

Thank you for your letter of 25 February 2016 March 2016 and the follow up letter of 2 March 2016. The GLA has taken the opportunity of responding to the DCO application and has made both a written representation and Local Impact Report (LIR). Both responses detail higher level strategic matters.

The GLA is also in the midst of finalising a Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) with the applicant- North London Waste Authority and will be submitting a signed SoCG to meet your deadline of the 6 April 2016.

GLA officers have worked alongside Transport for London (TfL) as it is one of the three functional bodies which form part of the GLA organisation. However, please note that whilst strategic planning matters for transport are addressed in the LIR, TfL will be making individual submissions to yourself as it has specific land-take concerns. TfL also has responses to provide to the first written questions which you issued on 2 March 2016 which did not concern the GLA.
