Introduction to commissioned tables

This Census Information Note has been produced to update users on the position with commissioned tables from the 2001 Census. It includes detailed information on tables, which have been received recently, and provides a list of all tables, which have been received so far. It tries to indicate how they differ from tables which are already available. It will be updated regularly, and the details in the list improved.

The GLA has requested that ONS send us a copy of all commissioned tables they produce as a matter of course, so that we do not have to spend time chasing them to find out what has been produced and asking for copies of each one. These tables include some tables that have been commissioned by the GLA on behalf of the consortium and a large number of tables that have been commissioned by other people. (It can sometimes even be quite interesting trying to guess who has commissioned which tables.) There are a lot more tables to come and we can commission tables at any time but the current wait for any tables commissioned now is over 5 months (until February 2005).

Format of commissioned tables

Some of the tables have been converted into SASPAC format and some are available as Excel files. There are a few exceptions, which are explained later, which have been provided in Supertable format. These are being converted into SASPAC files, as they are tables that were commissioned by the GLA and are not usable as they are. Any tables that are at ward level have been converted into SASPAC system files simply because they are very difficult to handle in any other way. Some other tables have been converted on the basis that they may be of wider interest. Some tables are small and only available for England and Wales or Government Office Regions, so these have been left as Excel files. The intention is to convert as many tables as possible into SASPAC format, but this can be a time consuming process. We are therefore being selective about which tables to convert.

The following sections provide information on some of the recently arrived tables and commissioned workplace tables; the list of tables which have been converted into SASPAC format and have been provided as SASPAC system files; the full list of available commissioned tables with some indication of what is new in them.

Commissioned tables naming convention

The tables are supplied by ONS in usually rather large Excel files and are named by them using the following convention:

M, ES or C followed by a table number.

M – tables commissioned by editors or authors of the ONS ‘Focus On’ series of publications (formerly known as the Multi-source topic reports)

ES – tables provided to Eurostat

C – general commissioned tables

In total there have been 189 'C' tables, 239 'M' tables and 24 'ES' tables produced so far and most are listed in an Excel spreadsheet that can be found on the ONS website: http://www.statistics.gov.uk/census2001/downloads/com_tab_finder.xls, which is updated whenever new tables are released. The list has been reproduced with additional information about some of the tables in this Census Information Note.

The tables, which have been converted into SASPAC system files have been given a prefix of 'SCT' for use in SASPAC and are numbered in the order they have been processed. Each of these them system files has been provided to consortium members along with the relevant FWD and FWK files.

The Census team is also working on adding the SCT tables to the SASPAC search facility so that they can be searched and used in the same way as any other standard table.

Recent commissioned tables received

Here is a detailed description of some of the most recent tables received.

C0188 - Migrant Inflows (received 16th September 2004)

This table was commissioned by the GLA for the Demography Team for the population projections model.

Table population: All people aged 0 to 90+

Geographical level: City of London and London Boroughs.

This table details migration from each borough, counties in the South East and the East of England Government Office Regions plus Scotland, Northern Ireland, Wales, rest of the world and no usual address to each of the London boroughs, Inner London, Outer London and London. The table is by sex and individual year of age.

Available as an Excel spreadsheet - 9,576KB

C0281 - (received 6th September 2004) is similar to C0188 but the geography is Central London, Rest of Inner London, Outer London, Rest of UK, Rest of World, no usual address to Central, Inner and Outer London. This table was commissioned by the GLA for the Demography Team for the population projections model.

C0208 - All economically active residents aged 16-74 (received 6th September 2004)

Table population: All economically active people aged 16 to 74

Geographical level: Unitary authorities and wards in Berkshire

Breaks down people who are economically active by sex and 5-year age band but also with 16-17 and 18-19 years.

Available as Excel spreadsheet - 170KB

C0200 - Infants in private households with mother present (received 16th September 2004)

This table was commissioned by the GLA for the Demography Team for the population projections model.

Table population: Infants (zero year olds) in households with mother present.

Geographical level: Central London, Rest of Inner London, and Outer London

This table cross tabulates the ethnic group of the father with the ethnic group of the mother and the ethnic group of the infant. It is provided by 5-year age band of mother

Available as an Excel spreadsheet - 2,410KB

C0116 - Theme Table 7 by country of birth (received 2nd September 2004)

Table population: Residents by specified country of birth

Geographical level: England and Wales to GOR

This table is useful because it gives the details from Theme Table 7 (age, sex, accommodation type, occupancy rating, amenities, central heating, tenure, living arrangements, family type, health, qualifications, economic activity, occupation, NS-Sec and industry) for 147 countries of birth. This table was originally produced for 127 countries of birth and the GLA commissioned the same table for another 20 countries.

Available as SCT021 SASPAC system file. This has been converted to SASPAC as a double geography file where the country of birth is the origin and the region of residence is the destination.

Economic activity tables

The following tables were originally commissioned by the GLA as working age tables to provide a range of economic activity details for people of working age. This would allow us to compare with economic activity in 1991, which was based on people of working age. ONS agreed to provide them for persons of pension age to 74 so that they could be subtracted from the original standard tables to give the relevant detail for people of working age. This then gets around the problem of the miscoding of people who have never worked and aged from pension age to 74, which is an error that ONS have no plans to fix. The tables are available as they were provided by ONS and listed below, or as the working age tables created by the GLA, subtracting the pension age to 74 table from the 16 to 74 table.
