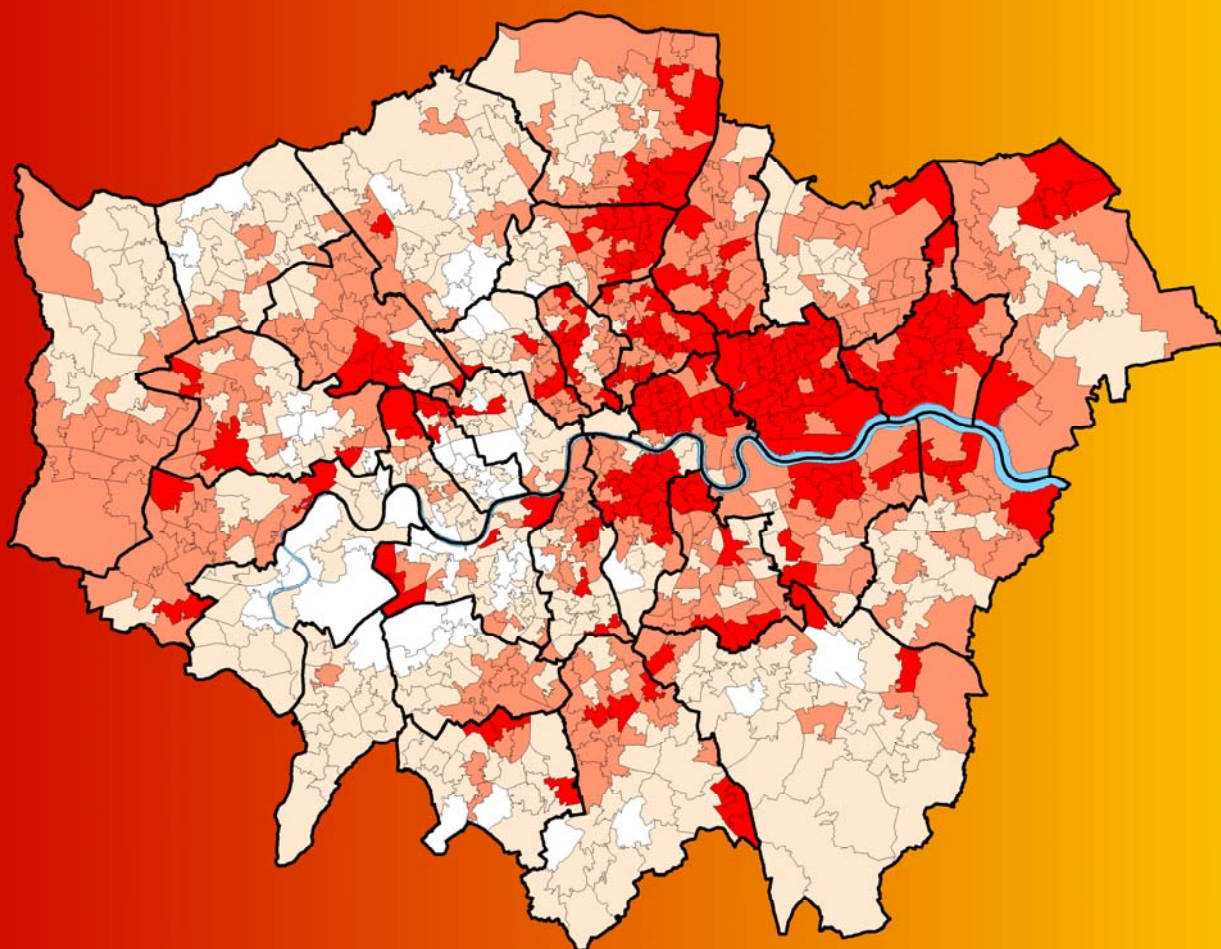

ONS Model-based Income Estimates: 2004/05

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Main Findings

- The modelling of four types of income means that the estimates are suitable for a wide range of uses. The information should help those who are working on a range of initiatives designed to combat poverty, inequality and social exclusion.
- London's gross weekly household income of £740 falls to £570 when net of tax and when deductions for pension contributions and child care are taken into account. This is a fall of 23 per cent – the highest for any region in England and Wales.
- The average income after taking housing costs into account is £480 for London, a reduction of over 14 per cent on the before housing cost figure of £560 – again the highest percentage change of any region.
- Income in some MSOAs rises when equivalised (taking into account household size) and in some fall. The general pattern is that there is a rise in wealthier areas after equivalisation and a fall in less wealthier areas.
- Once deductions for tax, pension schemes and childcare costs are taken into account (net income) many more MSOAs fall into the lower percentiles. This is especially true for Tower Hamlets with a quarter of its MSOAs in the bottom 10 per cent in England and Wales.
- The percentages fall once net income is equivalised (before housing costs) but rise again, dramatically in some boroughs, once housing costs are taken into account. Fifteen per cent of London's MSOAs are in the bottom 30 per cent for this income type in England and Wales and this rises to 25 per cent for Inner London. In Newham, 81 per cent of its MSOAs are in the bottom 30 per cent in England and Wales.
- The most dramatic change is in Barking and Dagenham: before housing costs are taken into account the borough had no MSOAs in the bottom 30 per cent but this rises to 64 per cent after housing costs are taken into account.

Introduction

The Office for National Statistics (ONS) has produced a third set of model-based income estimates for England and Wales. These estimates were produced to fulfil users' requirements for more up to date income information at the local level, on boundaries consistent with the 2001 Census. The previous release in 2005 relates to 2001/02 and used wards as its smallest geography (see *DMAG Briefing 2005-42*). In keeping with National Statistics geographic and statistical policy, ONS has produced the 2004/05 estimates for Middle Super Output Areas (MSOAs).

Estimates and confidence intervals have been produced for four different income types:

- 1) Average weekly household total income (unequalised).
- 2) Average weekly household net income (unequalised).
- 3) Average weekly household net income before housing costs (equalised).
- 4) Average weekly household net income after housing costs (equalised).

Differing geographical boundaries and data sources used in producing the 2004/05 estimates mean that they are not comparable with the estimates for 2001/02. However, the 2004/05 estimates have been produced using the same methodology as employed for 2001/02. This modelling methodology enables survey data to be combined with census and administrative data to improve the quality of estimates at small area level. As the estimates are model-based they are different to standard direct estimates obtained from surveys and from statistics provided by administrative sources.

The model-based approach gives estimates that are of a different nature from standard survey estimates because they are dependent upon correctly specifying the relationship between weekly household income and the census/administrative information. The main limitation of estimates for small areas, either those estimated directly from responses to surveys or model-based, is that they are subject to variability. ONS has produced confidence intervals associated with the model-based estimates in order to make the accuracy of the estimates clear.

The model-based methodology has been developed to ensure that the MSOA estimates are constrained to the published Family Resources Survey (FRS) direct estimates for Government Office Regions (GOR) in England and the direct estimate for the country of Wales. For example, the model-based estimates for the MSOAs in Wales aggregate to the FRS estimate of average weekly household income for Wales. However, the model-based estimates will not be consistent with FRS estimates of average weekly household income for other geographical levels.

The methodology used to produce the model-based estimates is relatively new and as a result may be subject to consultation, modification and further development. In view of this ongoing work the current MSOA level model-based estimates are being published as Experimental Statistics. The GOR level estimates are not produced by the model, they are obtained directly from the Family Resource Survey and are classified as National Statistics.

The modelling of four types of income means that the estimates are suitable for a wide range of uses and in particular may prove to be useful for validating other income sources. More

specifically, the information should help those in central government, local authorities and other organisations who are working on a range of initiatives designed to combat poverty, inequality and social exclusion.

Results

Table 1 and Chart 1 show average weekly household income for the four different types by region. London has the highest for all four types (the South East has equal highest for overall net income). However, this disguises the polarisation at both ends of the income scale within London. London has some of the highest earners in the country but also the highest rates of poverty – especially in Inner London.

London’s gross weekly household income of £740 falls to £570 when net of tax and when deductions for pension contributions and child care are taken into account. This is a fall of 23 per cent – the highest for any region and brings the average for London closer to other regions.

If net income is equivalised (taking into account average household size) then the differential between London and the other regions increases again but this is before housing costs are taken into account. The average income after taking housing costs into account is £480 for London, a reduction of over 14 per cent on the before housing cost figure of £560 – again the highest percentage change of any region.

The main purpose of these estimates, however, is to fulfil users’ requirements for more up to date income information at the local level rather than for regions. Figures from the previous release in 2001/02 were highlighted in *DMAG Briefing 2005-42* and were presented at the ward level. For many users ward areas are more useful than MSOAs as they have recognisable names and can be compared with other datasets produced at the ward level e.g. benefit statistics.

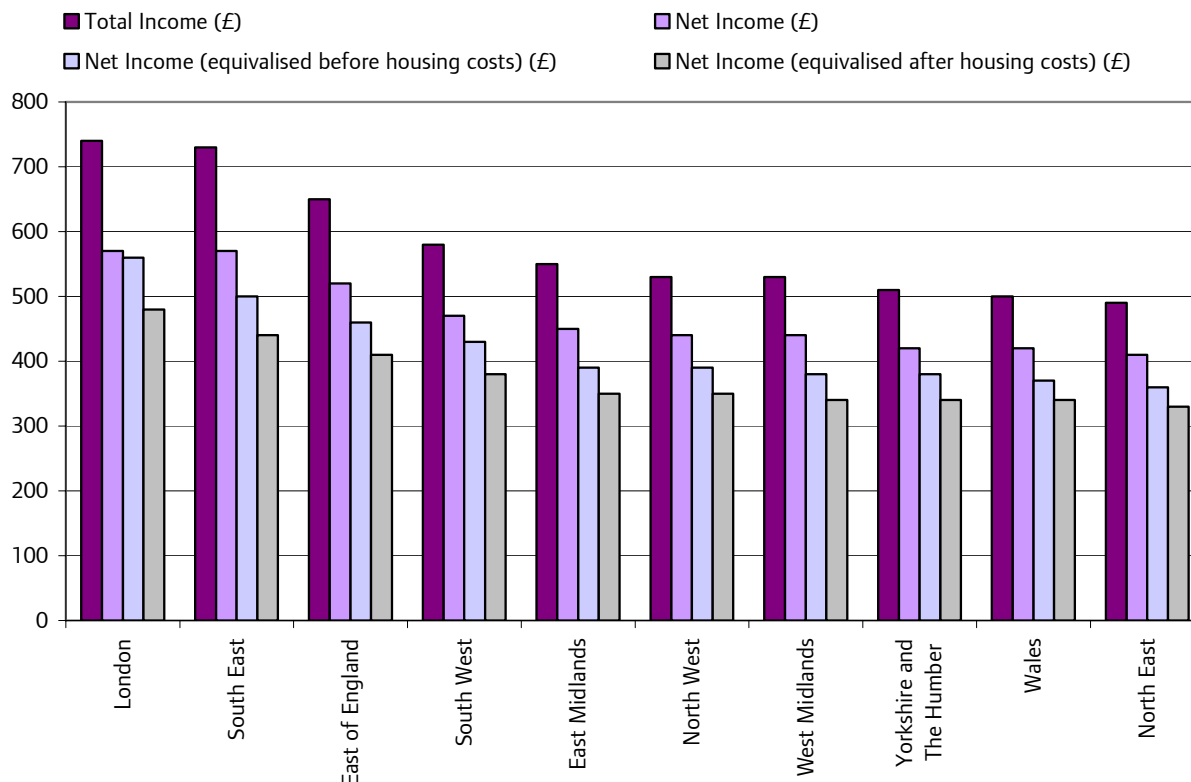

However in keeping with National Statistics geographic and statistical policy, ONS has produced these 2004/05 estimates on Middle Super Output Areas (MSOA) as opposed to wards. According to the ONS MSOA boundaries offer an advantage over wards because they are designed for statistical reporting, and will not change for electoral or other administrative reasons. This means fairer comparisons can be made between areas and over time. Maps 1 and 2 should help users to locate a particular MSOA within a London borough.

Appendix 1 shows the income estimates for each MSOA by London borough. A direct comparison of estimates (as opposed to calculating rates) is possible as MSOAs are of a consistent size (although this will change the further data move away from the year 2001). These areas have a minimum population of 5,000, with an overall mean of 7,200. They were built from groups of Lower Layer Super Output Areas and constrained by the local authority boundaries of 2003. There are around 7,000 MSOAs in England and Wales.

Table 2 shows the 20 MSOAs with the lowest estimates for each income type – ranked against all MSOAs in England and Wales. It is important to take into account the variability in the estimates when interpreting their ranking. For example, the confidence interval around the number one ranked MSOA suggests that the estimate lies among the group of MSOAs with the lowest income levels rather than being the MSOA with the lowest average MSOA income. Estimates for two particular MSOAs can be described as significantly different if the confidence intervals for the estimates do not overlap.

As would be expected, there is a fall in income levels when total estimates are compared to net estimates and another fall between the estimates before and after housing costs are taken into account.

However, the changes between net income before equivalisation and after equivalisation are not so clear-cut. When equivalised, income in some MSOAs rises and in others falls. The general pattern is that there is rise in wealthier areas like Richmond after equivalisation and a fall in less wealthier areas.

Those MSOAs that have an increase in income levels after equivalisation will probably have high earning singles or married couples without children – so income levels rise when compared to an average household with two children. Those MSOAs that have the largest decrease in income levels after equivalisation are boroughs with large ethnic populations (although not necessarily deprived e.g. Harrow) – this seems especially true of those boroughs with high Asian populations, which may be due to larger extended families.

Table 3 shows the percentage of MSOAs within each borough that have average incomes in the lowest 10, 20 and 30 percent in England and Wales. Four per cent of all MSOAs in London are in the lowest 20 per cent with regard to total household income (which includes income from benefits and tax credits) and this rises to nine per cent for the lowest 30 per cent. Most of these are in Inner London and concentrated in the boroughs of Tower Hamlets, Newham and Hackney. In fact Hackney has four per cent of its MSOAs in the bottom 10 per cent and over half the MSOAs in Newham and Tower Hamlets are in the bottom 30 per cent.

Once deductions for tax, pension schemes and childcare costs are taken into account (net income) many more MSOAs fall into the bottom 10 per cent. This is especially true for Tower Hamlets with a quarter of its MSOAs in the bottom 10 per cent. More surprising is that 15 per cent of MSOAs in Kingston upon Thames are in the bottom 30 per cent – none of these MSOAs appear again in the lower percentiles of any other income type.

The percentages fall once net income is equivalised (before housing costs) but rise again, dramatically in some boroughs, once housing costs are taken into account. Net household weekly income after housing costs (equivalised) - is composed of the same elements of net household weekly income but is subject to deductions for rent (gross of housing benefit), water rates, mortgage interest payments (net of any tax relief), ground rent and service charges.

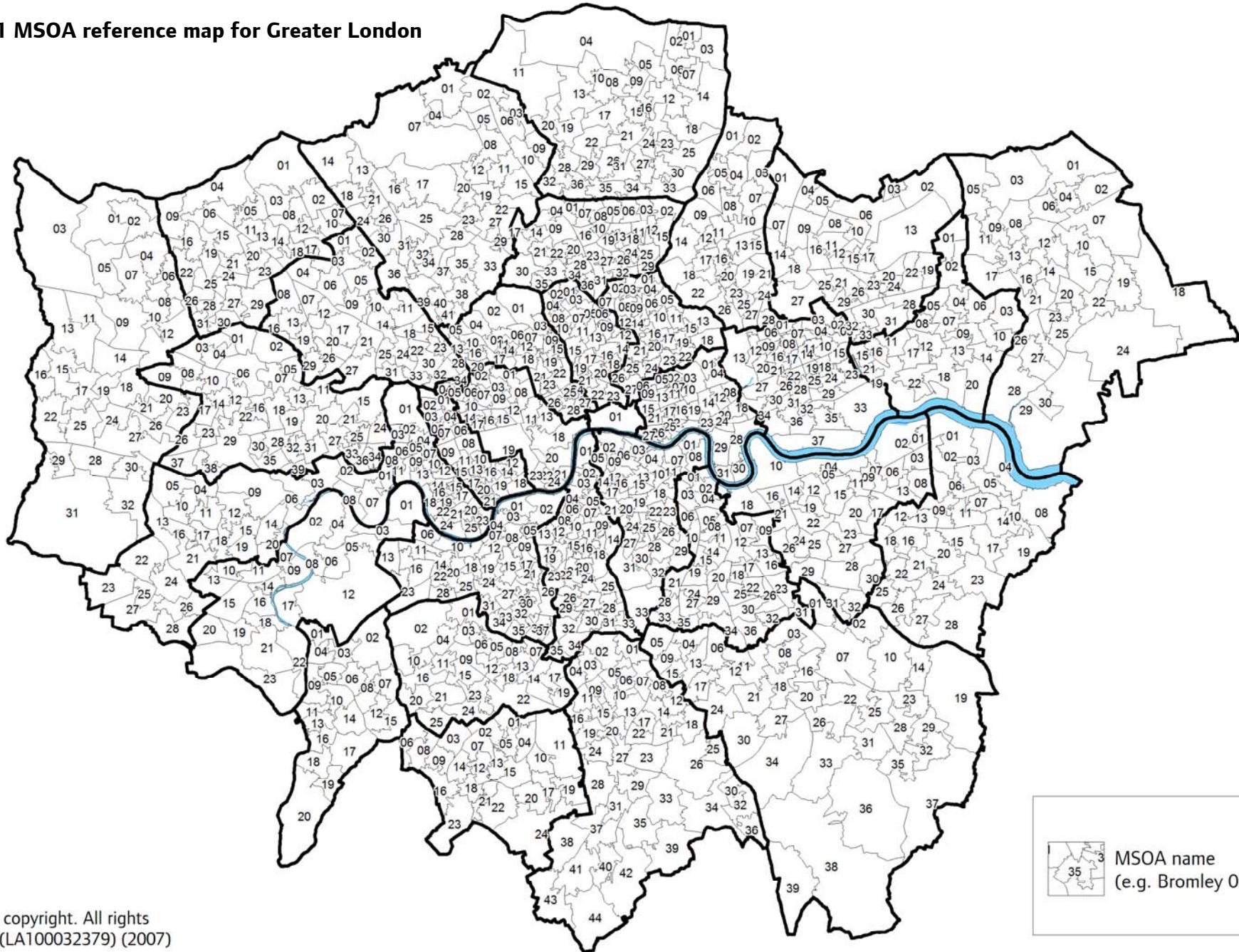
Fifteen per cent of MSOAs are in the bottom 30 per cent for this income type in London and this rises to 25 per cent for Inner London. In Newham, 81 per cent of its MSOAs are in the bottom 30 per cent – of these 32 per cent are in the lowest 10 per cent in England and Wales. Tower Hamlets has 61 per cent of its MSOAs in the bottom 30 per cent. The most dramatic change is in Barking and Dagenham: before housing costs are taken into account the borough had no MSOAs in the bottom 30 per cent but this rises to 64 per cent after housing costs are taken into account. However, even for this income type, there are many boroughs that have no MSOAs in the bottom 30 per cent. Again highlighting the extent of income inequality in London.

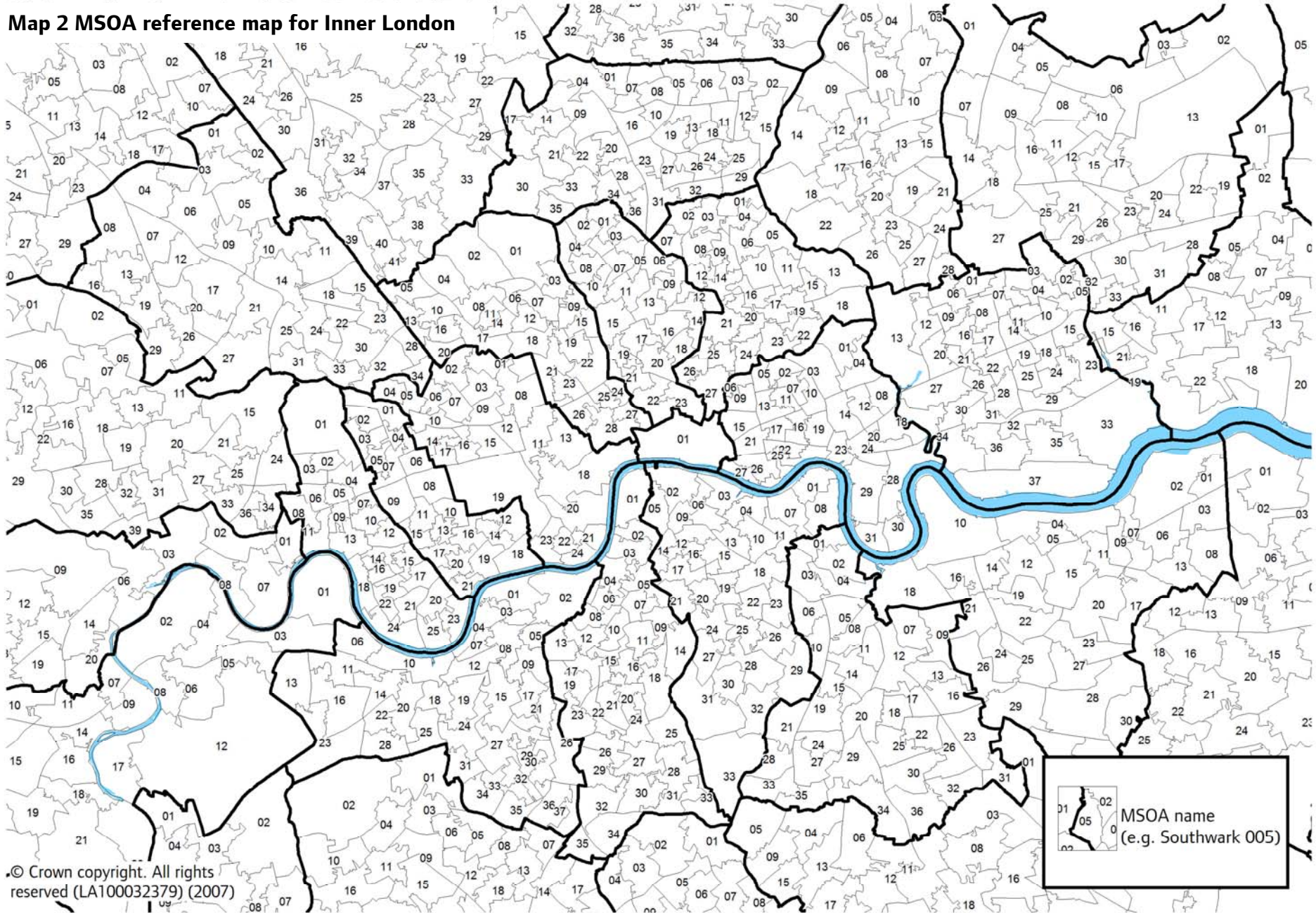

Map 1 MSOA reference map for Greater London

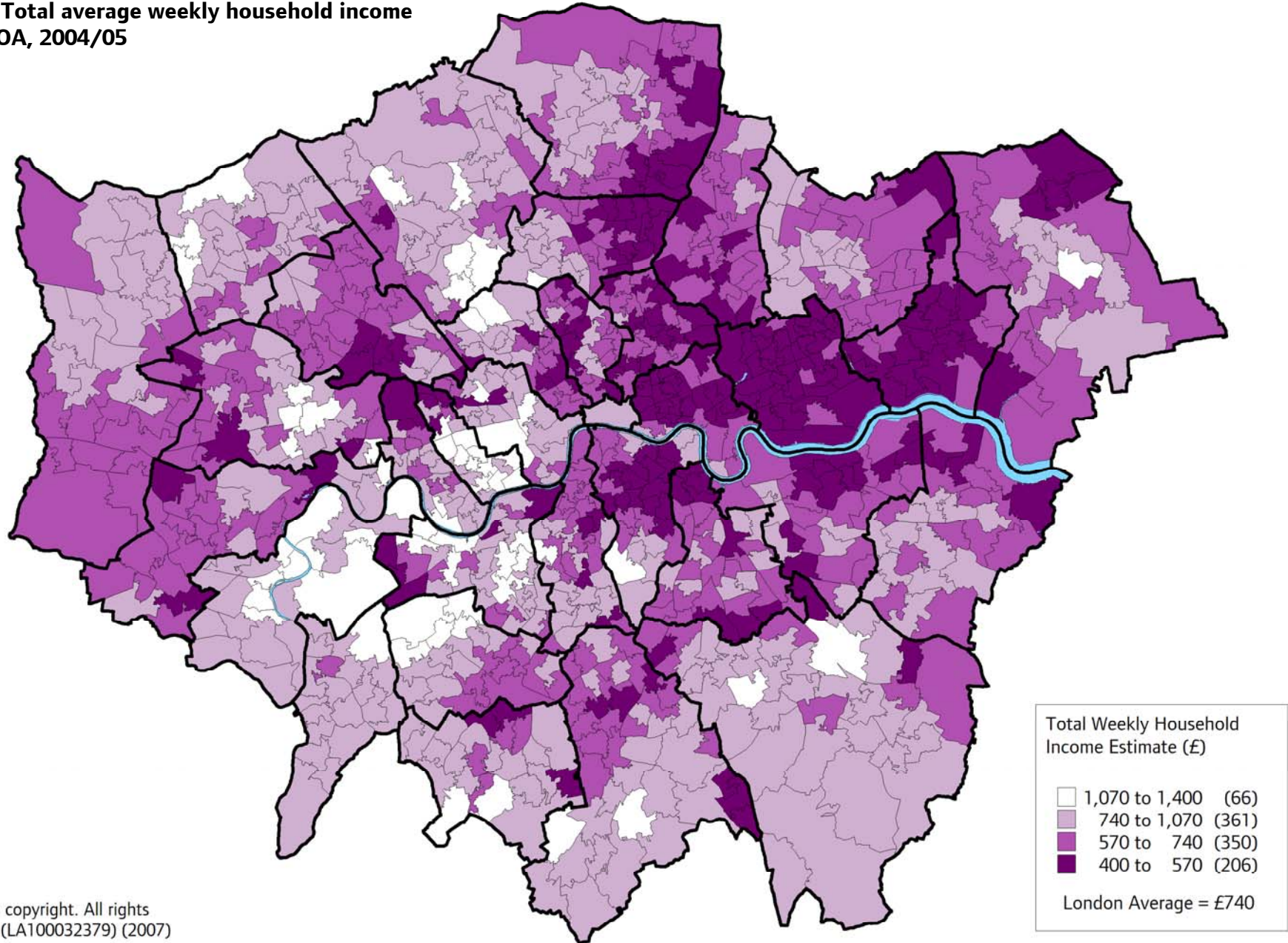


Map 2 MSOA reference map for Inner London



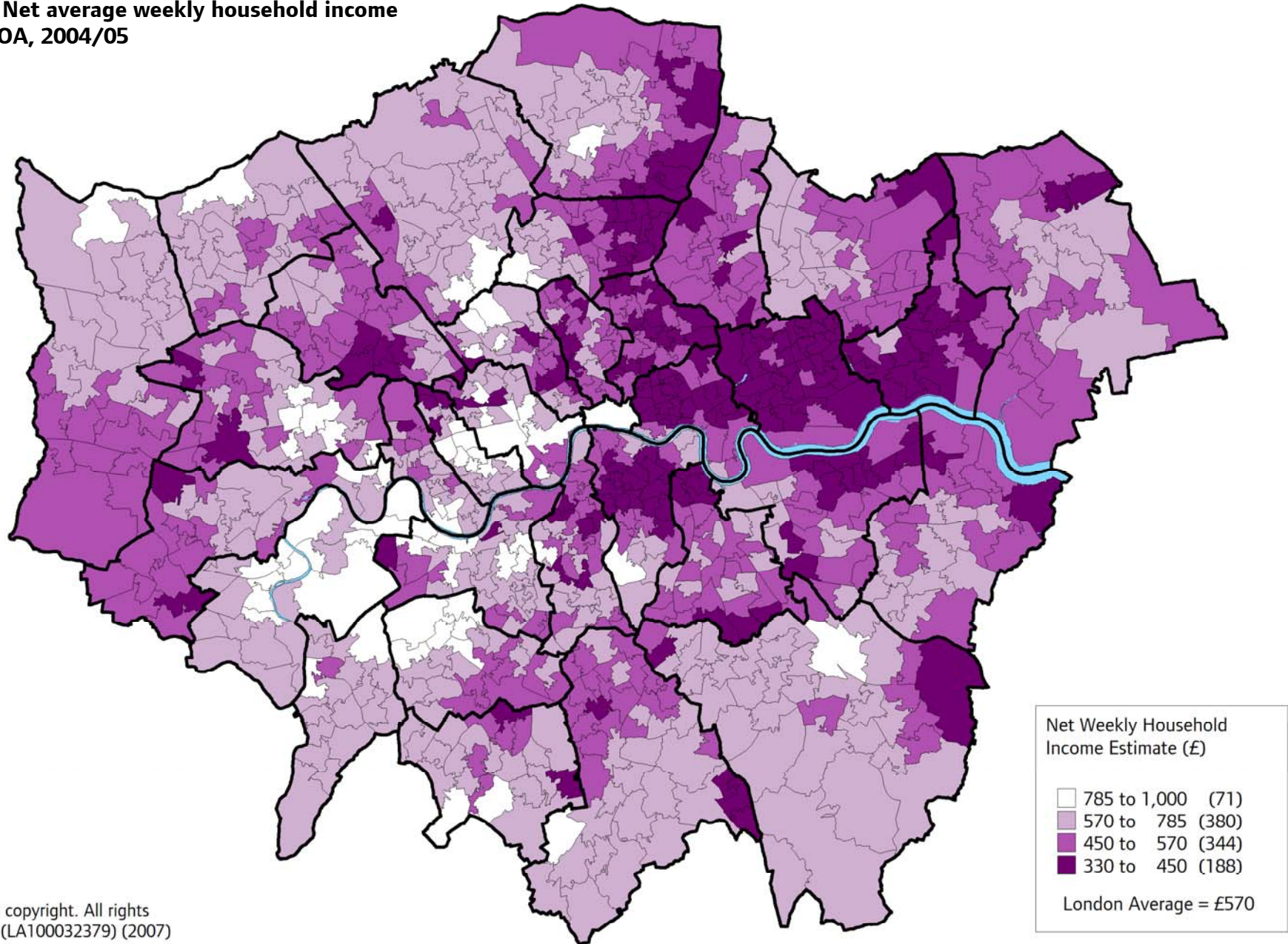
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Map 3 Total average weekly household income by MSOA, 2004/05



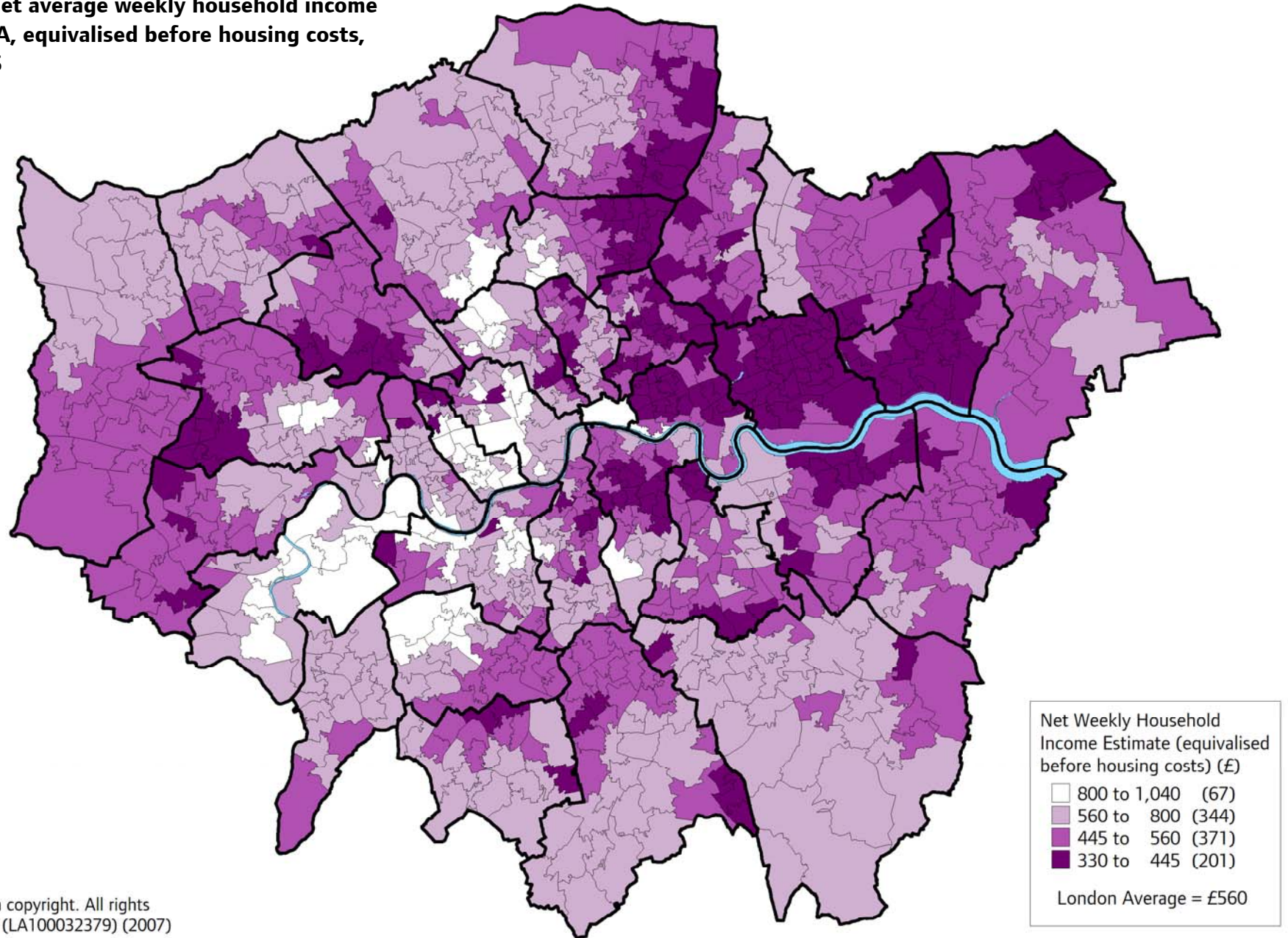
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Map 4 Net average weekly household income by MSA, 2004/05



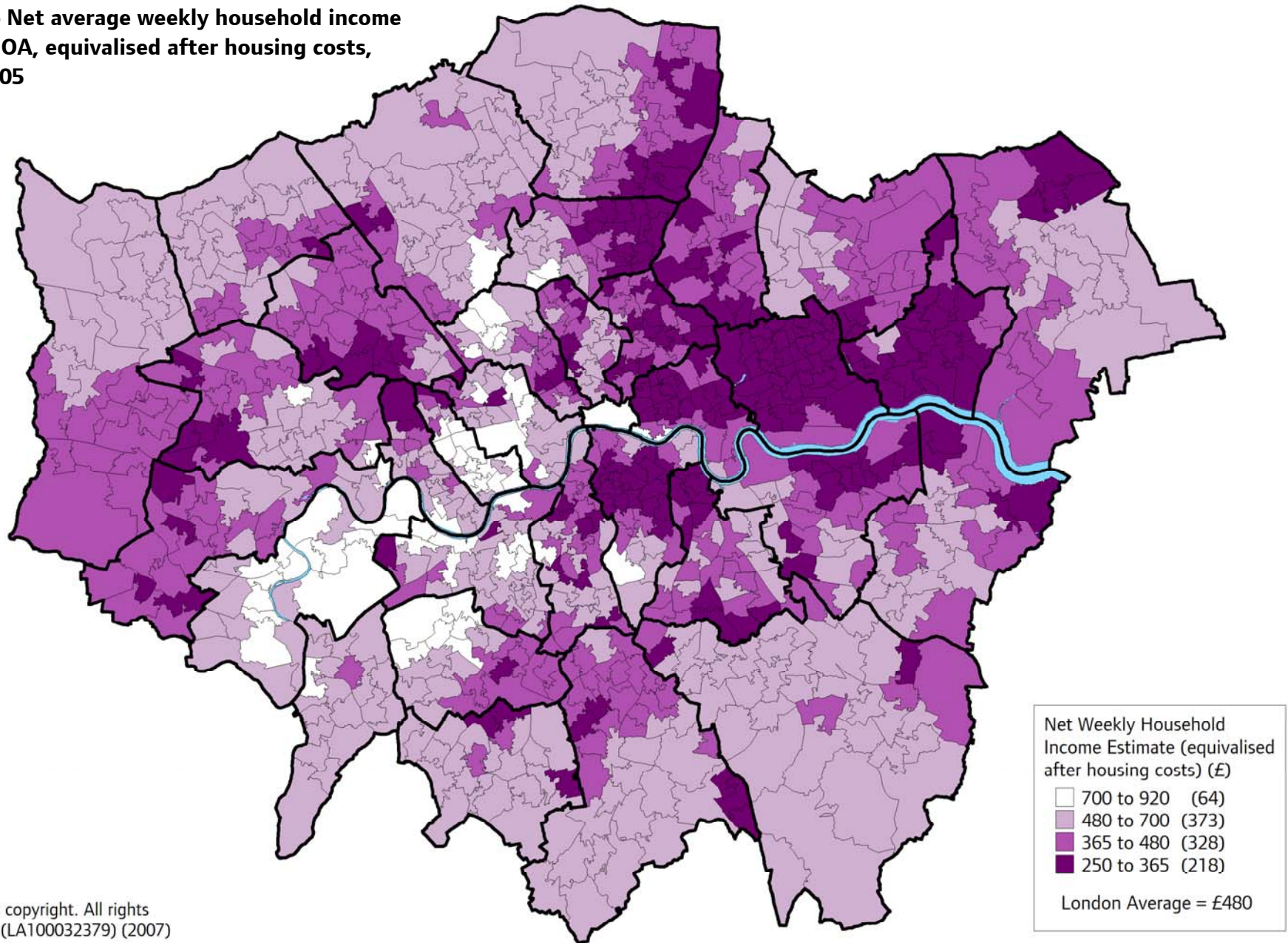
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Map 5 Net average weekly household income by MSOA, equalised before housing costs, 2004/05

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Background Information

The model-based approach to making estimates of income for MSOAs has been adopted because standard estimation procedures based on direct estimation from surveys do not provide reliable estimates at the small area level. Most surveys are designed to provide reliable estimates at national or regional levels, and at MSOA level the sample sizes are small, or in the majority of cases, zero.

The model-based process involves finding a relationship between survey data (data available on income) and other data drawn from administrative and census data sources. This relationship can then be used to 'borrow strength' from the administrative and census sources, known as covariates, to provide estimates on income for MSOAs.

The 2004/05 model-based income estimates for MSOAs are based on the relationship or model between Family Resources Survey data describing average household income at the household level and the selected covariates at the MSOA level. A model fitting process is used to select from the set of covariates, those with a strong relationship to the survey data. Separate models for England and Wales were investigated and the conclusion was that a single model was appropriate. In total, four models were produced representing each income type for England and Wales.

Each model is constructed using survey data from the sampled areas only. But as the relationships identified by the model are assumed to apply nationally the fitted model can be used to obtain estimates and confidence intervals for all MSOAs.

The survey data used within the modelling process were obtained from the 2004/05 Family Resources Survey (FRS). The choice of the FRS enabled each of the four survey variables on income to be modelled. The estimates produced are values of the average MSOA income for the following four income types:

- 1) Average weekly household total income (unequalised).
- 2) Average weekly household net income (unequalised).
- 3) Average weekly household net income before housing costs (equalised).
- 4) Average weekly household net income after housing costs (equalised).

Although the survey data used in the modelling process were obtained from the FRS, two of the income types were defined by a different study that is based on FRS data. Net weekly household income (equalised) both before and after housing costs is defined and calculated in the Households Below Average Income (HBAI) report. Although all four types of income for a particular household are calculated using the same FRS survey data the HBAI methodology makes some changes to the original data set.

The HBAI data set is a cut-down version of the FRS data since the HBAI excludes households containing a married adult whose spouse is temporarily absent. An adjustment is also made to sample cases at the top of the income distribution to correct for volatility in the highest income captured in the survey. The covariate data sets considered for inclusion in the models were:

- Census, 2001.
- DWP benefit claimant counts, August 2004.
- Country/regional indicators.
- VOA Council Tax, 2004.
- Her Majesty's Land Registry House Price Indices, smoothed data 2002 to 2004.
- Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs, adults earning over £35,000 or £40,000, 2003/04

A benchmarking or scaling process was used to ensure that the model-based MSOA estimates were consistent with the direct estimates of average weekly household income published in the FRS report for 2004/05 for GORs in England and the direct estimate for the country of Wales.

Concepts and Definitions

Confidence Interval

In the context of model-based estimates, the confidence interval represents the uncertainty in the modelling process. The interval reflects the range between which the true value of average weekly household income is believed to lie, at a given level of confidence. At the 95% confidence level, assuming the model holds, on average the confidence interval is expected to contain the true value for 95% of the MSOAs.

Confidence intervals are not supplied with the GOR income estimates. This is because the GOR estimates are not produced by the model, they are obtained directly from the Family Resources Survey, therefore no confidence intervals are required.

Equivalised Income

Equivalisation adjusts household income values to take account of household size and composition, enabling more appropriate comparisons to be made between households. For instance, consider the income of two households, A and B, who have the same weekly income, but A contains a couple with no children and B contains a couple with two children. On the basis of income alone, households A and B would appear to be of similar wealth. However, household B is less wealthy as there are two children to support.

McClements Equivalence Scale

Equivalisation adjusts household income values to take account of household size and composition, enabling more appropriate comparisons to be made between households. Further information can be found here: [McClements equivalisation scale](#)

Income Definitions

Total household weekly income (unequivalised) is the sum of the gross income of every member of the household plus any income from benefits such as Tax Credits. It is calculated as the sum of income from:

- earnings (gross);
- self-employment;
- investments;
- disability benefits;

- retirement pensions and income support;
- other benefits;
- other pensions; and
- other/remaining sources.

Net household weekly income (unequalised) is the sum of the net income of every member of the household. It is calculated using the same components as gross income but income is net of:

- income tax payments;
- national insurance contributions;
- domestic rates/council tax;
- contributions to occupational pension schemes;
- all maintenance and child support payments, which are deducted from the income of the person making the payments; and
- parental contribution to students living away from home.

Net household weekly income before housing costs (equivalised) is composed of the same elements as net household weekly income but is subject to the McClements Equivalence Scale.

Net household weekly income after housing costs (equivalised) is composed of the same elements of net household weekly income but is subject to the following deductions prior to the McClements Equivalence Scale being applied:

- rent (gross of housing benefit);
- water rates, community water charges and council water charges;
- mortgage interest payments (net of any tax relief);
- structural insurance premiums (for owner occupiers); and
- ground rent and service charges.

Geographic Referencing

Model-based estimates have been produced on MSOA boundaries. Both survey and all covariate data sources had to be available on the relevant MSOA geography.

The survey data were provided at household level with grid reference coordinates attached. This enabled ONS to locate households and allocate them to the appropriate MSOAs.

The majority of covariate data sources were supplied or downloaded from departmental websites pre-aggregated to MSOA boundaries. In cases where data were available at LSOA level only, the figures were aggregated to MSOA level.
