### Summary

- The picture of deprivation at a ward level is similar to the picture at Super Output Area level.
- The wards with most deprived SOAs are concentrated in Central and East Central London. There is also a concentration of these wards in the Lea Valley.
- Church Street is the most deprived ward in terms of average SOA rank with Queen's Park ward second. Both are in Westminster and the rankings may be partly due to the Census undercount in that borough.
- Three of the four most deprived wards in terms of average SOA rank are made up of SOAs which are all in the 10 per cent most deprived in the country.
- The two wards with the least number of deprived SOAs are in Bromley (Shortlands and Petts Wood & Knoll).

## Overview and analysis

This Briefing presents a ward analysis of the Indices of Deprivation 2004 from the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister (published on 28 April 2004 and revised on 17 June 2004), as they relate to London. Unlike the indices for 1998 and 2000, the ODPM did not produce ward scores for 2004. Only the Social Disadvantage Research Centre at the University of Oxford (which constructed the Indices on behalf of the ODPM) can do so from first principles. The methodology involves a complex process of combining data on a range of topics into a single measure.

The purpose of the indices is to identify areas of need, so the indices have been produced for small areas known as Super Output Areas - level 1 (SOAs). These are geographical areas of a consistent size devised in a consistent way across the whole of England. Each area has a total population size of around 1,500 people. These areas are nested (as far as possible) within electoral wards. There are exceptions to this, such as in the City of London, where ward populations are so small that this is not possible. The SOAs are a new development and this is the first time they have been used. The IMD2000 were produced for wards, which have the disadvantage in terms of deprivation analysis in that they vary considerably in size across the country.

However, there has been a demand within the GLA and from partner agencies for a ward level analysis based on 2004 scores and this Briefing attempts to address that need. No attempt has been made to produce actual scores but instead this Briefing presents an analysis at ward level based on individual SOA scores within wards to show:

- the average SOA rank within the ward (out of the 32,482 SOAs in England)
- a ward rank based on the above averages (out of the 624 wards in London (excluding the City of London))
- the number of SOAs within London wards that are ranked within the lowest 30, 20 and 10 per cent in the country.

Table 1 shows the ten most deprived wards in London based on their average SOA rank. Church Street is the most deprived compared with other London wards with Queen's Park second. Both are in Westminster and users should be aware that the IMD2004 was calculated before the population for Westminster had been revised up as a consequence of studies into the undercount in the 2001 Census. However, it is difficult to gauge the potential effect of this on the IMD2004 rankings as the population uplift did not focus on either the present ward geography of Westminster or the SOAs. It is known, though, that the area of the former Church Street ward was the most seriously undercounted – therefore, it is likely that this ward, although still deprived, would not be the most deprived in London.

These two wards and Bromley-by-Bow in Tower Hamlets – the fourth most deprived – are made up of SOAs that are all in the 10 per cent most deprived in the country. The results for all wards are shown in Appendix 1.

The wards with most deprived SOAs are concentrated in Central and East Central London (see Map 1 which shows average SOA rank by ward). There is also a concentration of these wards in the Lea Valley and pockets of deprivation along the M4 corridor. Map 2 highlights wards that have 25 per cent or more of their SOAs in the 10 per cent most deprived in the country. The London borough of Hackney has only one ward (Clissold) which has less than 25 per cent. Overall Hackney has 48 per cent of its SOAs in the bottom 10 per cent of the country, second to Tower Hamlets which has 55 per cent. Tower Hamlets has four wards that have 75 per cent or more of its SOAs in the bottom 10 per cent in the country.

The two wards with the least number of deprived SOAs are in Bromley (Shortlands and Petts Wood & Knoll).

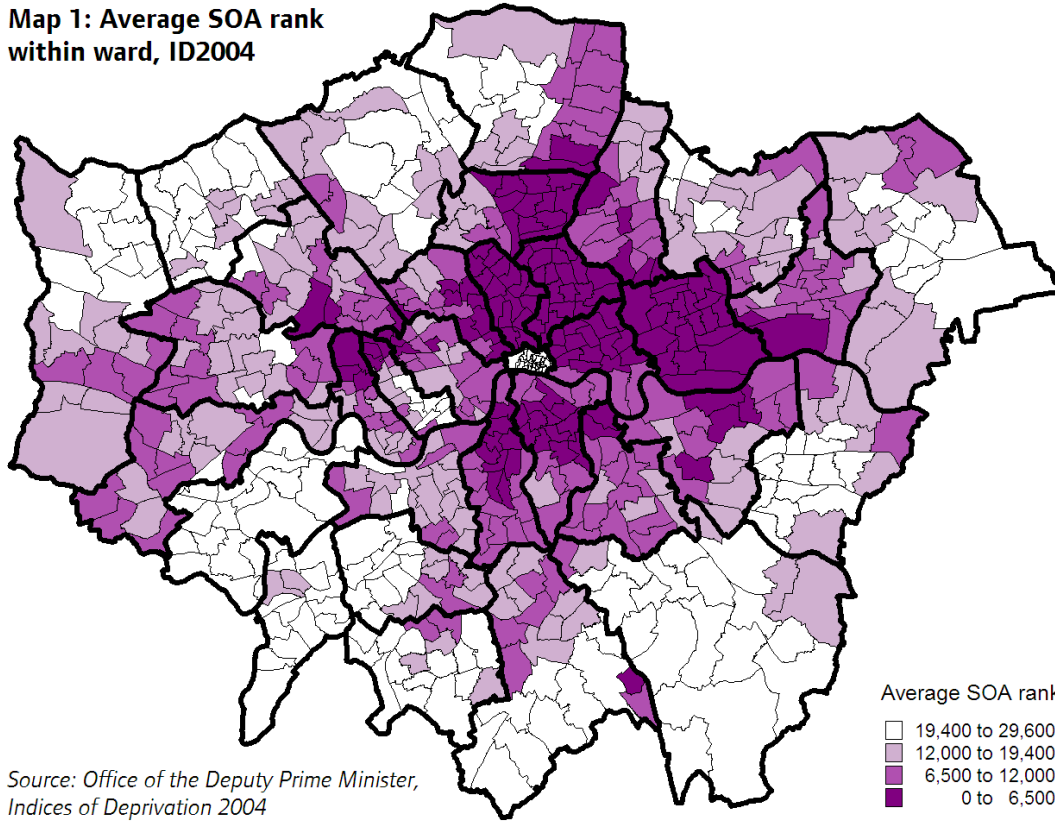
For more detail on the construction of the indices see DMAG Briefing 2004/18 '*Indices of Deprivation*'. The Briefing also covers the results for London at SOA level and how these compare to the previous Indices of Deprivation (2000).

The results are weighted for differences in SOA populations. Ward populations were taken from the 2001 Census (less prisoners) and constrained to the ONS mid-2001 population estimates – which are considered a more accurate measure. The methodology is similar to that used by ODPM to produce average ranks at a Local District level.

The Indices of Deprivation 2004 were originally issued in April 2004. However, some errors were found in the calculations, so these were corrected and a revised version was published on 17 June 2004. This Briefing is based on the revised data.

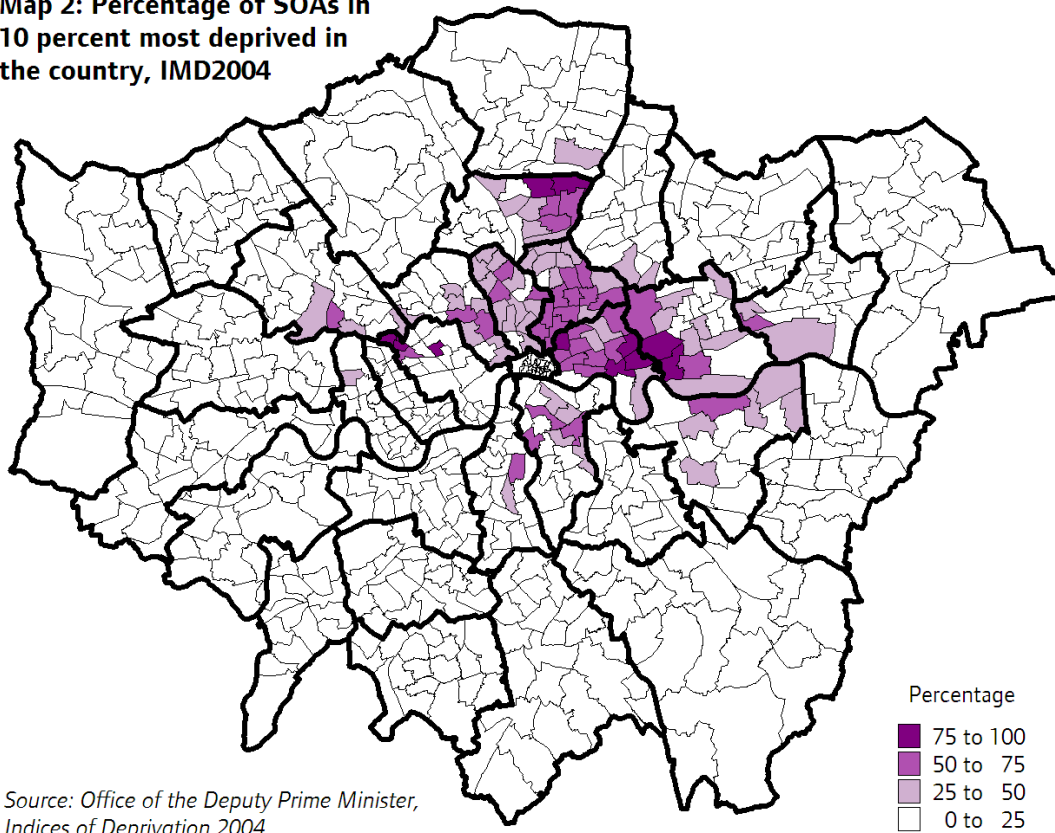
