

GLA 2007 Round Labour Force Projections - Correction

The projections of the resident labour force that form part of the GLA 2007 Round of demographic projections have been found to contain an error.

The programme failed to pick up the population of females aged 29.

The projections have been rerun and this *Update* gives corrected versions of Tables A3 and A6 as found in *DMAG Briefing 2008-07: GLA 2007 Round Demographic Projections*.

The difference is that the estimated resident labour force of London in 2001 is 3.700 million rather than 3.643 million. In PLP High the resident labour force increases by 592 thousand between 2006 and 2026 rather than 590 thousand. In PLP Low there is no difference in the increase: 451 thousand.
