Dance performance venues

Definition: Buildings which are used for dance performances. These are only included if they can be attended or booked by the public.

Overview

The number of dance performance venues has experienced a 1% decrease, going from 200 to 196 sites with 8 sites closing and 4 new sites opening. Dance performance venues have been more stable than the performing arts sector generally with a lower rate of closures (4% vs 10%) and lower rate of openings (2% vs 6%). Like theatres, dance performance venues are concentrated in the West End and Central London, although new openings are all in East London. These include the Mulryan Centre for Dance, Talent House and Studio 3 Arts. Mayoral funding supported the opening of Talent House and Studio 3 Arts.
