

## View as existing

- This view is taken Upper North Street, at the junction with Ricardo Street. It lies within the Lansbury CA. The view looks north-east, in the direction of the Site, which lies some 795m from this viewpoint. The foreground of the view takes in the highway at this junction and modern blocks of flats lying either side of Ricardo Street those seen on the left side of the image lie outside the CA. The upper levels of Balfron Tower can just be glimpsed in the distance, to the left of centre in the image.
- 6.221 People in this location are likely to be residents and workers.
- 6.222 This is a view of **low to medium** sensitivity.

6.223 The Proposed Development would not be visible in this view. There would be **no effect**.


## View as proposed with cumulative schemes

6.224 A cumulative scheme at Chrisp Street would terminate the view at the end of the street. Taking this into account, the Proposed Development would have **no effect** on this view.

## View as existing

- 6.225 This viewpoint is located on the corner of Cordelia Street and Giraud Street. It looks north-east, along Cordelia Street, in the direction of the Site, which lies some 635m from this viewpoint. The buildings seen in this view date to the post-war period or later. The view is terminated by Glenkerry House (grade II LB) seen in the centre of the image.
- 6.226 People in this location are likely to be residents and workers.
- 6.227 This is a view of **low** sensitivity.
