5.0 LANDSCAPE STRATEGY Outerspace

5.1 PLAY STRATEGY

Whilst providing a fun, exciting and safe area for children to play within the gardens, we have taken a 'naturalistic' approach to the design and selection of play equipment.

Rather than having a dedicated play area, we propose to site play facilities throughout the various communal gardens with access open for children to explore and meet their friends. Every garden will have an element of informal play activity. Interactive pieces of play equipment, that are both fun and educational, have been designed into the garden.

The play area within the landscaped gardens alone consist of 2150m2, including areas of incidental play and lawns in socialisation spaces.

Activities within the space:

Activities within the play spaces will be informal play for toddlers and 5-11 year olds, under the supervision of adults. Toddlers dorstep play is located within the courtyards. Such play provision will range from exploring naturalistic elements and team games. For 0-5 year olds we would provide small climbable objects including subtle changes of level and seating for parents and guardians around them. For 5-11 year olds equipment that allows children to swing, slide and climb is located within communal orchards. And for 12+ years old we have catered for casual play/ hang out opportunities throughout the spaces.

We are providing wide variety of play opportunitise within the development, which is not required, but we belive is essential to be well used and active. The central space will have exciting level changes, tunnels and balancing beams. The Eastern site perimeter will be punctuated with naturalistic play elements and provide opportunities for incidental play.

The experience of the space:

Children can play throughout the day within the play spaces under the supervision of adults. They can explore the landscape, have fun by using the naturalistic play features and create team games with their friends. Children are not confined to only these spaces; they also have freedom to use the whole garden and we encourage them to do so through use of sensory planting. We also envisage children using paths to ride their tricycle/bicycles and create their circuits.


Appearance of the gardens:

In the creation of the play spaces, we have followed playground design guidance, established by Play England. This includes the use of natural elements such as timber and boulders.




