Introduction

The 2011 Census reports on 18 ethnic groups. This series of fact sheets presents the most detailed data available for those groups at the London level. For each ethnic group data on a wide range of characteristics are presented alongside London averages for comparison.

All data are rounded to the nearest 100. Percentages are rounded to the nearest integer and as a result percentages within tables may not sum to 100.

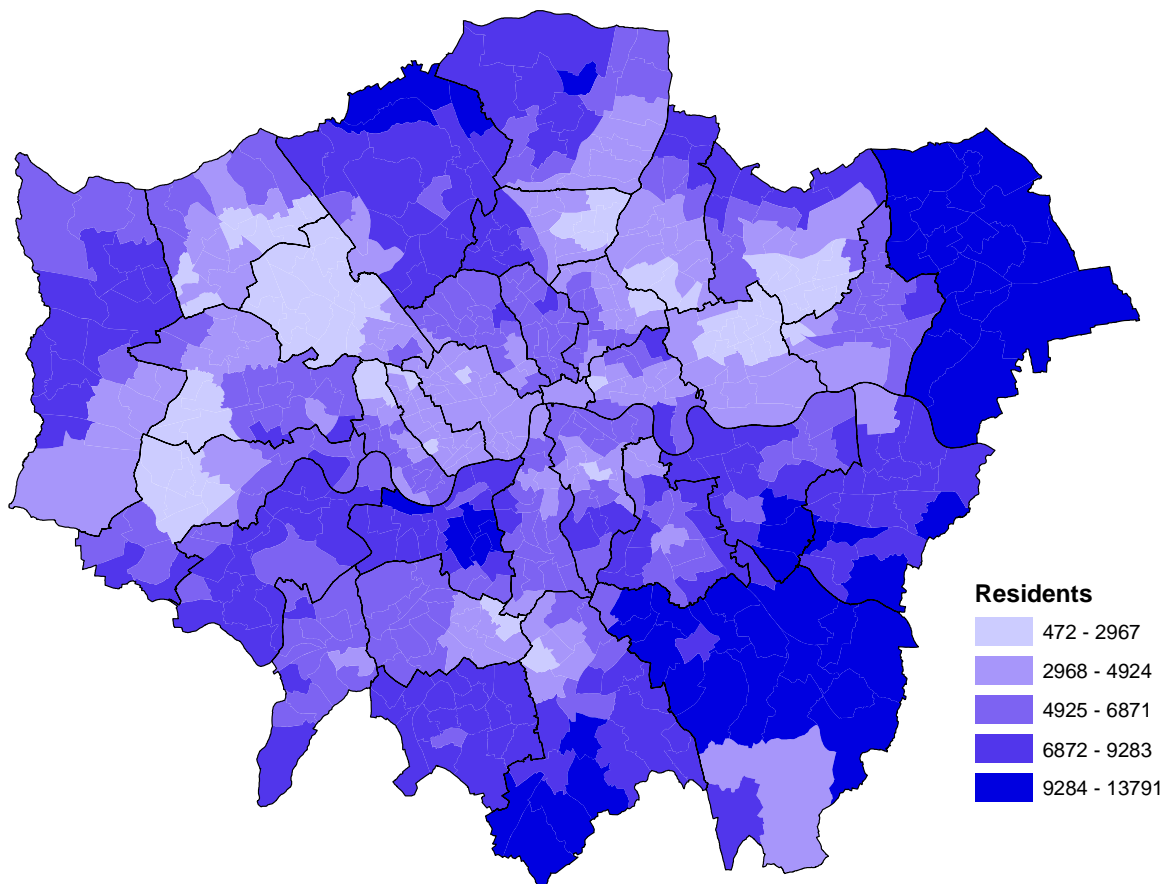

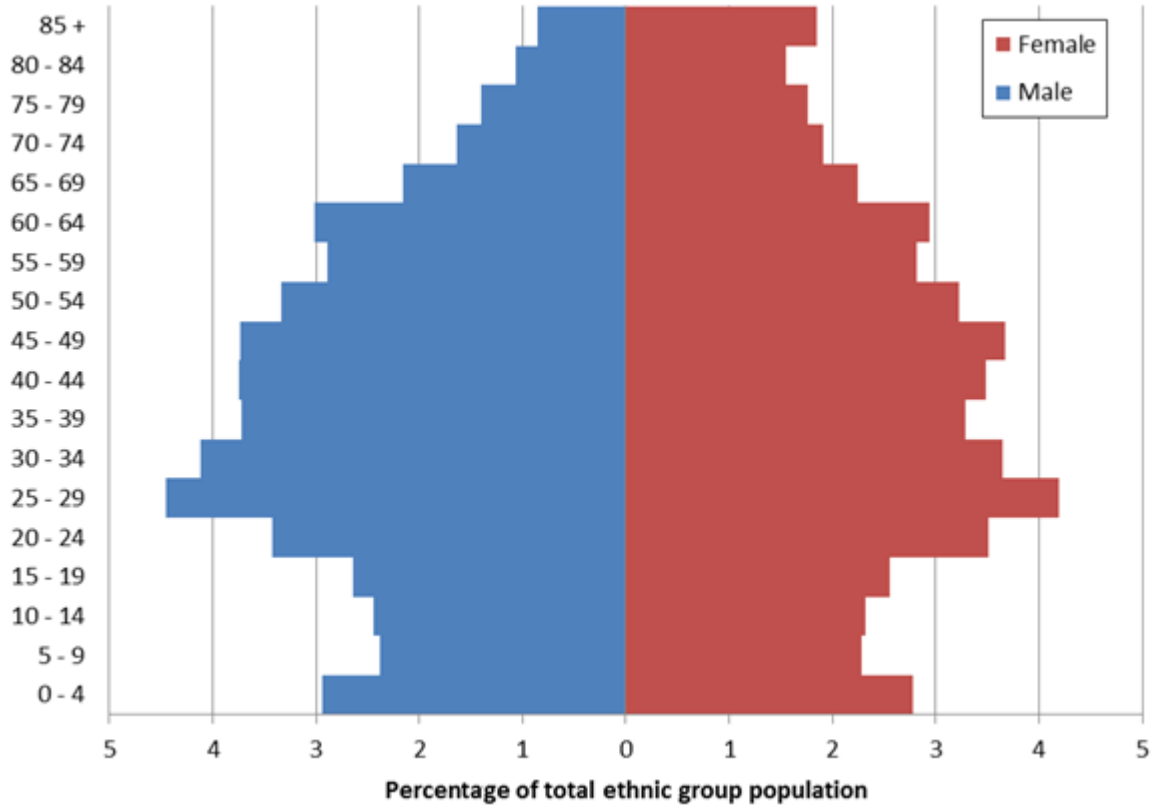

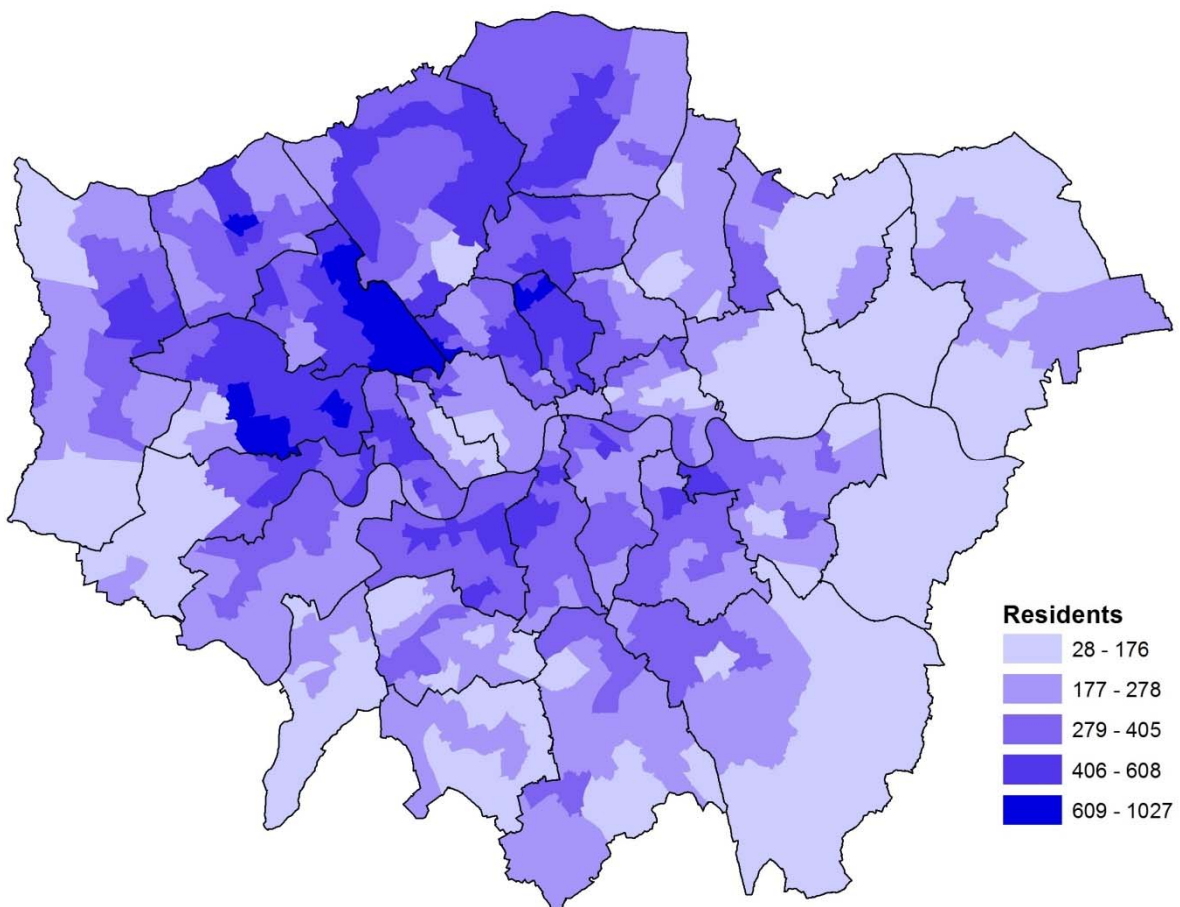

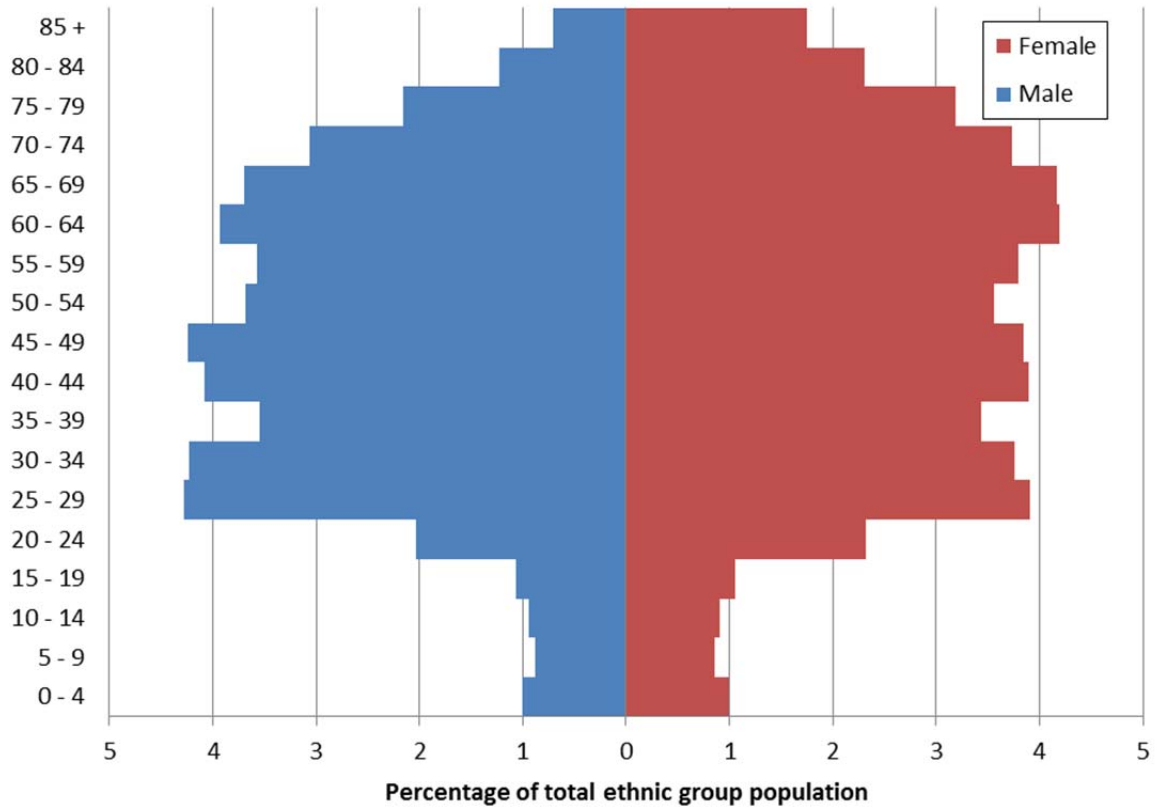

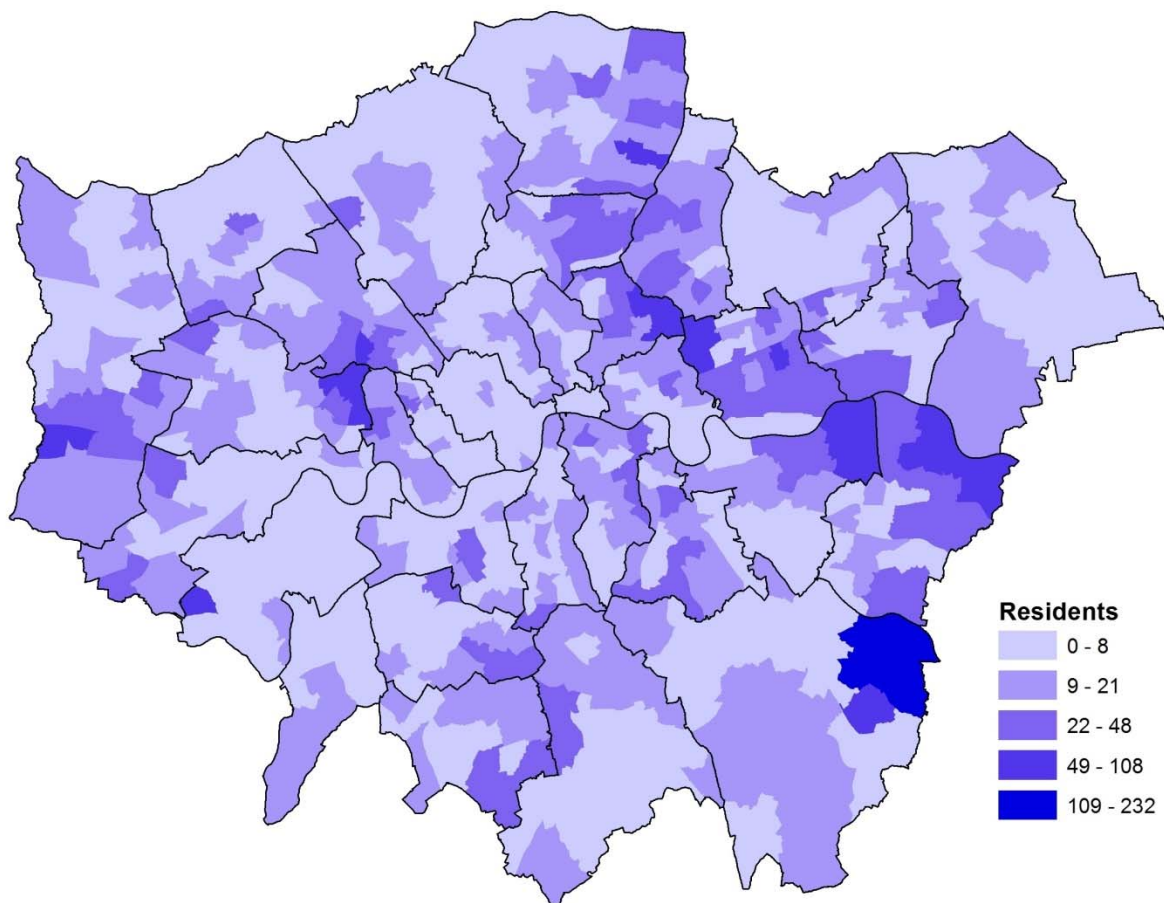

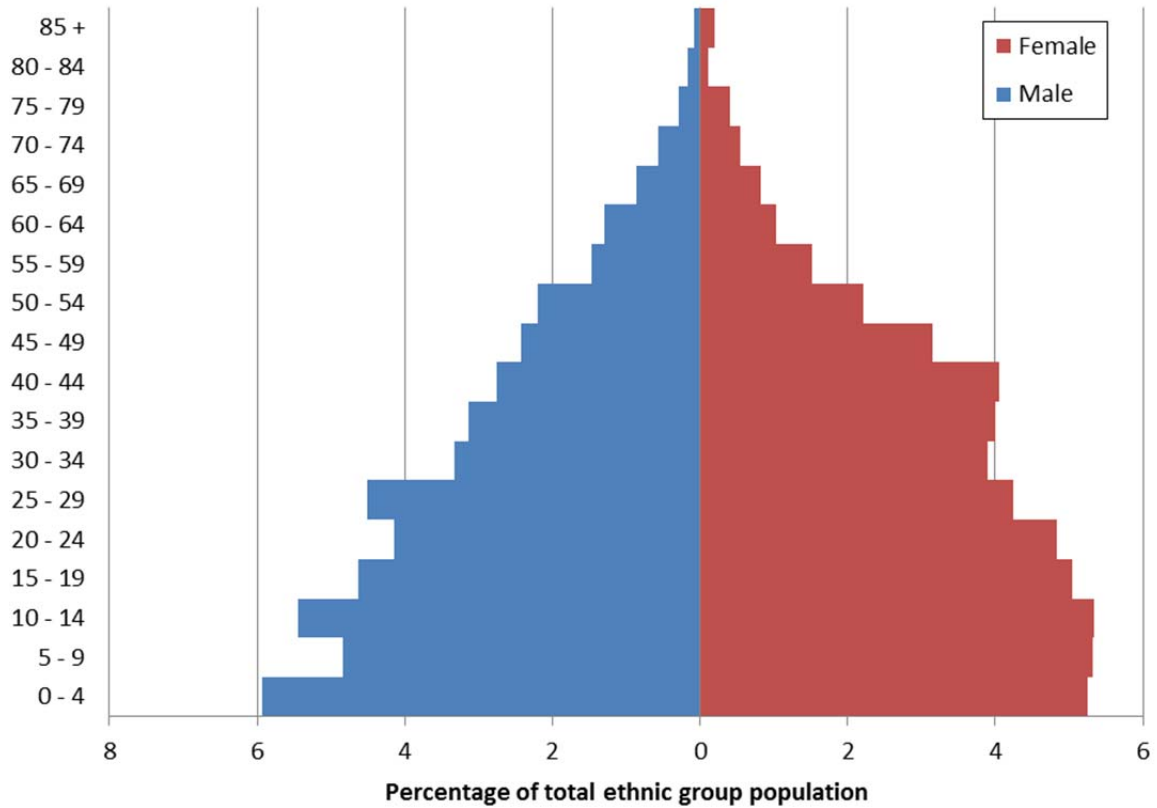

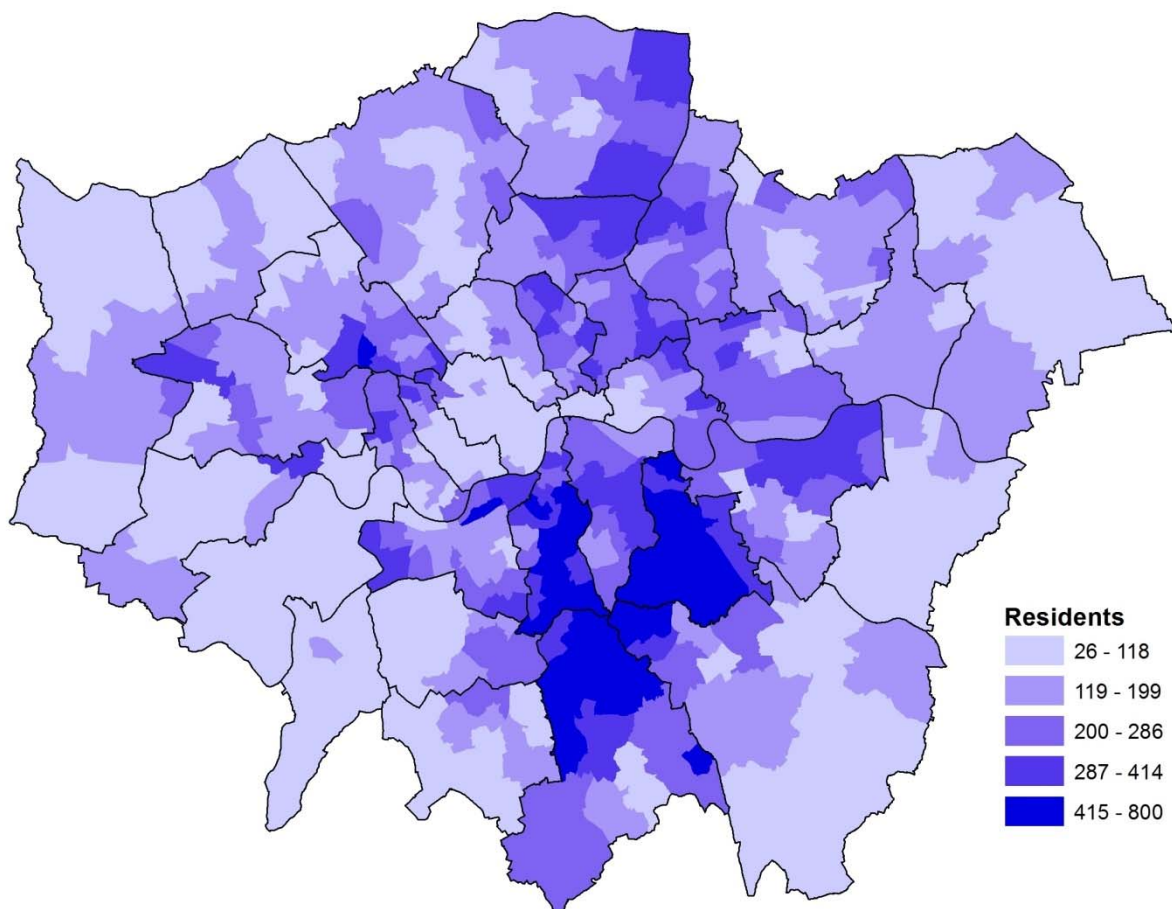

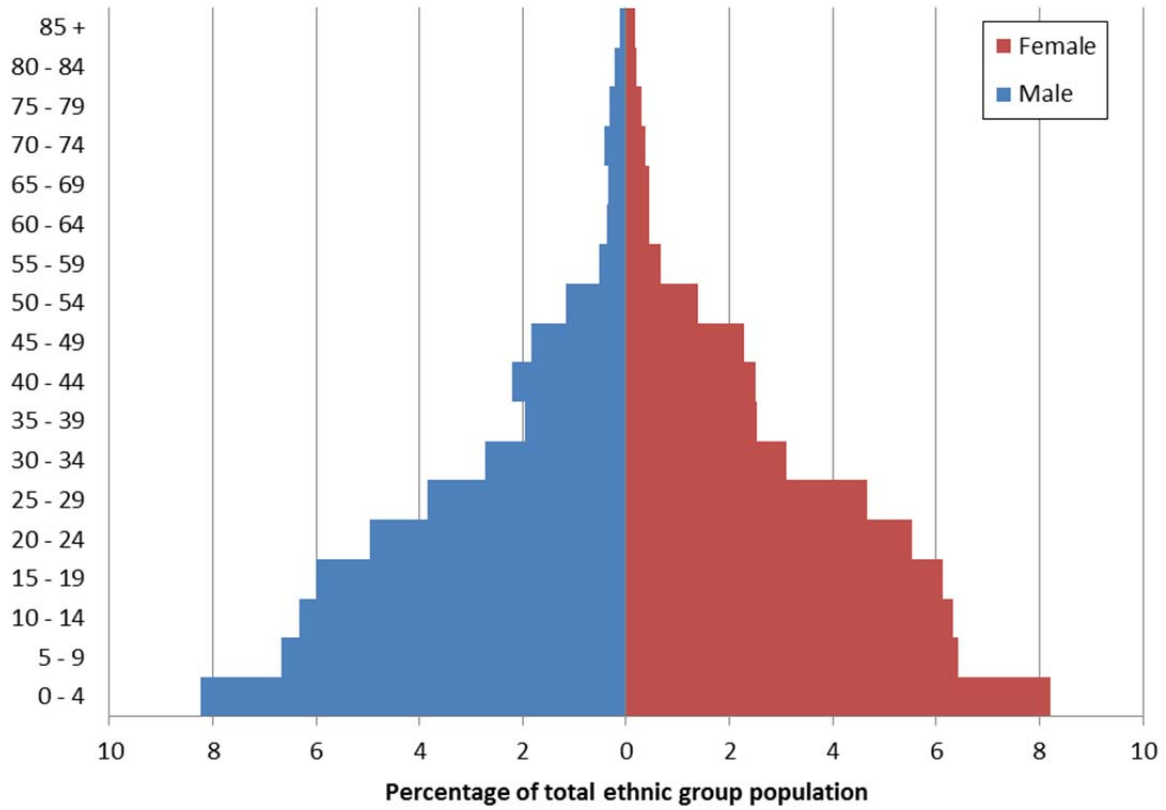

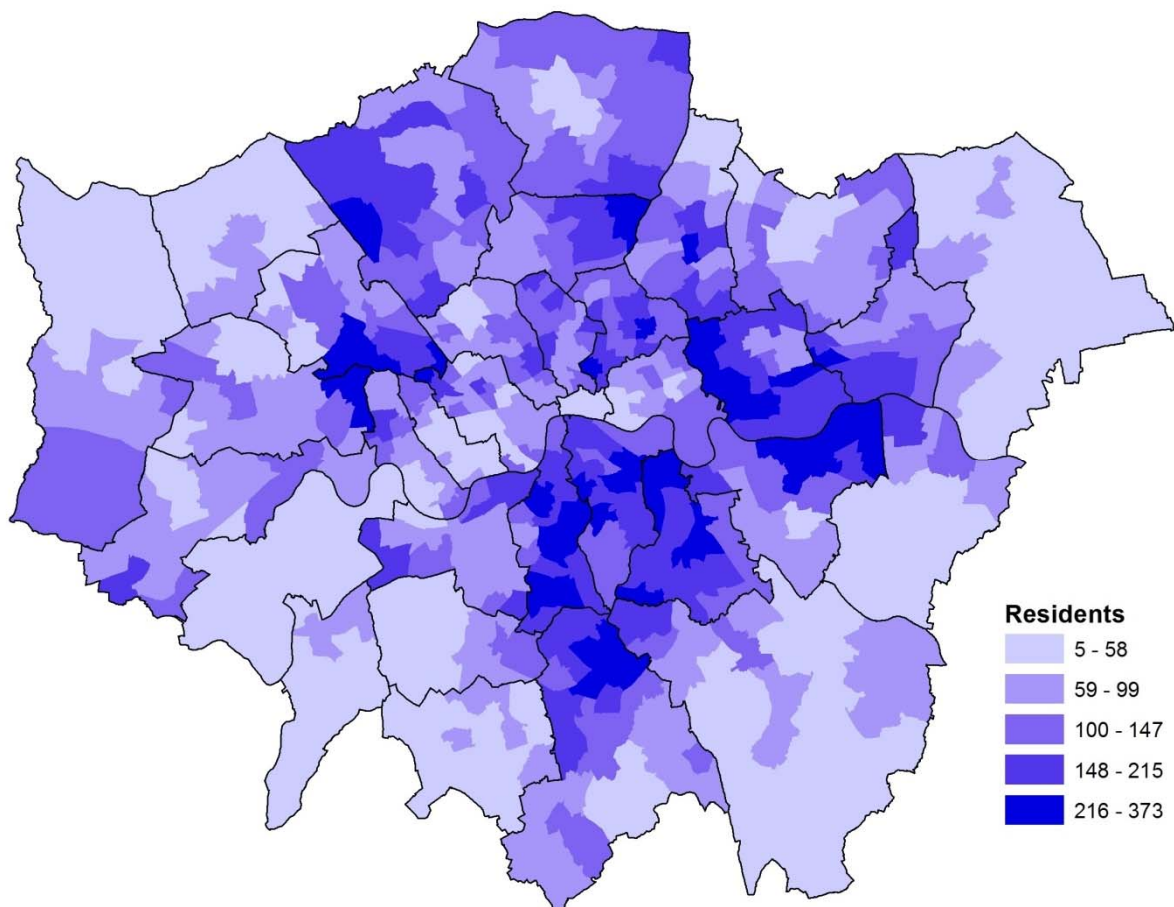

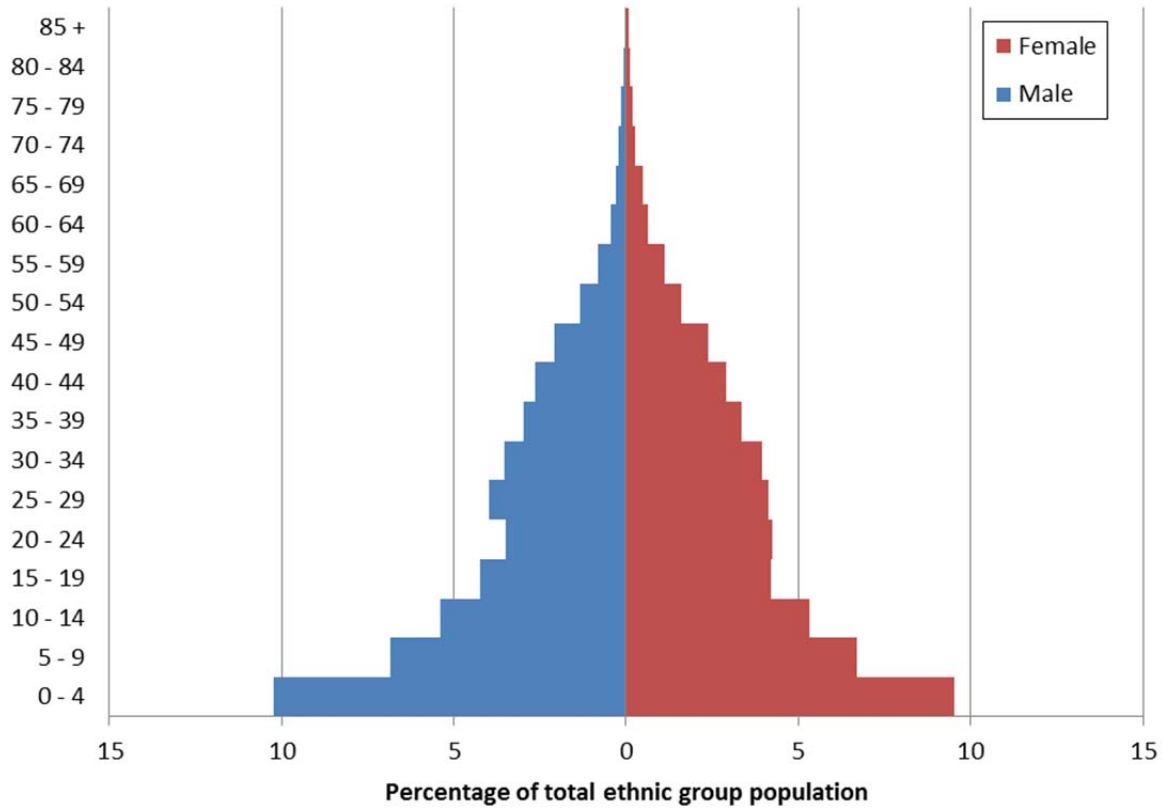

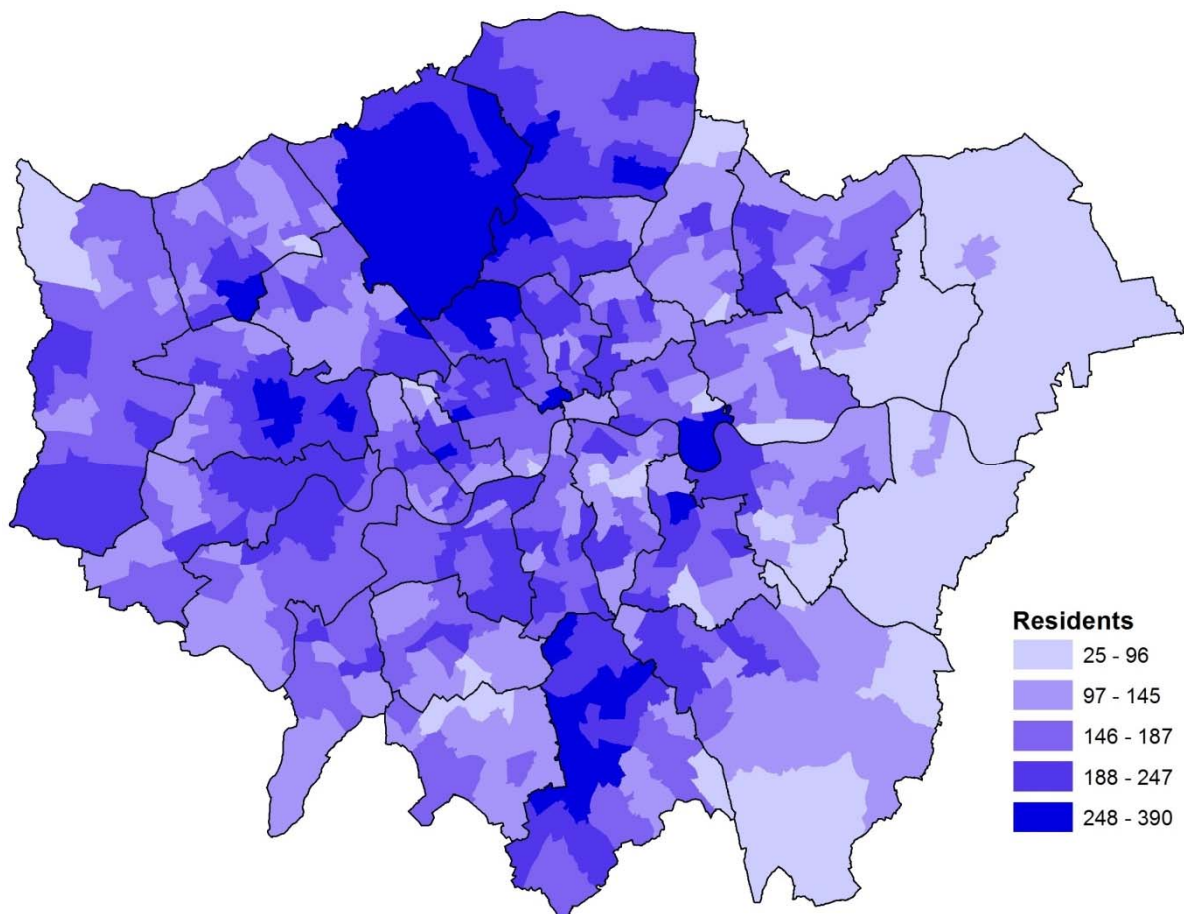

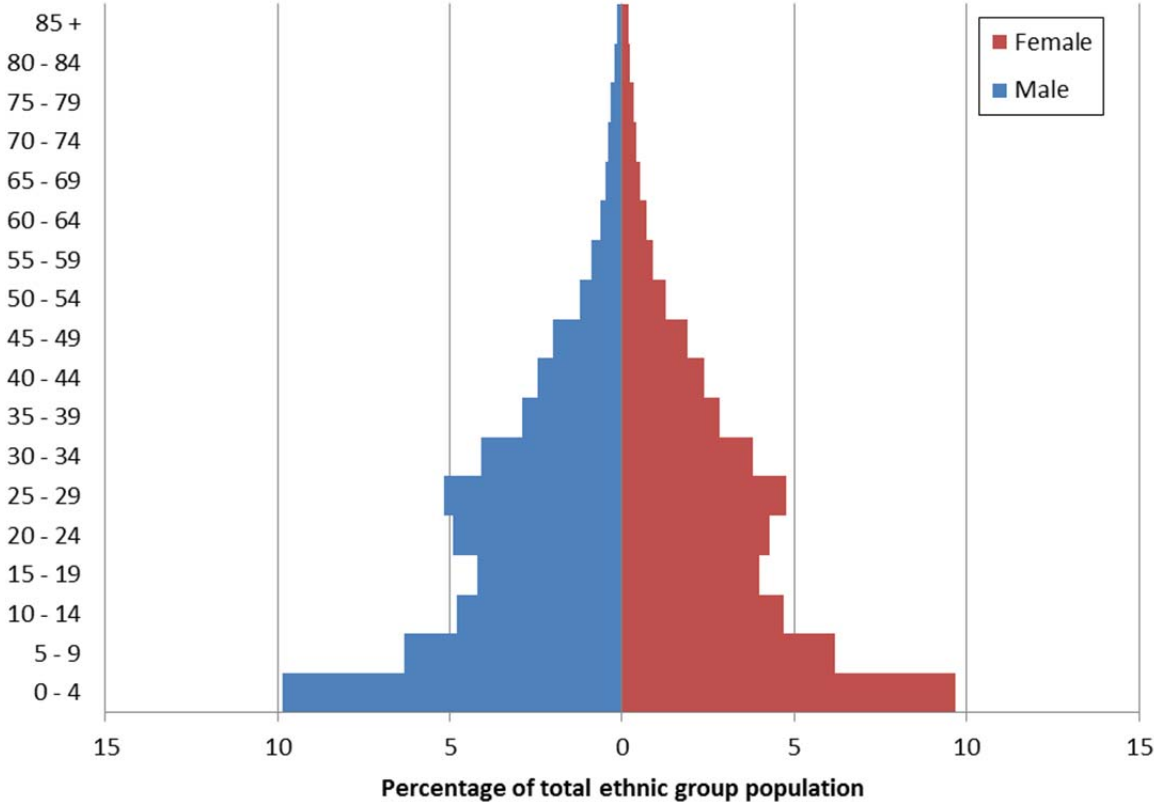

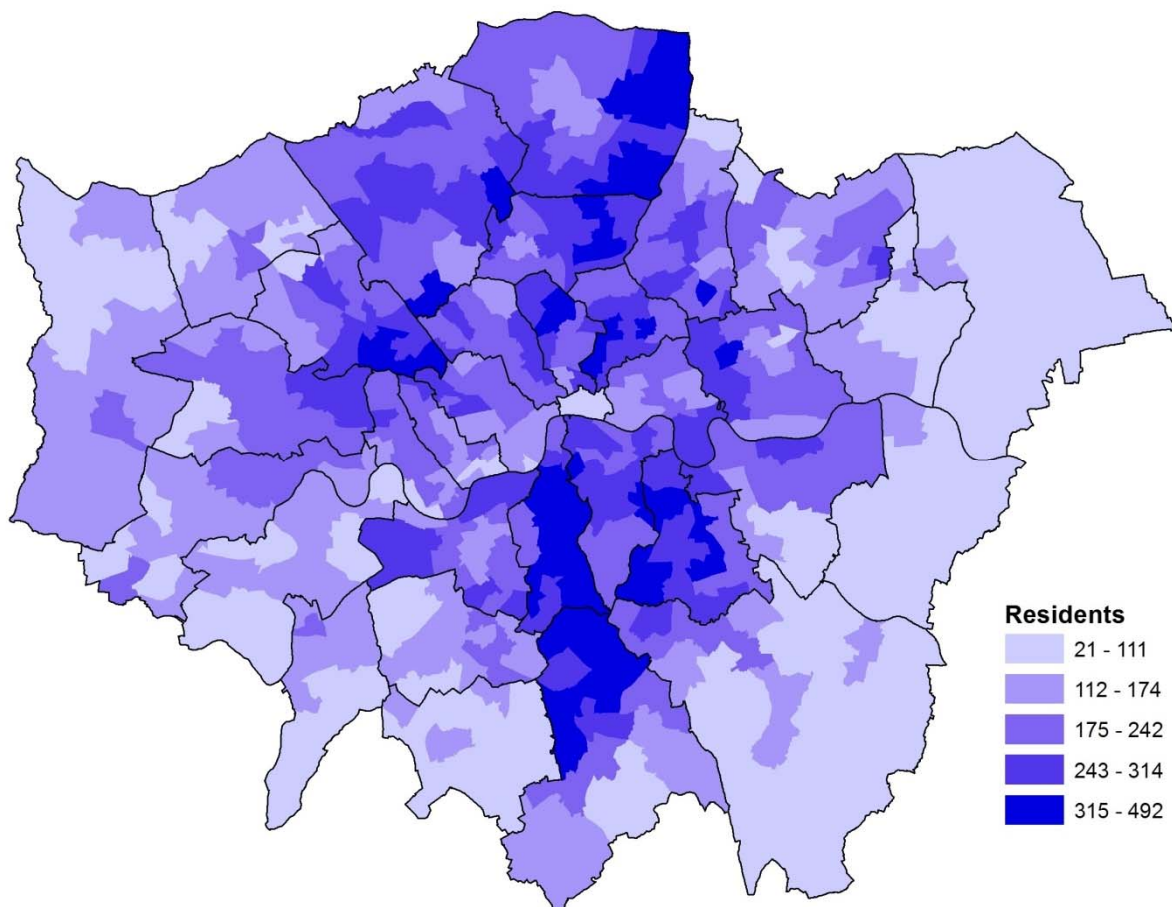

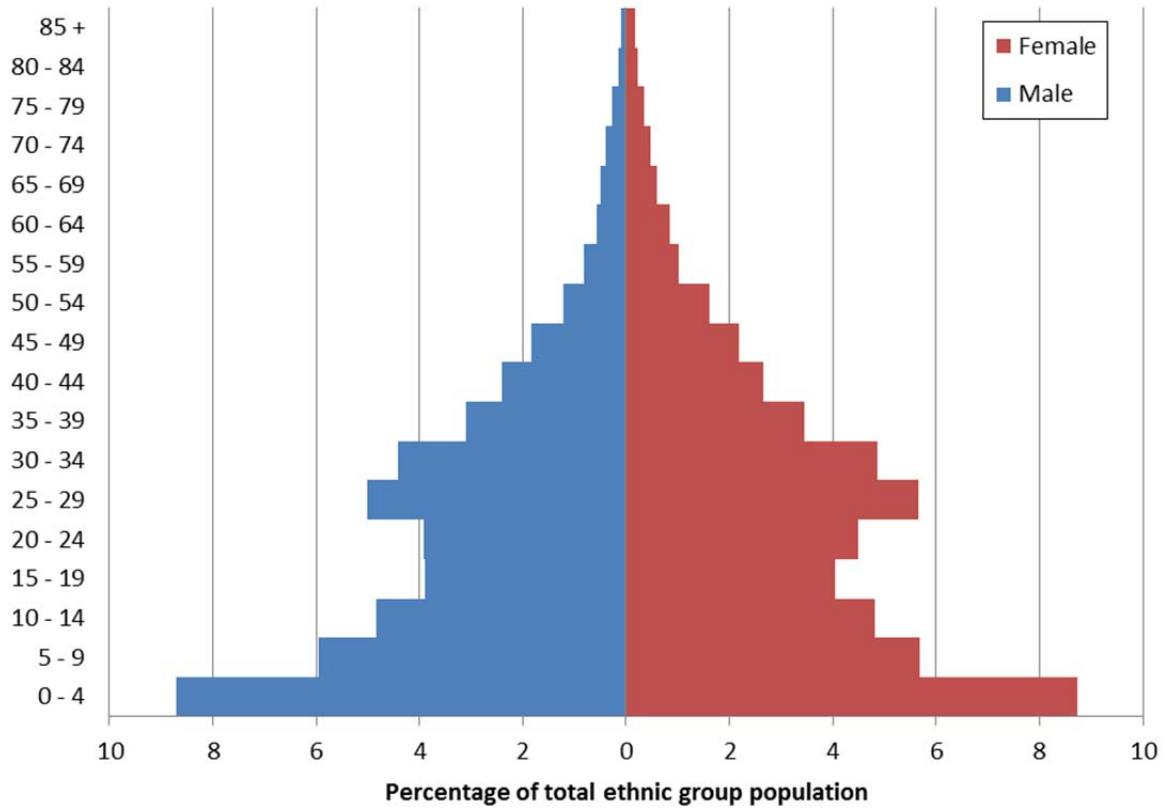

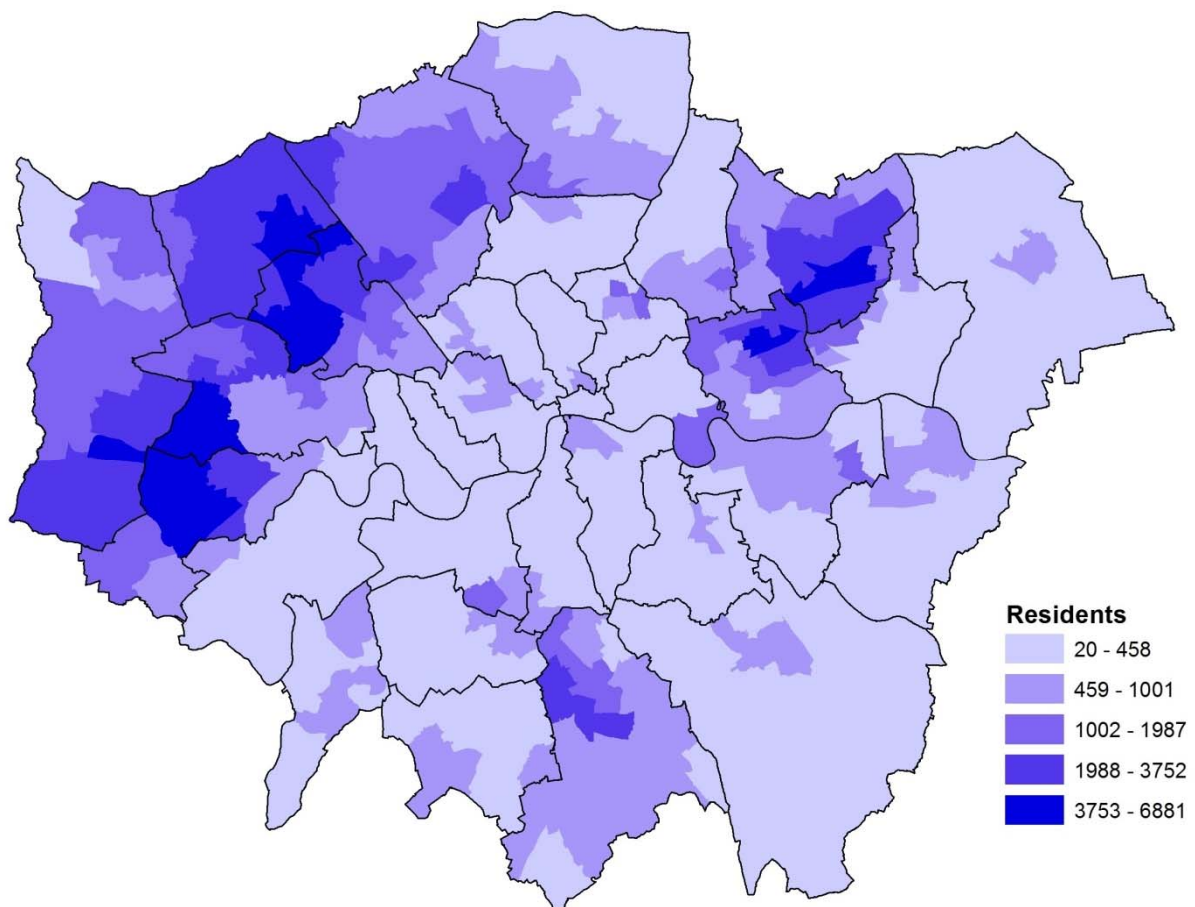

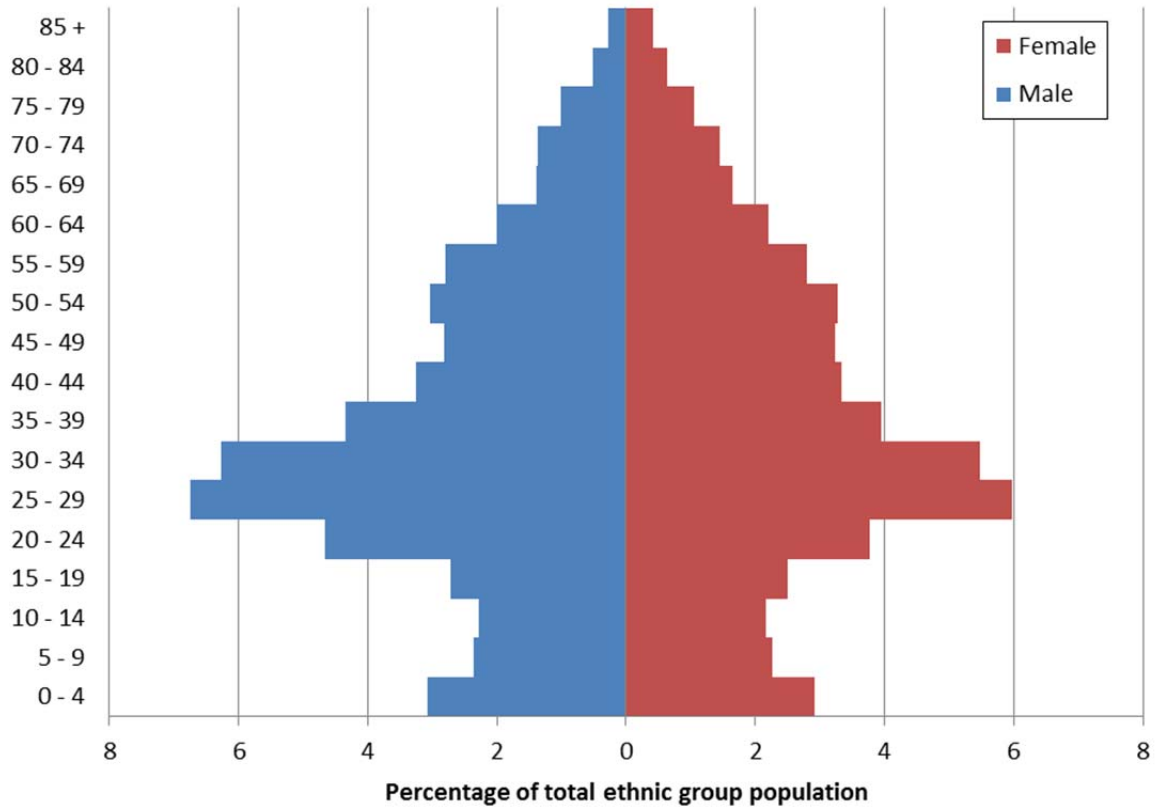

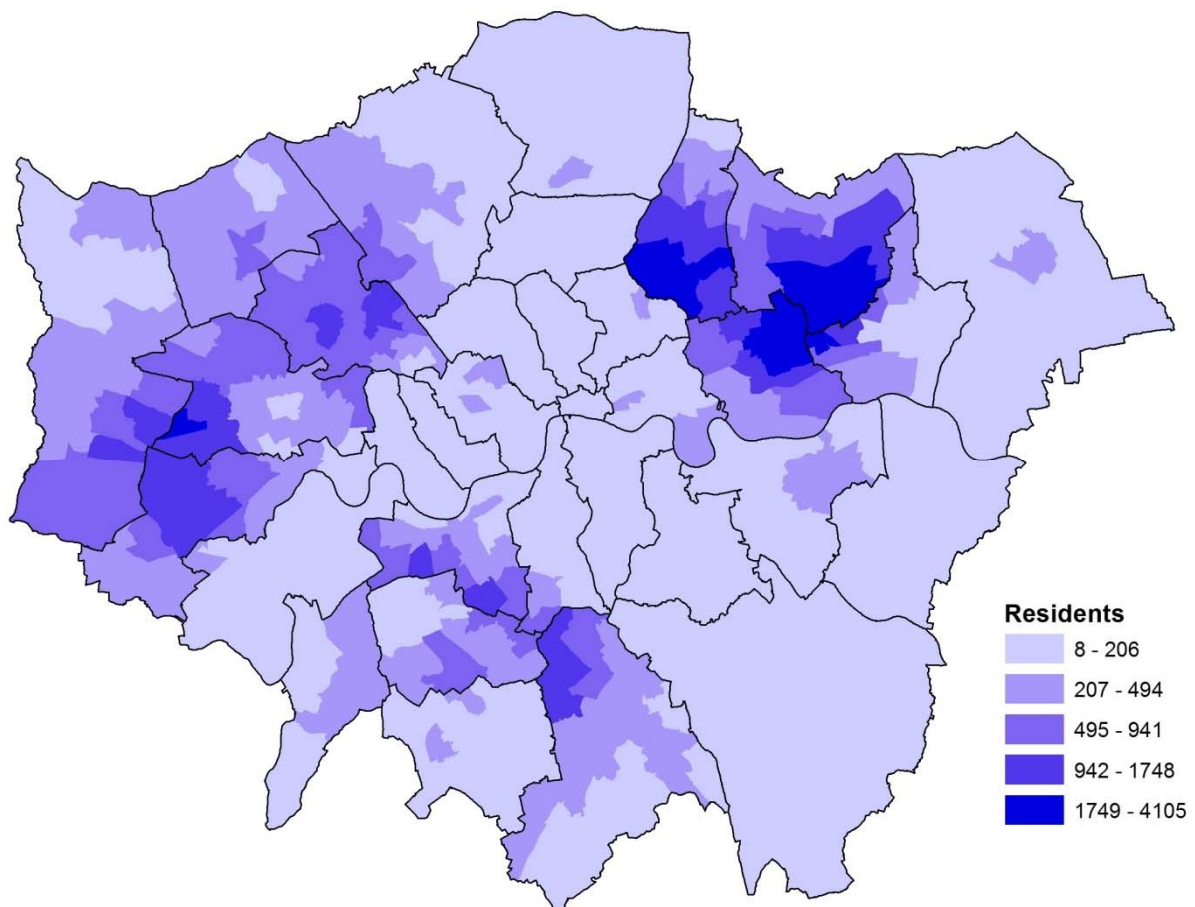

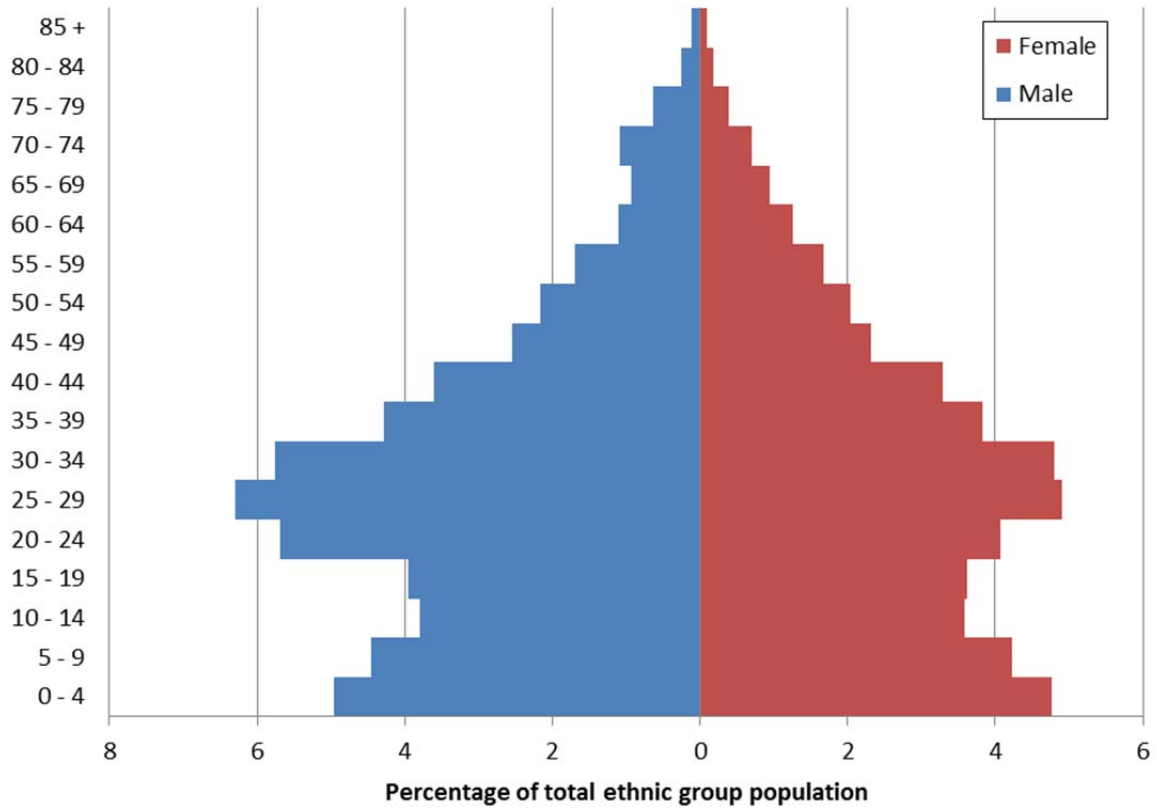

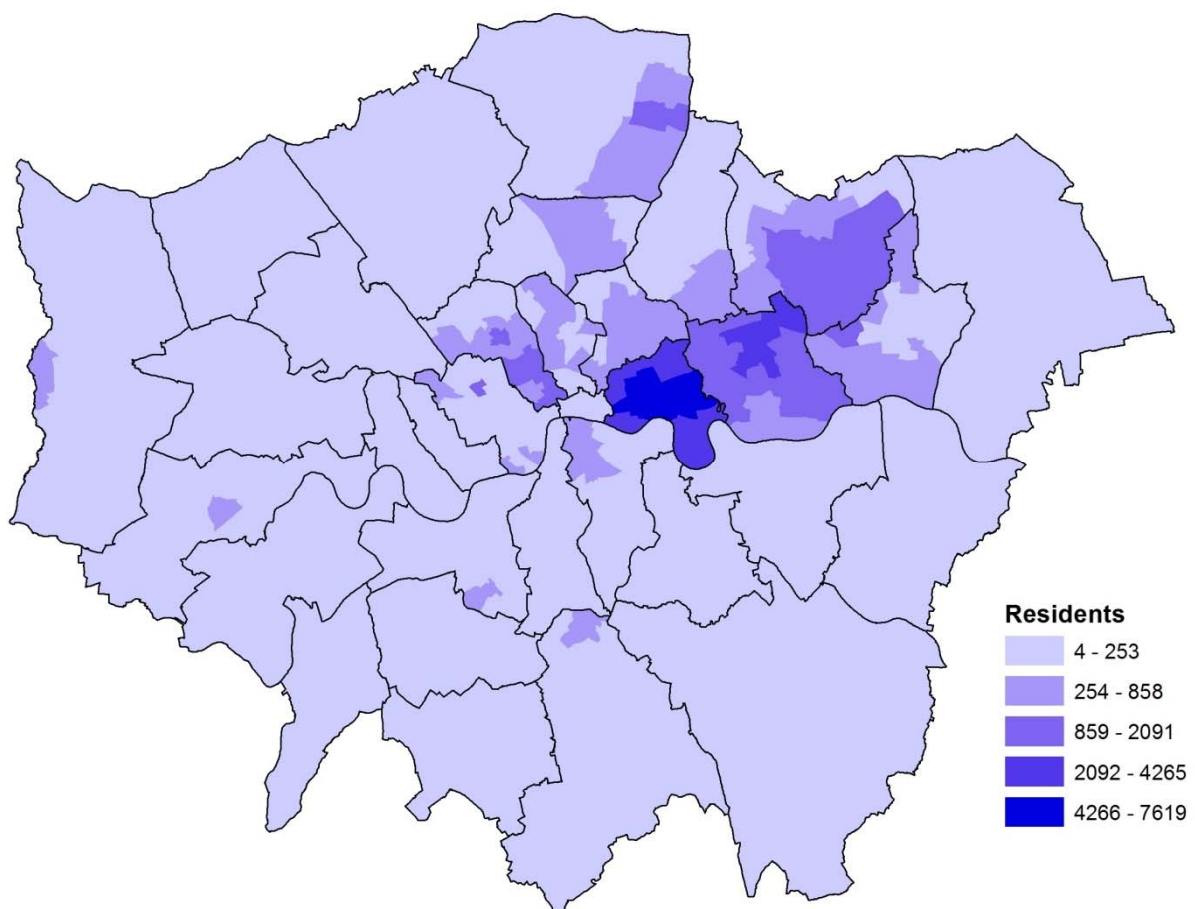

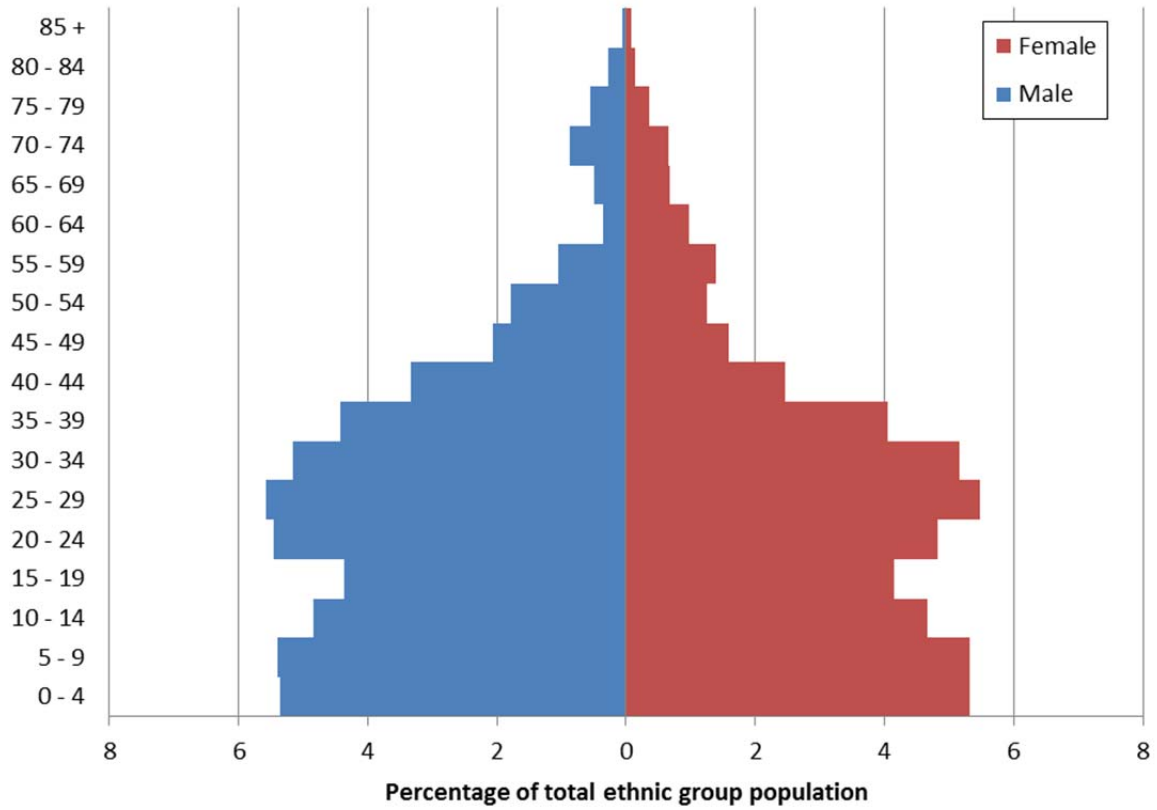

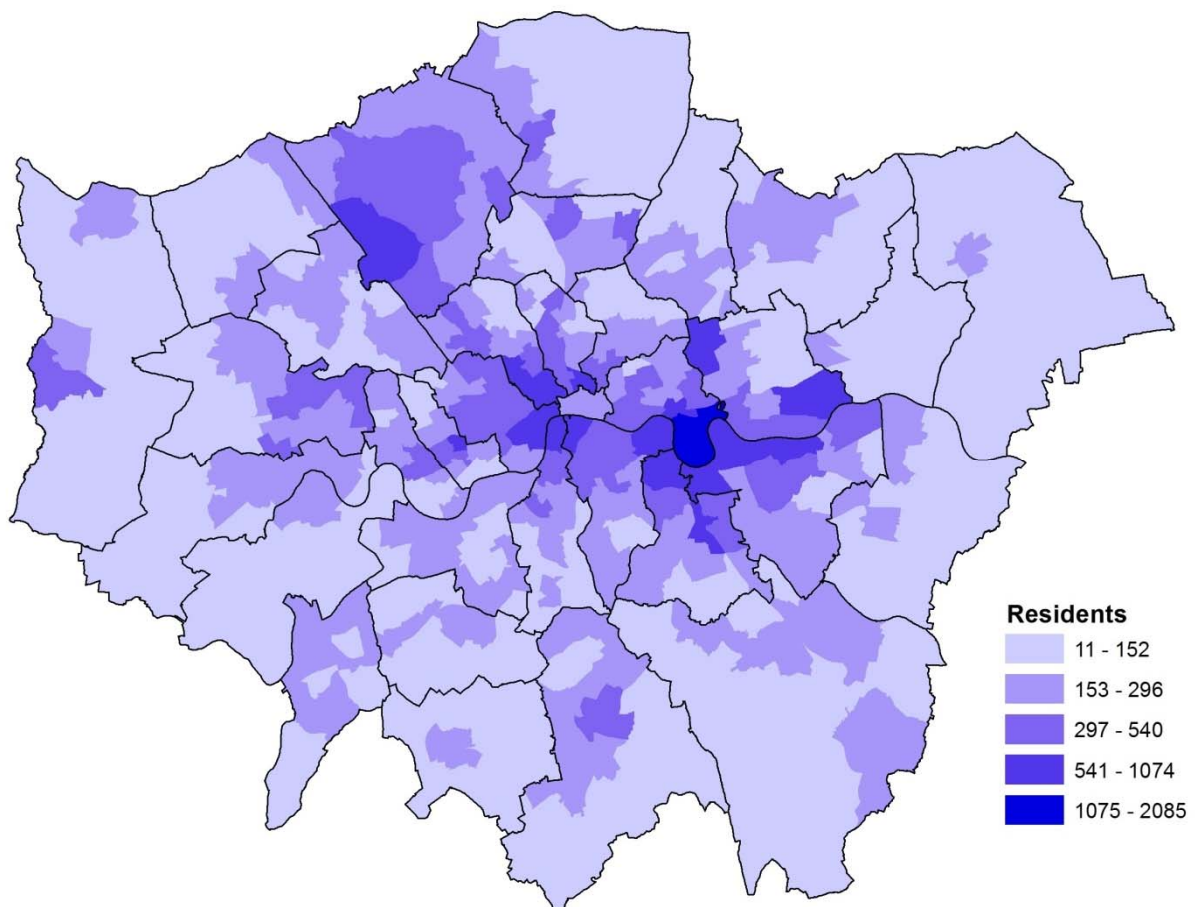

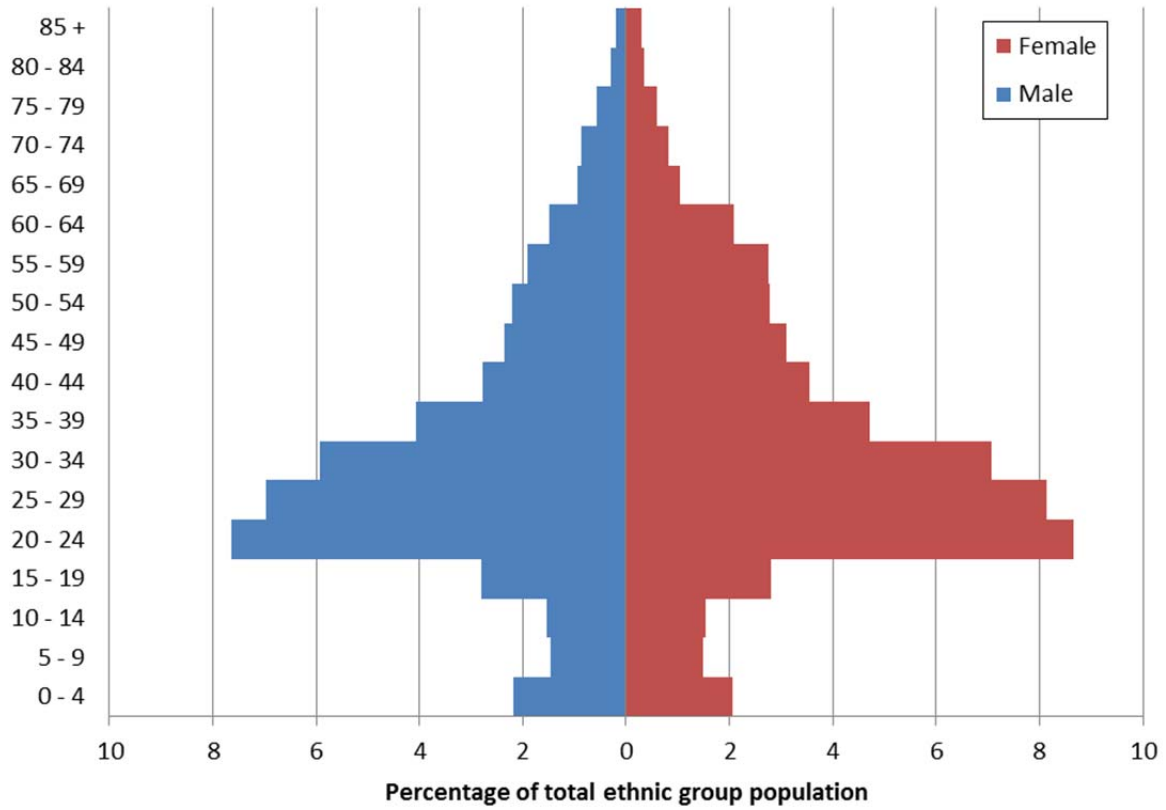

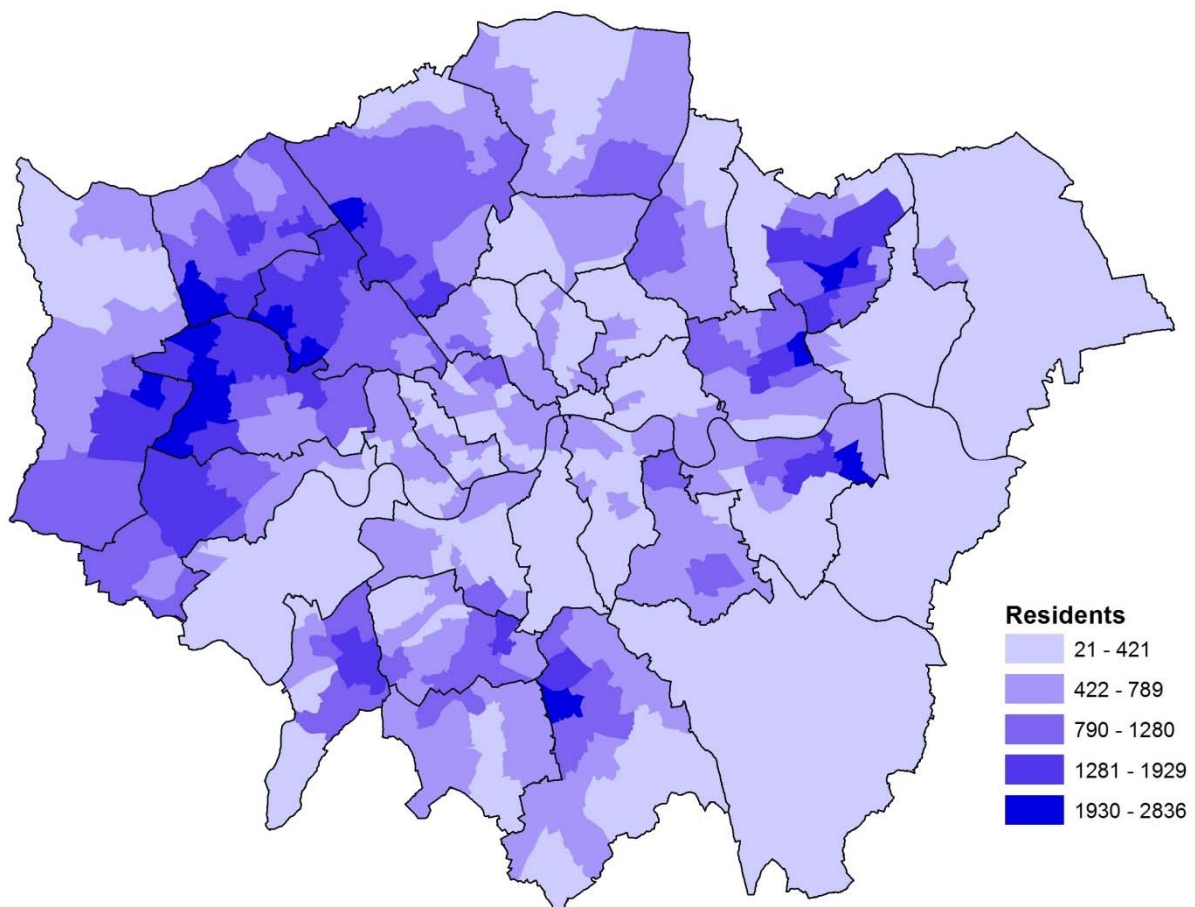

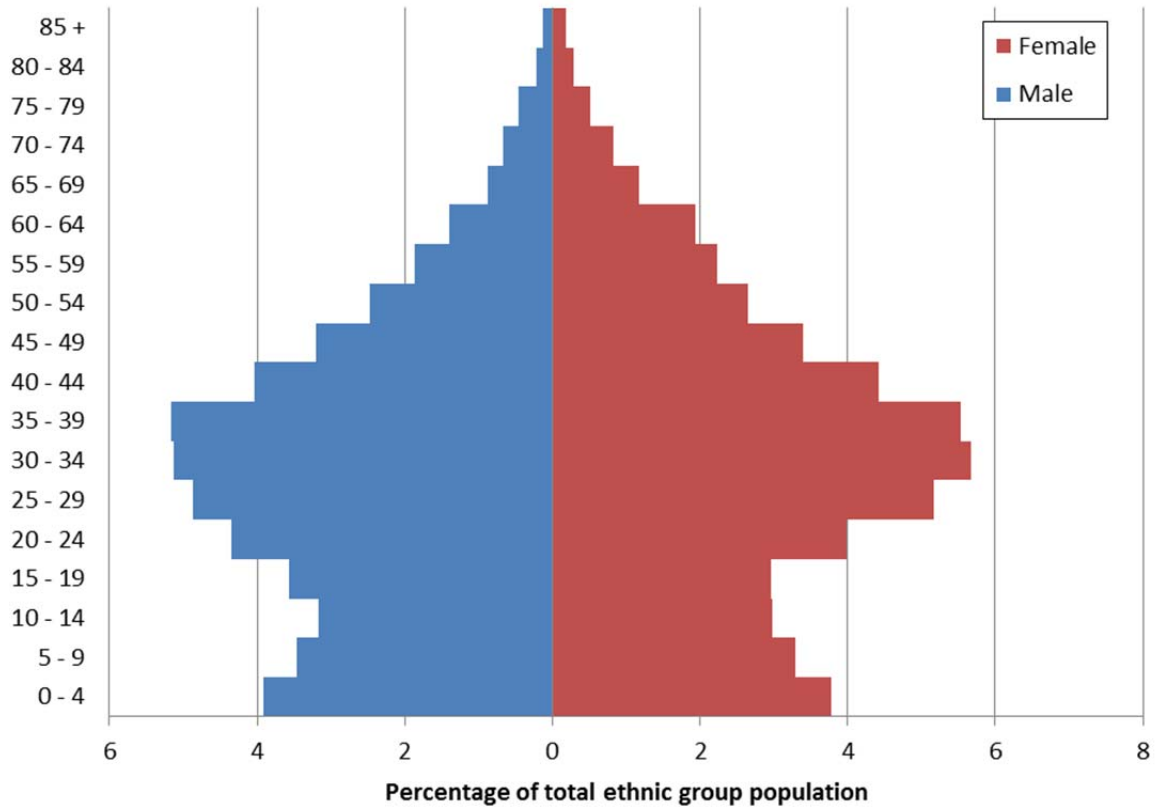

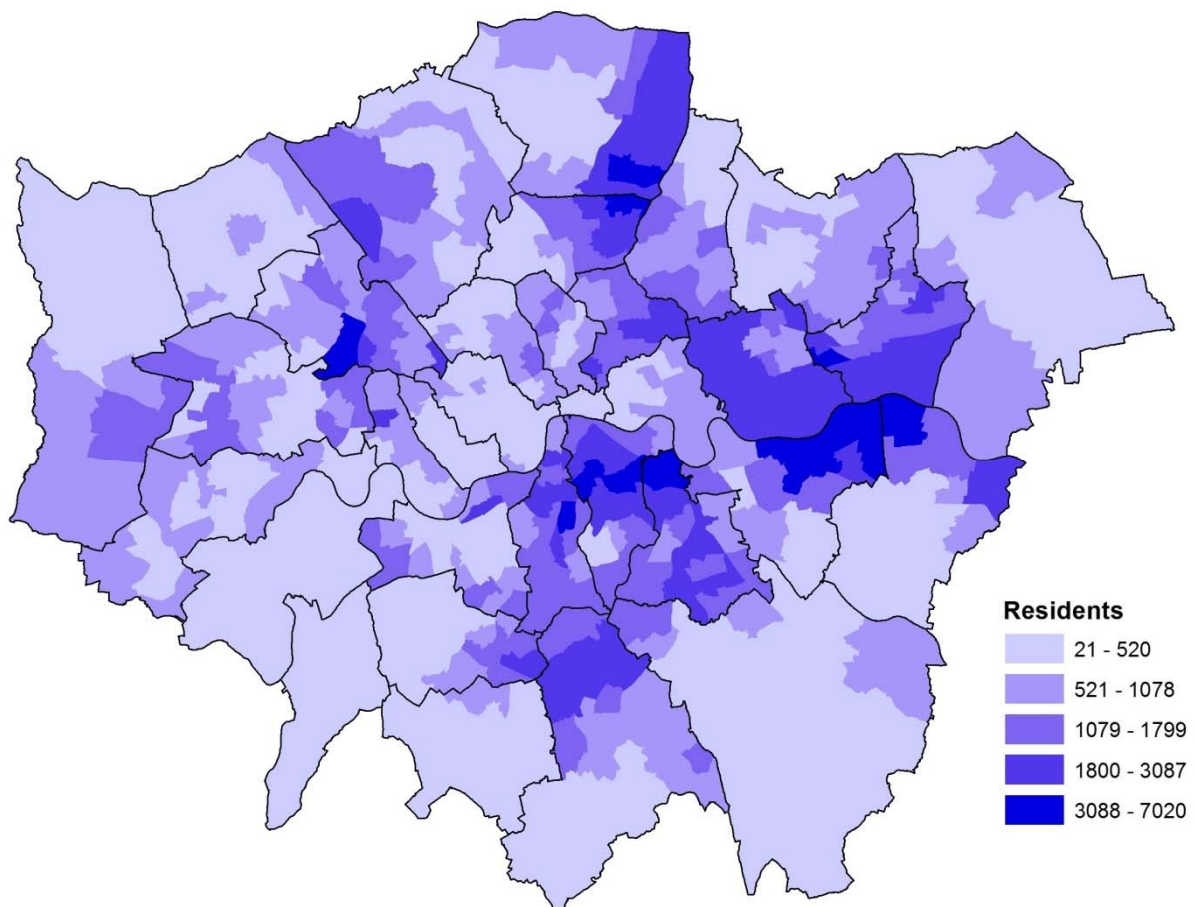

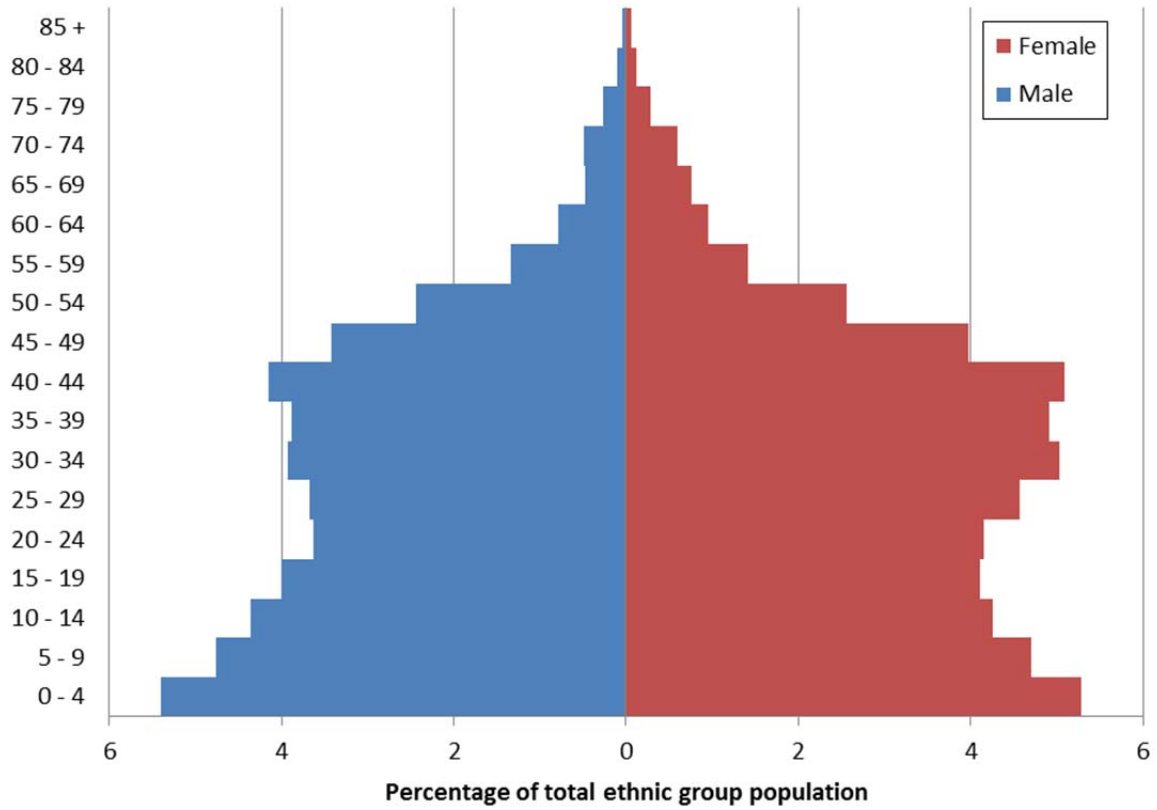

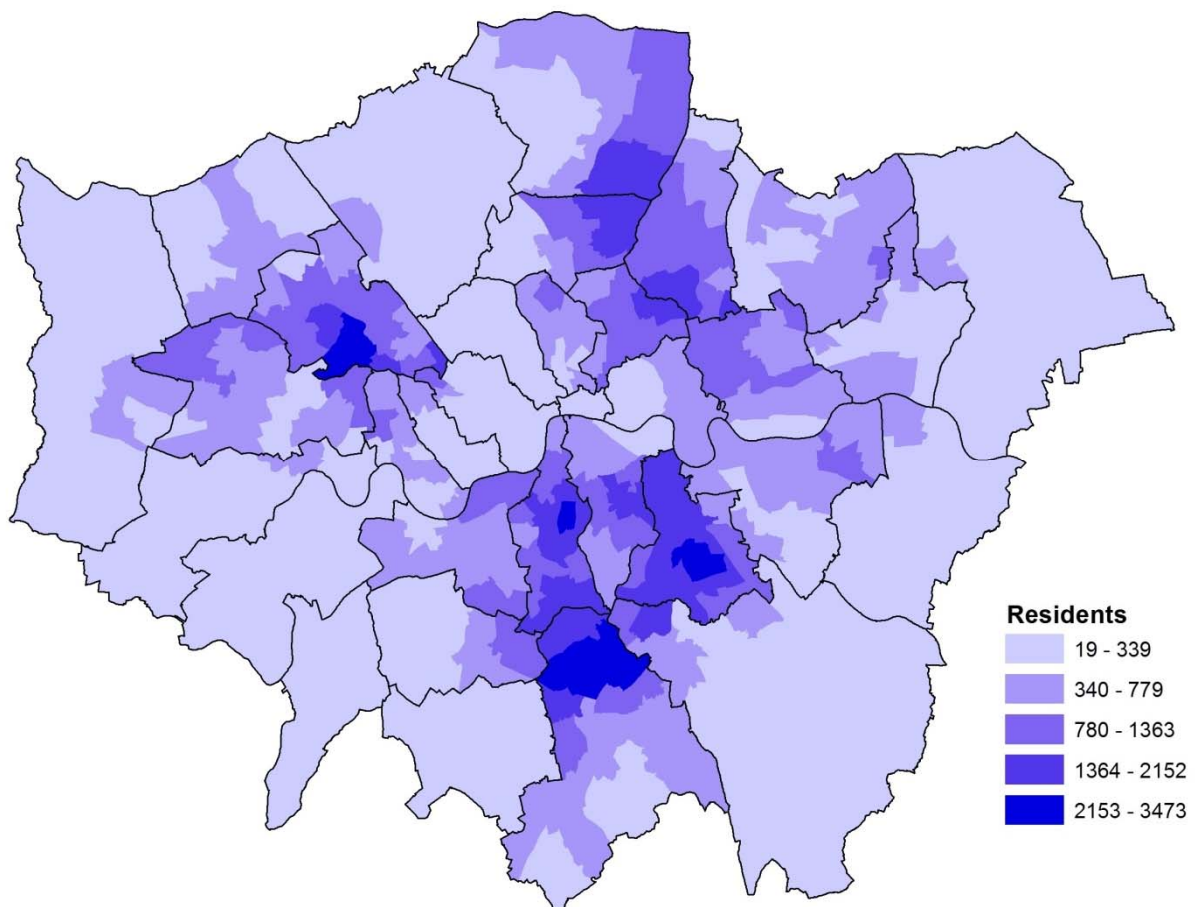

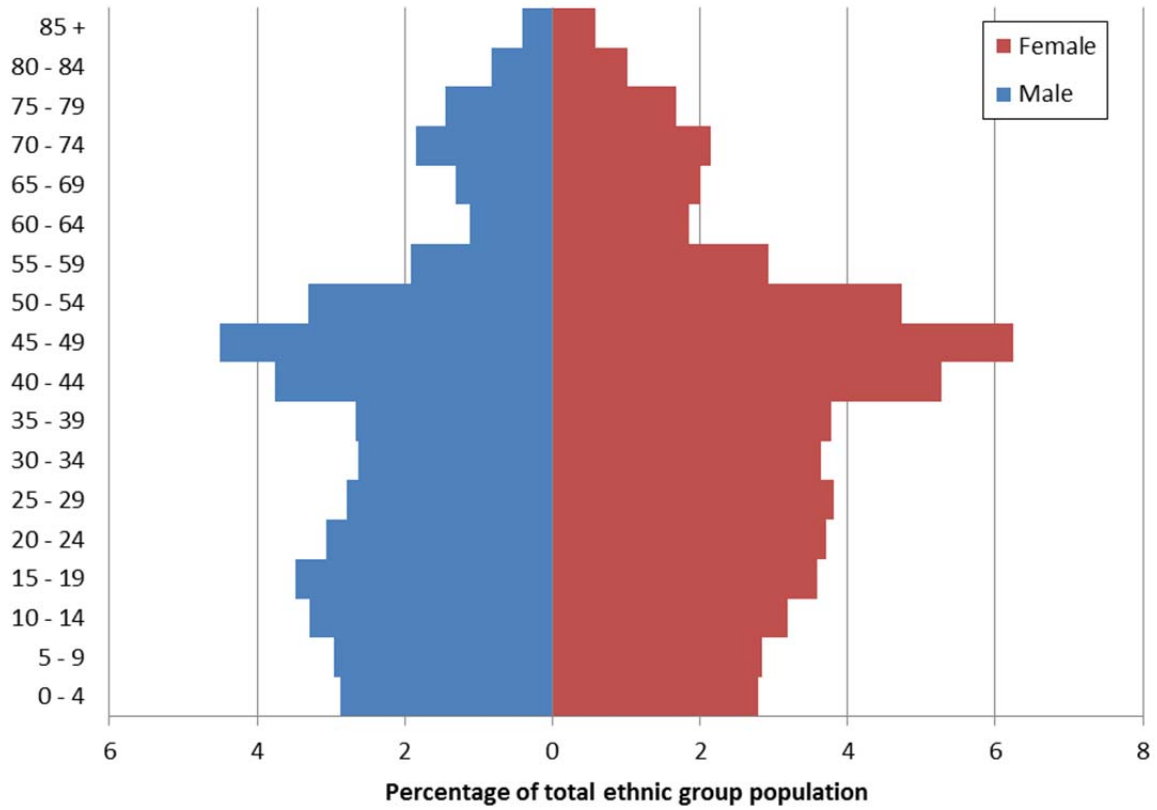

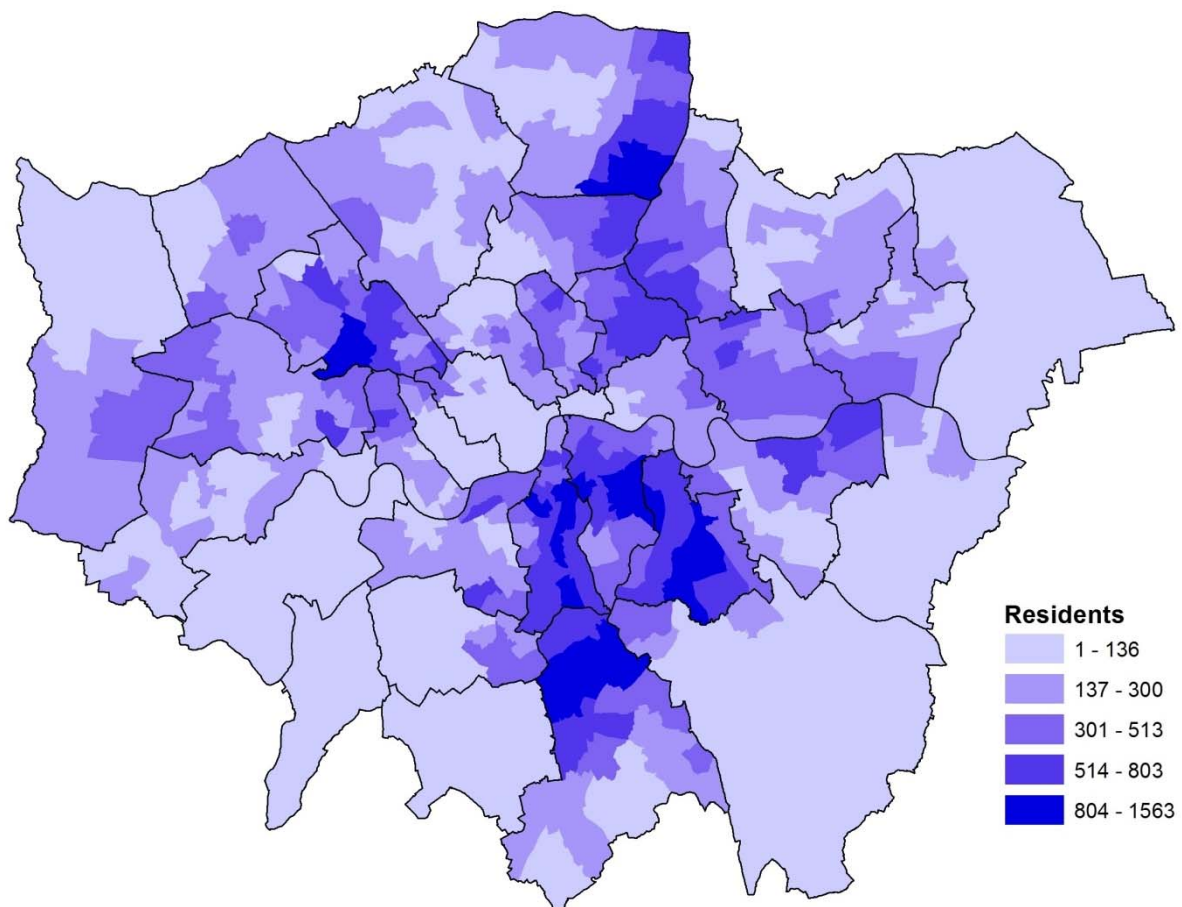

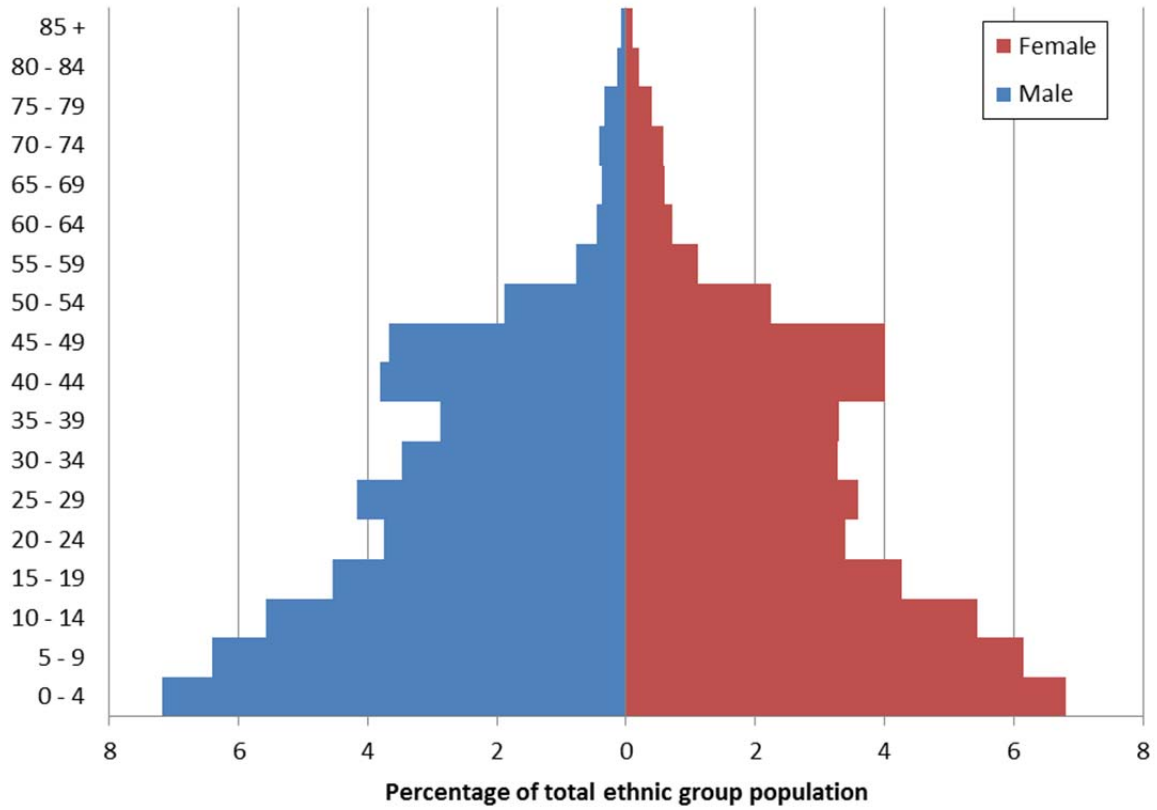

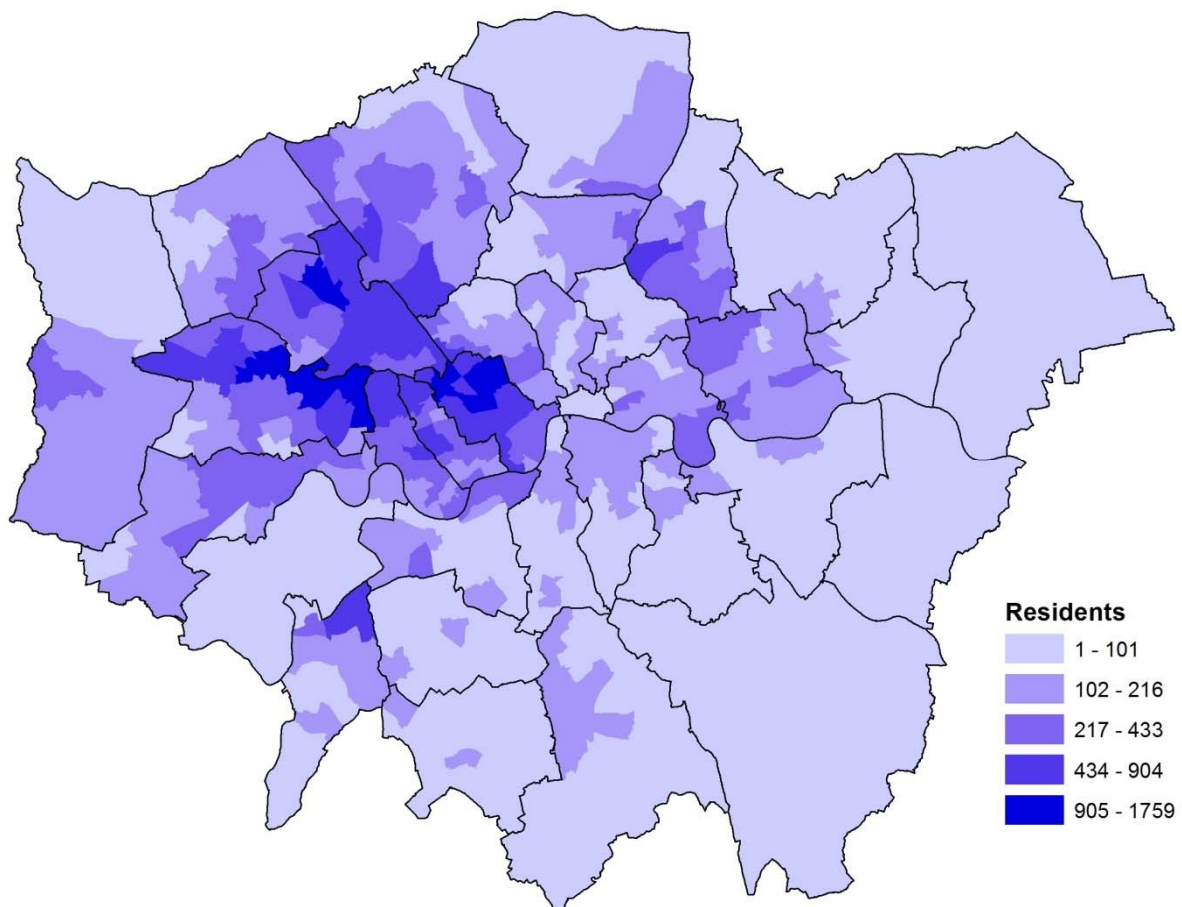

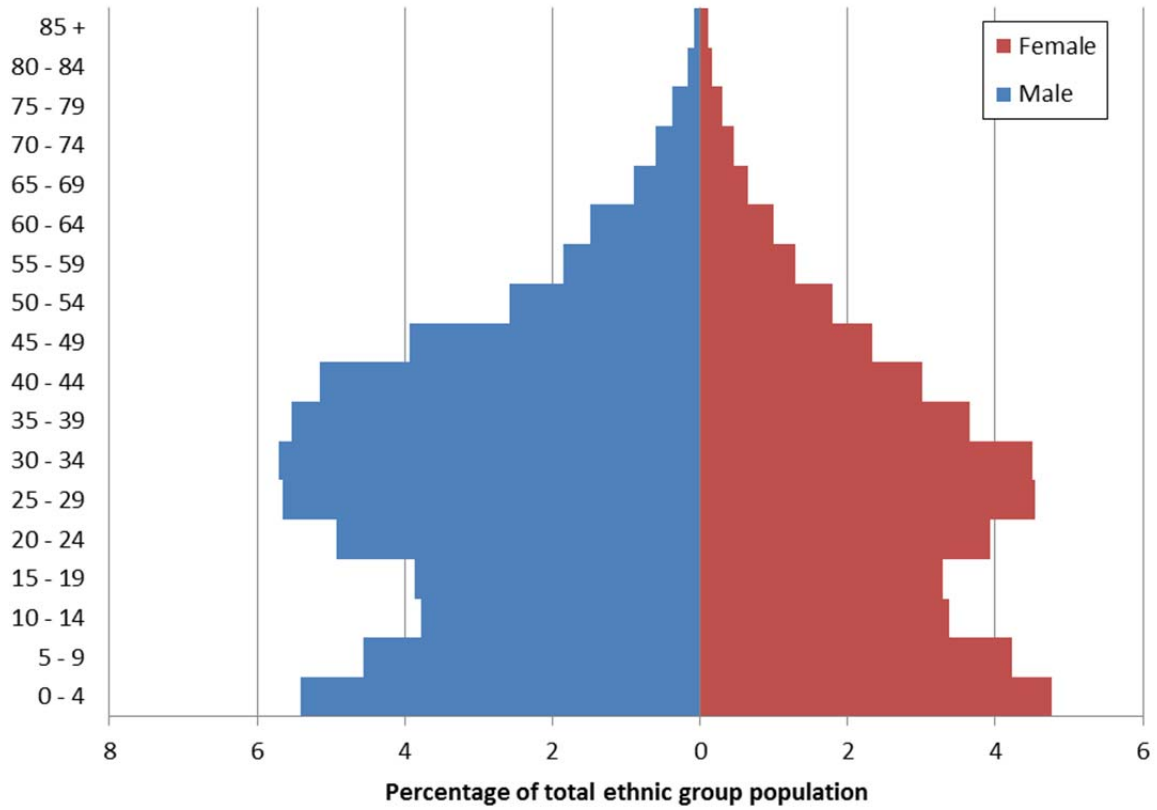

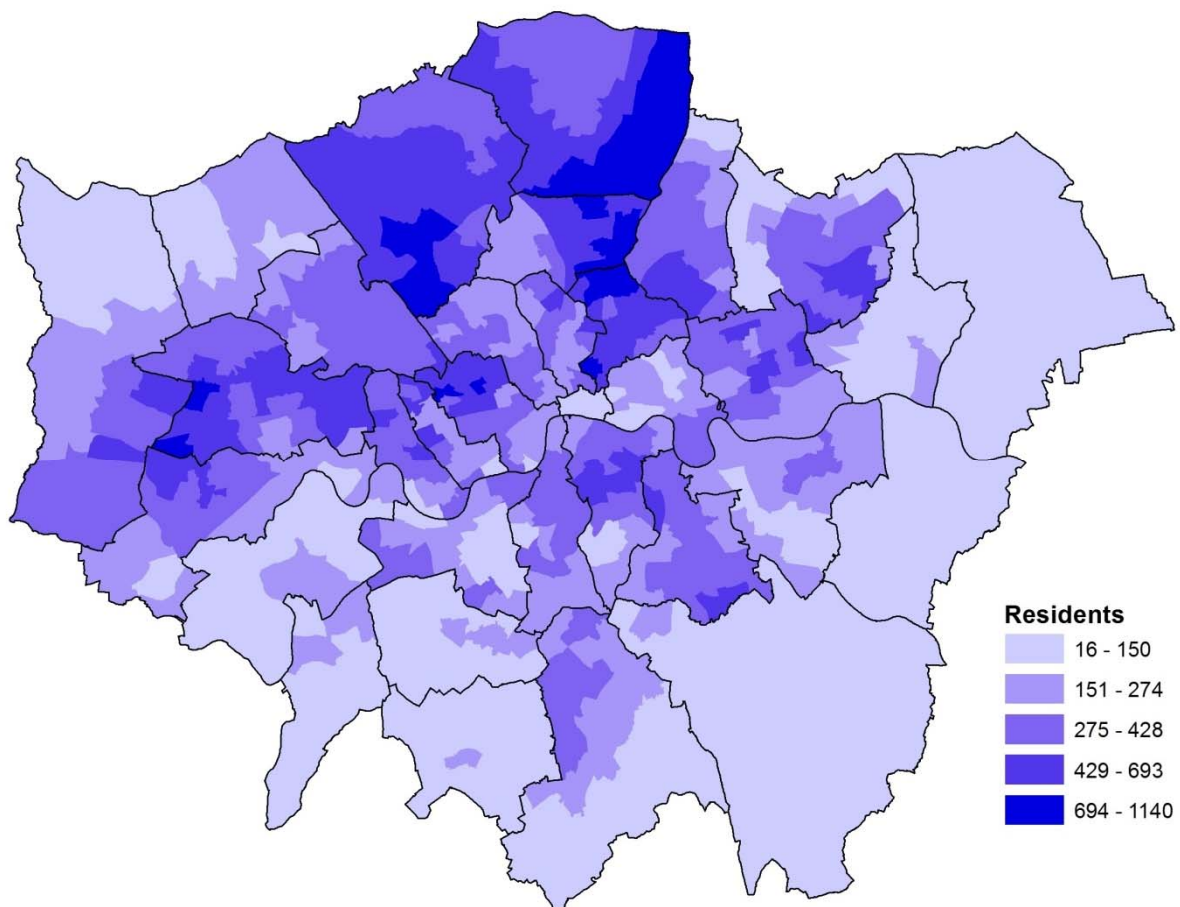

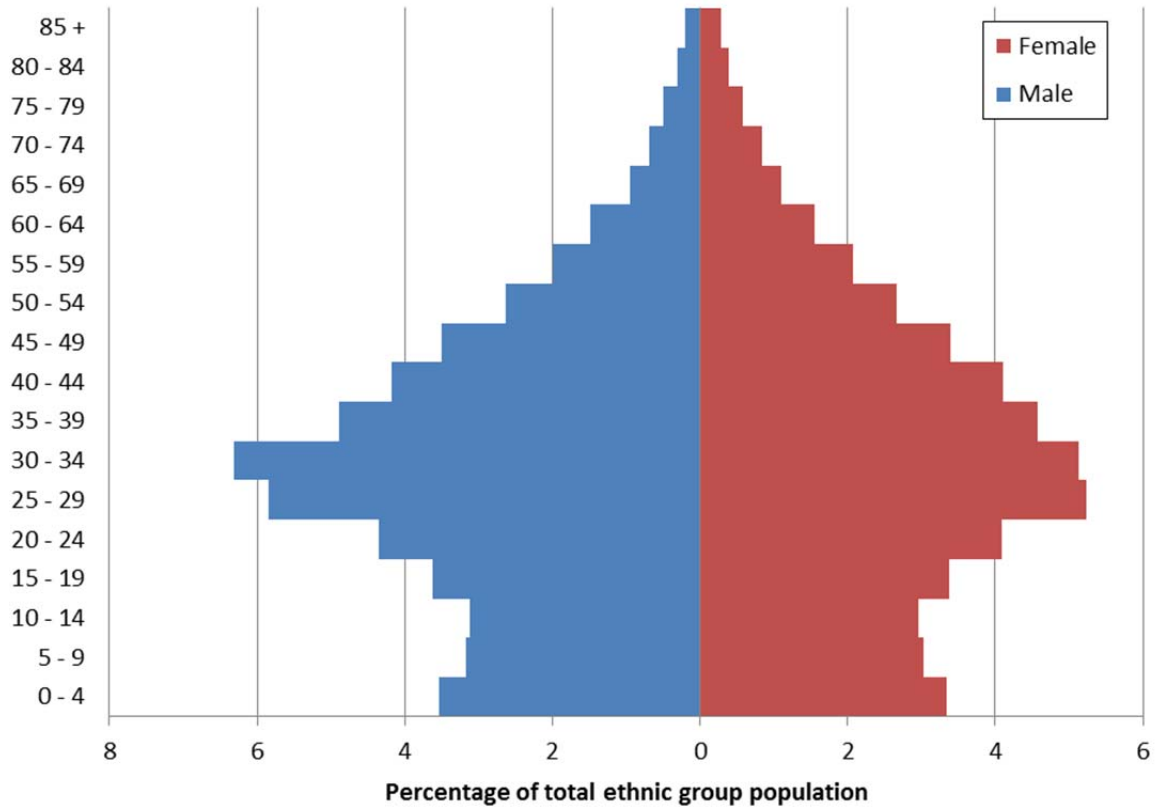

Glossary

Household Reference Person (HRP)

The concept of HRP was introduced for the 2001 Census to replace the traditional concept of 'head of household'. HRPs provide an individual person within a household to act as a reference point for producing further derived statistics and for characterising whole households according to individual characteristics.

NS-SeC

The National Socio-economic Classification is a method of classification which determines an individual's social group based on occupational data.

Occupancy rating

Occupancy rating provides a measure of whether a household's accommodation is overcrowded or under-occupied. There are two measures of occupancy: rooms and bedrooms. This fact sheet uses the more accurate bedrooms measure.

The number of bedrooms required by members of the household is derived using a complex formula which takes into account the age, sex, and relationship of each household member. The number of required bedrooms is subtracted from the number of available bedrooms to produce an occupancy rating.

Persons

In this fact sheet 'persons' is synonymous with 'all usual residents'. A usual resident is an individual who was resident, or intended to be resident, for over 12 months at the time the census was taken.
