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# Methodology

This study was conducted in London via OnLineBus, an Internet omnibus survey.

1. **SAMPLE SIZE**

A sample of 1005 London adults aged 16+ were interviewed.

2. **INTERVIEWING**

Interviewing was conducted by online self-completion from 22<sup>nd</sup> May to 27<sup>th</sup> May 2014.

3. **WEIGHTING**

The sample has been weighted to represent the adult population of Londoners 16+

4. **LOW BASES**

Where unweighted base figures are less than 100, data should be treated cautiously, as large margins of error are possible.

5. **ABBREVIATIONS USED**

- = 0%

\* = less than 0.5%
