I refer to your letter of 15 September 2011 requesting that I make a decision under section 252 of the above Act as to whether, in the special circumstances of the case, it is necessary to hold an inquiry into the proposed stopping up of College End/Grove End.

On 19 December 2011, I considered a report on the proposal (reference PDU/2852/01). A copy of the report is attached in full.

Having considered the report, I have concluded that the stopping up order will be in accordance with the statutory requirements under Section 247 of the Act in that the Order is necessary to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Act.

Under Section 252(5A) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, I have decided that special circumstances in this case have not been demonstrated and the holding of an inquiry is necessary. This letter is to notify Camden Council of this decision.
