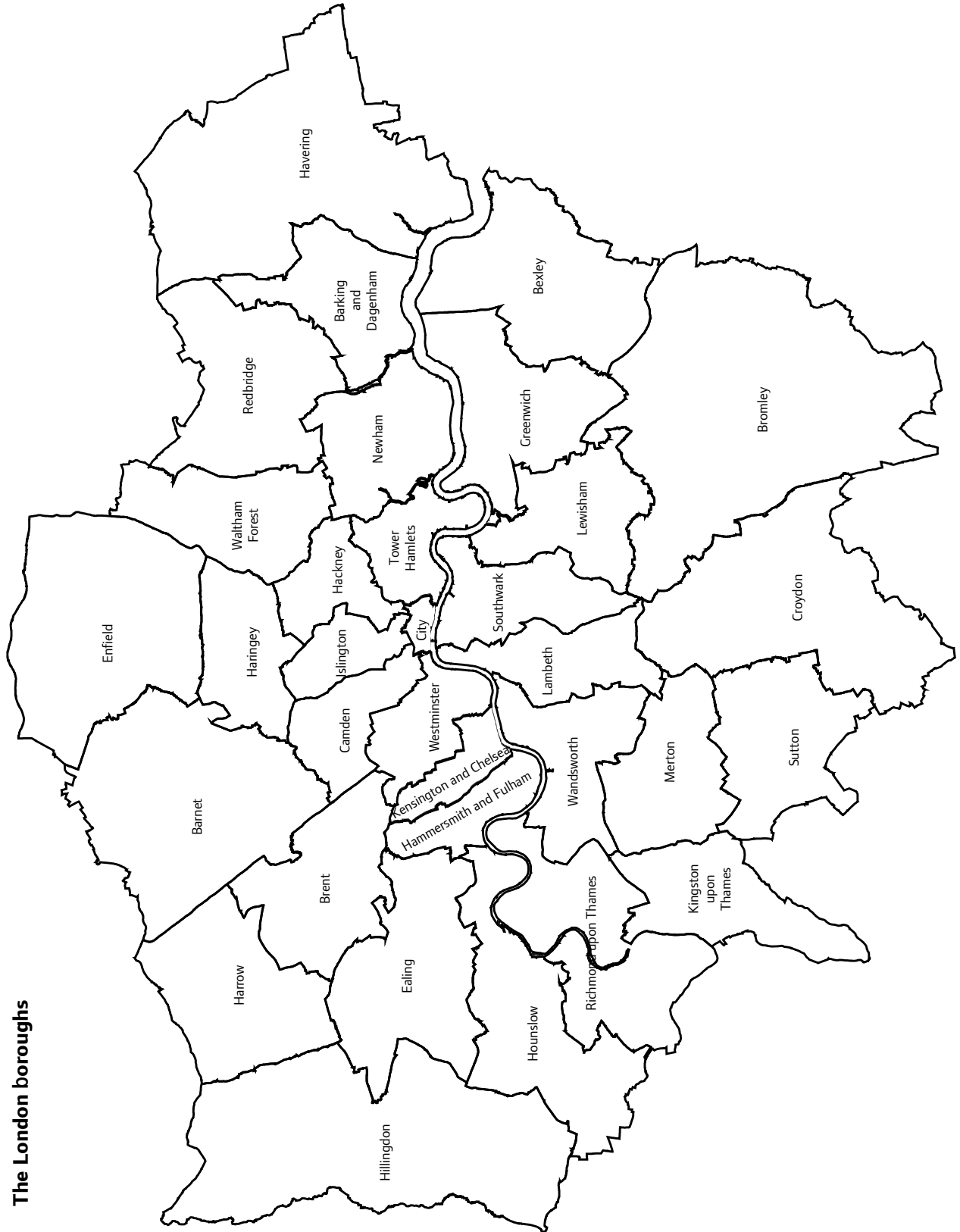

## The London boroughs



## Introduction

The aim of this briefing is to provide detailed information about where Londoners were born. Most Londoners were born in the United Kingdom (UK), this report also shows that people born in a range of other countries are also present in most London boroughs.

The 2001 Census question on country of birth offered a choice of six tick boxes and a section for a self defined response. Five of the tick boxes related to England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland. The sixth box was for people born elsewhere and respondents were given the opportunity to write in the present name of their country of birth.

This report is based on a 2001 Census commissioned table, C0413 country of birth by local authority district. Information was only made available for countries where at least ten residents were present in an area. This Briefing presents data for London boroughs, Inner London, Outer London and London. The London total was derived from adding the Inner and Outer London figures.

ONS had previously released country of birth information in standard datasets, the most detailed of which is Univariate Table UV008 with data on 81 different countries. The GLA subsequently commissioned a more detailed country of birth table with a threshold of 200 residents, resulting in data for 179 countries of birth. Table C0413 is the most detailed country of birth table currently available at a local authority level, with 243 countries identified as the birthplace of at least ten Londoners. A number of commissioned tables are now available.

The 2001 Census identified 7.1 million people living in London. The vast majority of these residents, 5.2 million (73 per cent), were born in the United Kingdom. When looking at London boroughs the highest percentage of UK born residents is in Havering, 94 per cent. The highest percentages of UK born residents are concentrated in East and South East London: Havering 94 per cent, Bexley 91 per cent, Bromley 90 per cent and Barking and Dagenham 88 per cent. The lowest percentage born in the UK is in Brent at 53 per cent, closely followed by Kensington and Chelsea, and Westminster, both with 55 per cent. Appendix 1 shows the numbers and percentages of Londoners born in the United Kingdom.

There were almost two million Londoners who were born outside the UK. If we look at which continents those born outside the UK were born in, we see that Asia, the largest continent with 30 per cent of the world's landmass and 60 per cent of the world's population, is the birthplace of 635,000 Londoners. The Asian continent includes the Far East, Middle East and South Asia.

Over half a million London residents were born in the rest of Europe, representing more than one in four London residents born outside the UK. Even though the number of London residents from Oceania (71,000) is smaller than the other continents, so is the relative number of inhabitants. The Australians and New Zealanders living in London represent a significantly larger proportion of the population of Australia and New Zealand than people born in other continents. There were a number of Londoners (21,000) who stated they were born elsewhere but did not add any further details. Table 1 shows the full listing of Londoners born outside the UK by continent. Where a significant number are from a subcontinent, further details are provided.

The top 20 countries of birth outside the UK account for 17 per cent of Londoners. The largest group, Indians with 172,000 represents two per cent of London residents. Four South East Asian countries are in the top ten. Other countries to appear in the top 20 include the Republic of Ireland, Germany, Italy, France, Turkey and Cyprus. The number of London residents from countries such as Ghana and Cyprus, both with over 45,000 residents, was not available in earlier tables. A full list of the top twenty countries of birth and the number of residents living in London can be seen in Appendix 2.

In this report we have amalgamated a small number of ONS defined areas:

Channel Islands includes the Channel Islands, Guernsey and Jersey.

Greece includes Greece and Crete.

Spain includes Spain and the Canary Islands.

UK includes England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, Great Britain and the UK.

United Arab Emirates includes the United Arab Emirates, Abu Dhabi and Dubai.

Yemen includes Yemen and Aden.

A number of ONS defined areas are simply remainders, or they were included where insufficient information was stated. See Appendix 3 for a list of these areas, the numbers associated and the number of boroughs in which they appear.

Countries with a small presence in London, and which were present in less than six London boroughs, have been omitted from this Briefing. The numbers of London residents born in these countries are provided without a breakdown at borough level. Appendix 4 shows the full list of countries and the number of boroughs that have met the minimum threshold. Countries highlighted were previously available at borough level.

Westminster has the highest number of different countries of birth, 182 countries have communities with at least ten residents living there. The City of London has the smallest number of countries of birth, at 48. Havering has the second lowest number at 106. Appendix 5 shows the number of different communities present in each London borough in 2001.

Appendix 6 shows boroughs which have more than 25 per cent of all Londoners born in particular countries. For example, 26 per cent of all Londoners born in Cyprus live in Enfield, which is more than 11,800 people. Some of the numbers in the table are too small to be significant.

The following pages show where Londoners, born in 172 different countries, live in London. The two page spreads show a chart for each country with the number of residents in each London borough. For each country the table indicates the number of borough residents born in that country and the proportion of the London total. The London borough figures do not add up to the London total due to suppression in some boroughs. The maps provide an indication of where in London residents born in a particular country live.

The number of bandings shown in each map varies. If the highest concentration is less than 50 residents in a borough there are two bandings, if there are less than 100 residents there are three bandings. There are a number of maps where there are four bandings; these were chosen to show more clearly the patterns of where people live.
