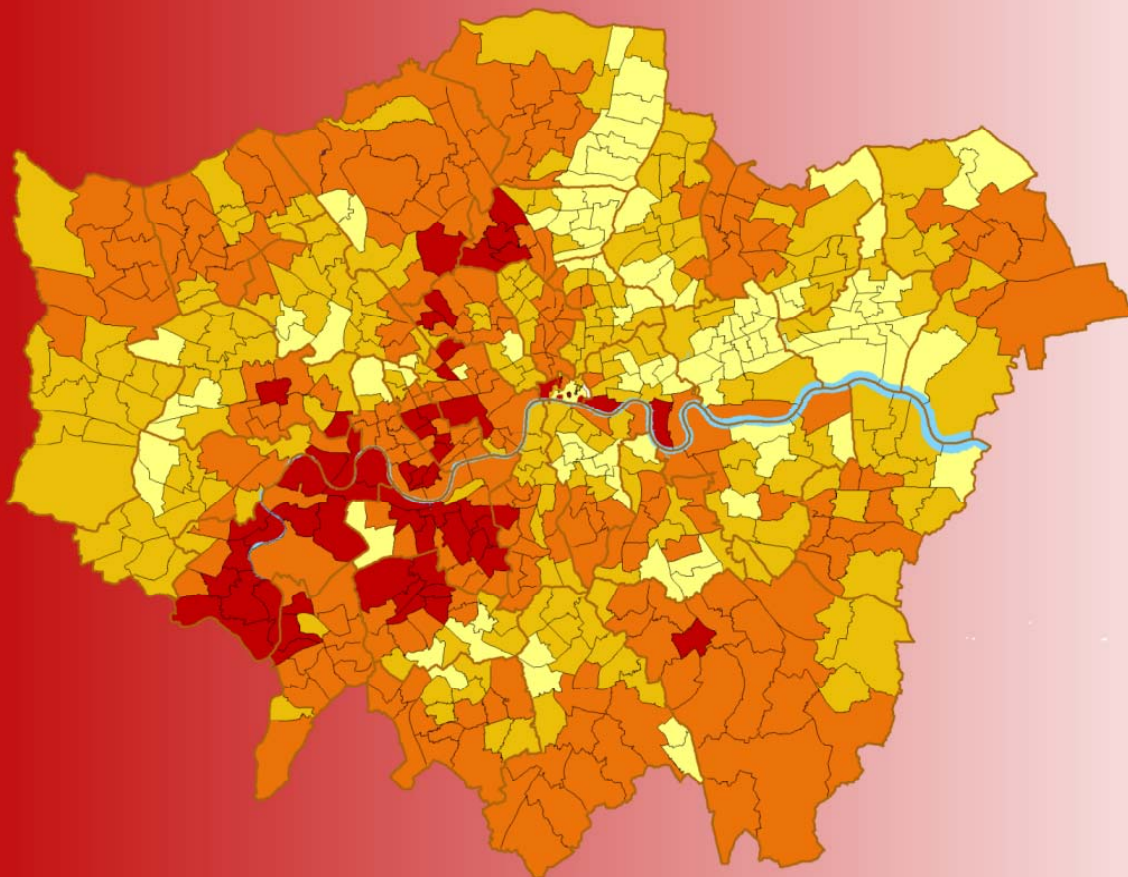

PayCheck 2006: Unequalised and Equalised Household Income

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Main Findings

- The mean or average unequivalised household income for London in 2006 was £37,661, this compares to £36,282 for the equivalised figure; the unequivalised average is over £5,000 higher than the Great Britain average of £32,353.
- There are single person households in London with high incomes, which cancel out any difference when mean incomes are equivalised.
- Median household income falls by 11.4 per cent in London when comparing unequivalised with equivalised.
- The borough of Barking & Dagenham has the lowest average household income in London compared to other London boroughs.
- The highest household income is in Richmond upon Thames when unequivalised and in the City of London when equivalised.
- The London borough of Harrow had the largest percentage drop in median household income when comparing unequivalised with equivalised.
- Both Barking & Dagenham and Newham had 22 per cent of its households with a unequivalised household income below £15,000 a year – this rises to 30 per cent each when equivalised.
- A quarter of households in Richmond have an equivalised income of over £60,000 a year compared to only eight per cent in Barking & Dagenham.
- Edmonton Green ward in Enfield has the lowest median household income (unequivalised) in London with £22,664. This is over half the income in the highest ward, which is Village ward in Merton with a median household income of £46,400.
- Green Street West ward in Newham has the lowest median household income with £19,232 once equalisation is taken into account.
- Southall Green ward in Ealing had the largest percentage difference between unequivalised and equivalised household income.
- Newham has three wards (Green Street West, Green Street East and East Ham North) that have 37 per cent of households with an annual household income (equivalised) below £15,000.

Introduction

This *Briefing* presents figures from the 2006 PayCheck dataset. It shows unequivalised data, which provides modelled estimates of gross household income (including investment income and social security benefits) compared to equivalised data, which takes into account household size. The data are produced by CACI Information Solutions, a market analysis consultancy.

Equivalised income is an adjusted income scale, which takes into account the size of a household. It reflects the idea that a large household will need a larger income than a smaller household in order to achieve an equivalent standard of living.

The equivalisation scale used in PayCheck is the *McClements Scale*, which is also widely used by the Office for National Statistics. This scale assumes the equivalised income of a cohabiting couple living on their own is equal to their actual income. The equivalised income of larger households is less than their actual household income, and the equivalised income of a single-person household is greater than the person's actual income. The scale takes into account both the greater income needs of larger families and economies of scale achieved when people live together.

The name 'PayCheck' is slightly misleading, since these data relate to household income from all sources, rather than just earnings, which might be assumed from the name. The data includes most sources of income such as benefits but it does not include outgoings such as tax payments and housing costs. Deductions for housing costs, would make PayCheck a better measure of deprivation – especially in London. The data consist of a mean, mode and median gross household income figure.

This is the second year that CACI has produced equivalised data but comparisons are not possible due to changes in methodology. Tables for 2005 unequivalised household income were presented in *DMAG Briefing 2005-29*. Tables for 2005 equivalised are available on request.

The results in this *Briefing* are presented in two parts –results are presented for London boroughs followed by a ward level analysis. There are two types of tables for each geographical level: the first compares mean and median incomes split by unequivalised and equivalised. The second shows the distribution of earnings by income scale comparing unequivalised with equivalised.

Showing both median household incomes as well as mean income is important when looking at income levels in London. A mean income would be skewed by a relatively small number of very high earners: only three per cent of households have an income above 100 thousand pounds, however, it is not known how much more they earn above this threshold but the median household income (unequivalised) for London is nearly £6,000 pounds below the mean figure.

Another reason for highlighting the median figure is the importance that the Government places upon it in terms of defining poverty levels. The official poverty line is defined as households with less than 60 per cent of median income (equivalised). In Greater London 27 per cent of the population live in income poverty¹ (2002-05, after housing costs), this rises to 39 per cent for

children – the highest for any region in the country. Child poverty is even higher in Inner London where just over half of all children (52 per cent) are living in income poverty – after housing costs. Poverty rates for some boroughs, especially those with high ethnic populations, would be even higher but sub-regional figures are not possible from the Family Resources Survey (FRS).

The FRS is the Government's source for household income figures used to calculate poverty levels and the equivalised median income for Great Britain according to that source (before housing costs in 2004/05) was £349 per week or £18,148 for the year. This is lower than the corresponding equivalised figure derived from PayCheck in 2006 of £23,711. This difference is due to the methodology adopted by CACI to calculate PayCheck data. The FRS is a continuous cross-sectional survey with a sample of some 26,000 households in Great Britain, whereas PayCheck is based on information on over 4 million households from CACI's lifestyle database, in conjunction with Census and other sources, including market research data. This gives PayCheck its key strength: to make household income estimates for very small areas.

PayCheck data are modelled rather than actual. For some areas this may mean that the model incorporates only a very small number of actual observations for that area. There are no deductions such as tax or housing costs to give disposable income estimates – as PayCheck was originally designed for market analysis.

Household income is higher in London compared to the rest of Great Britain but the extra does not make up for the higher costs of living in London especially those costs relating to housing. According to the Joseph Rowntree Foundation² access to home ownership is most difficult in London, with house price to household income ratios less than four in only three authorities: City of London, Barking & Dagenham and Merton. Only in six authorities can more than thirty per cent of all working households afford to buy at lower quartile house prices. Affordability issues for key workers are even more acute in London. This is because their earnings are based on national pay scales, and London and other related salary supplements are insufficient to offset London's higher housing costs. In most areas, even a key worker couple with two incomes could not afford to buy at lower quartile house prices.

Therefore, an adjustment for housing costs would allow for more meaningful comparisons with areas outside London, as well as within London, although housing costs are high no matter how deprived a certain borough or ward is.

PayCheck data are produced at 2001 Census Output Areas and postcodes, however, PayCheck data at this level are confidential and the actual numbers cannot be published. The Greater London Authority has, arranged, on behalf of the London Boroughs, a consortium purchase for the 2006 Paycheck data from CACI at output area and postcode level. London Boroughs using PayCheck data at this level can do so for internal purposes only and must not be passed on to anyone else, including to another London Borough. Publications must be cleared with CACI if they contain tabular data.

Results

The mean or average unequivalised household income for London in 2006 was £37,661, this compares to £36,282 for the equivalised figure; the unequivalised average is over £5,000 higher than the Great Britain average of £32,353. The equivalised average for London is £1,379 lower than the unequivalised average (see Table 1), while for Great Britain average income decreases when equivalised by £2,029 – a percentage drop of 6.3 per cent compared to a 3.7 per cent drop in London.

The difference between unequivalised and equivalised is more marked when looking at median household incomes in London. Median household income falls by 11.4 per cent in London when comparing unequivalised with equivalised – the percentage difference in Great Britain was 12.4 per cent, therefore the percentage difference for London is far closer to the difference for Great Britain. According to the 2001 Census the average household size in London is 2.35, the same as Great Britain as a whole.

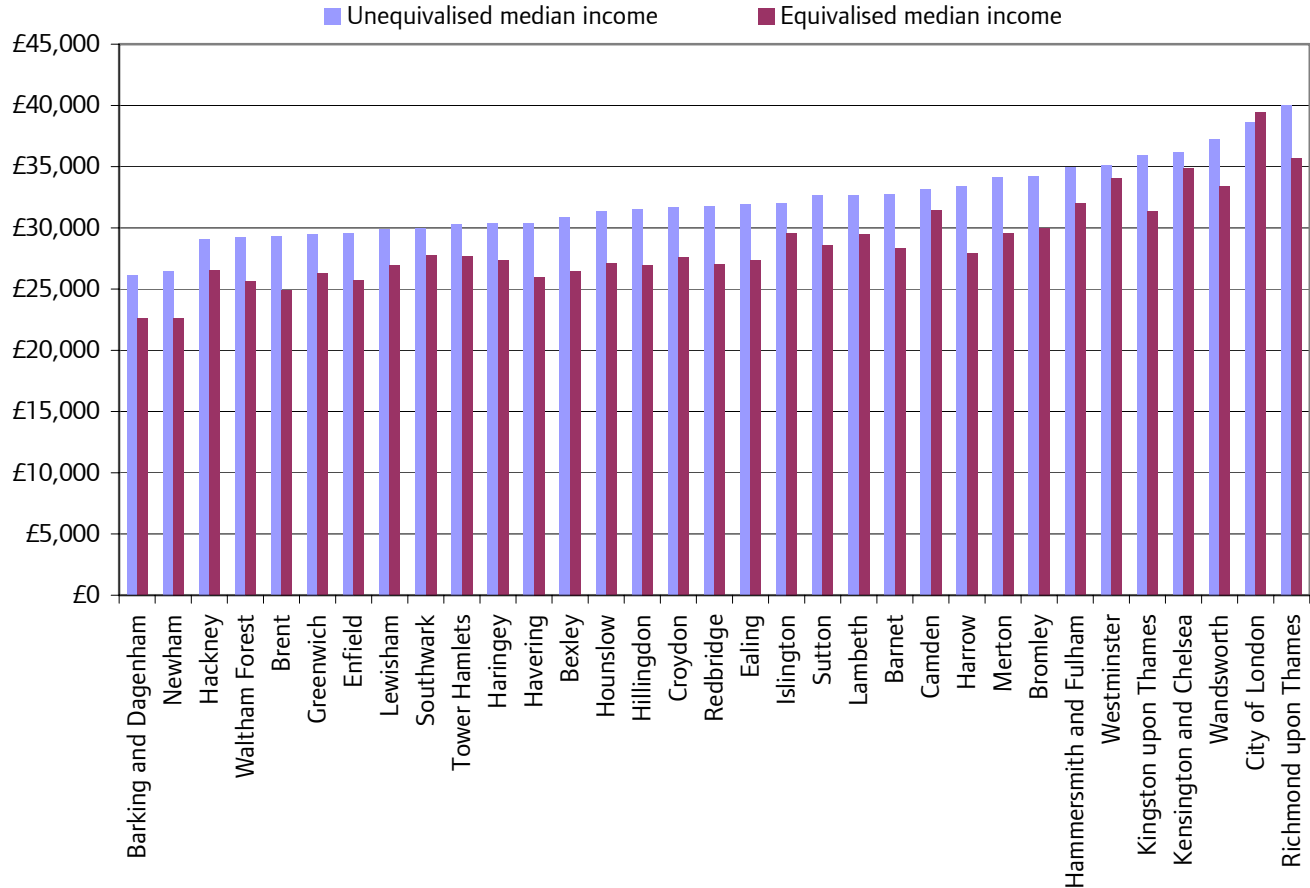
This shows that there are single person households in London with high incomes, which cancels out any difference when mean incomes are equivalised. These smaller but high earning households have less impact when looking at median income, hence the larger difference when median incomes are equivalised.

The borough of Barking & Dagenham has the lowest average household income in London compared to all other boroughs. This is true for all measures: mean and median, equivalised and unequivalised. In Barking and Dagenham, household income ranges from £22,601 for the equivalised median figure to £30,420 for the unequivalised mean figure (see Table 1)

The highest household income is in Richmond upon Thames when unequivalised and in the City of London when equivalised (see Chart 1).

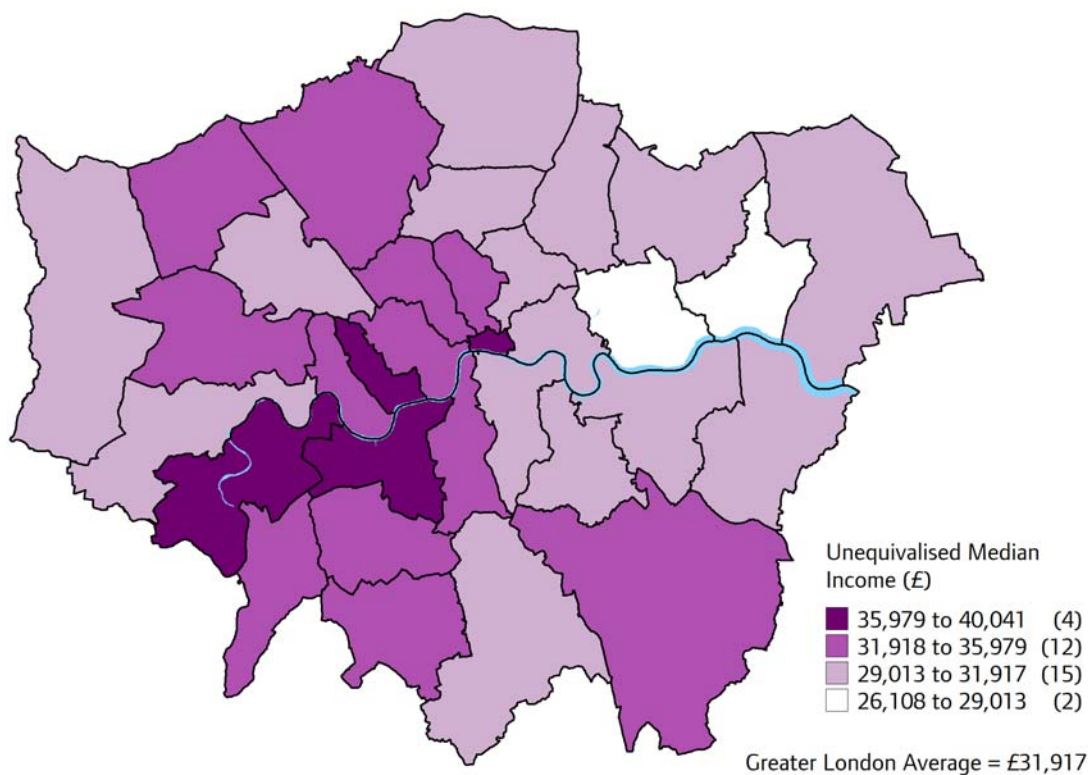
Chart 1 Household Median Income by London borough, Unequivalised compared to Equivalised, 2006

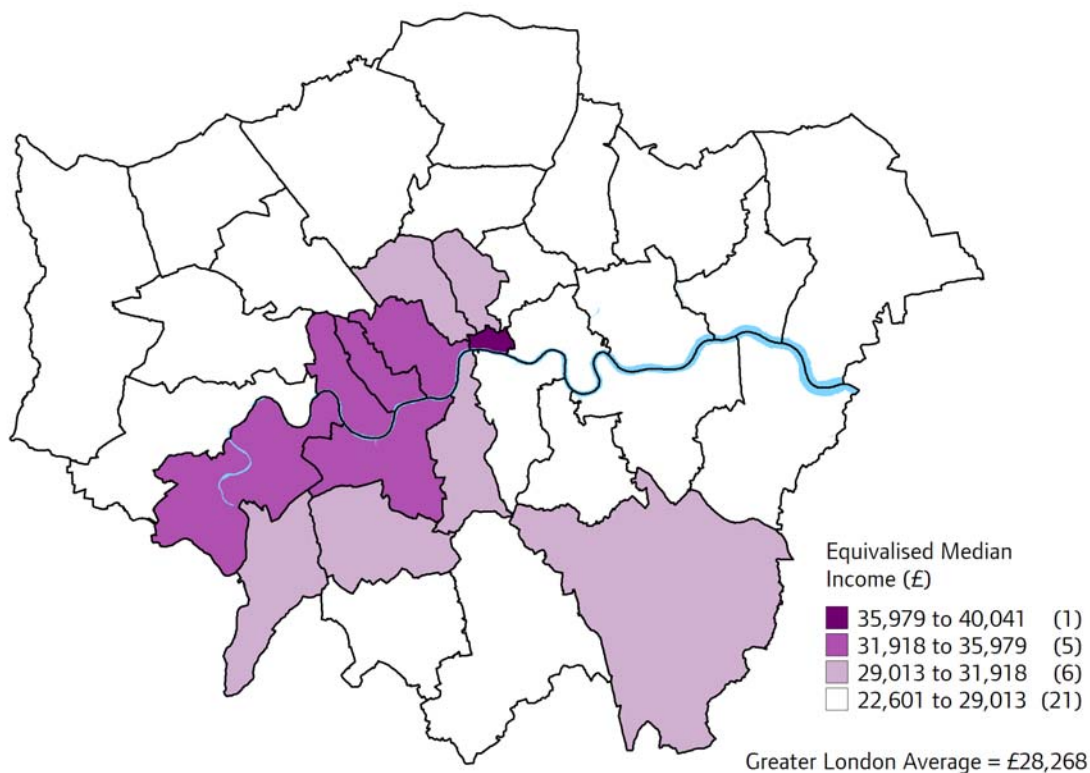
Map 1 Household Median Income by London borough, Unequalised, 2006

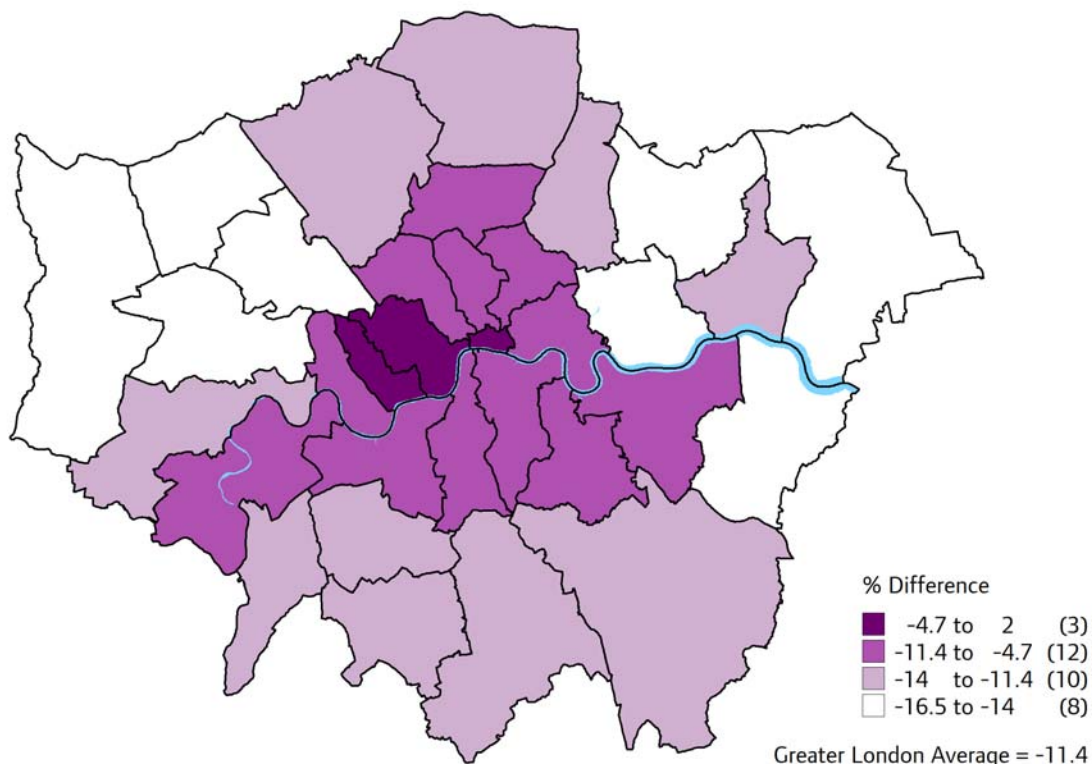
Map 2 Household Median Income by London borough, Equalised, 2006

The London borough of Harrow had the largest percentage fall in median household income when comparing unequalised with equalised. Household income falls by £5,504, a percentage difference of minus 16.5 per cent. The next largest difference was in Brent with a 15 per cent drop. Apart from the City of London, which was the only authority to have its average household income rise after equalisation, the smallest percentage change was in Westminster with income falling by just over three per cent.

Map 3 shows that the largest changes in income occurred in outer London boroughs, particularly in the west and the east. Newham had the largest percentage change of any inner London borough.

Table 2 shows the distribution of earnings by income band for London and its boroughs – comparing unequalised with equalised. Both Barking & Dagenham and Newham had 22 per cent of households with a unequalised household income below £15,000 a year – this rises to 30 per cent each when equalised. The London borough of Harrow had over a 50 per cent increase in the number of households with an income below £15,000 a year after being equalised. Overall, 22 per cent of households in London had equalised incomes below £15,000.

Richmond upon Thames only had 14 per cent of households with an equalised income below £15,000 per year. This is the lowest percentage apart from the City. A quarter of households in

Richmond have an equivalised income of over £60,000 a year compared to only eight per cent in Barking & Dagenham. Overall, 15 per cent of households in London had equivalised incomes above £60,000 a year.

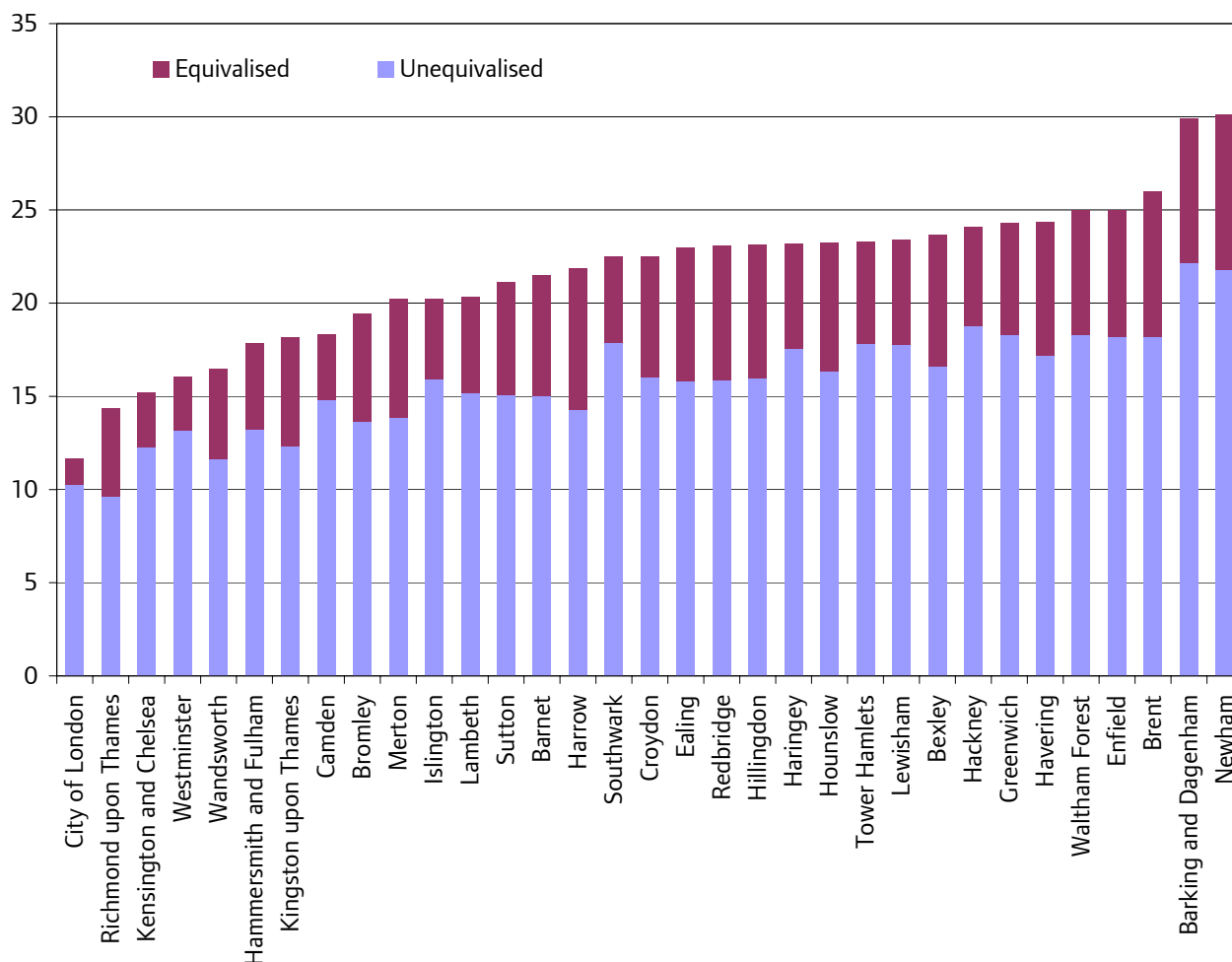

The main advantage of the PayCheck dataset is that it can show household income levels for small areas. Figures for London wards can identify small pockets of low income and highlight polarization not only within London but also within individual boroughs.

According to PayCheck, Edmonton Green ward in Enfield has the lowest median household income (unequalised) in London with £22,664. This is over half the income in the highest ward which is Village ward in Merton which had a median household income of £46,400, otherwise the highest incomes by ward are mostly in three authorities: Richmond upon Thames, the City of London and Wandsworth (see Table 3).

Map 4 shows that the lowest unequalised household incomes are mostly situated in the east of London, along the Lea Valley, with pockets also in the south of Brent, south Lewisham and across the middle of Southwark (around the Peckham and Faraday area). There are also wards in the west of Hounslow and Ealing with low incomes.

The rankings change once equivalisation is taken into account. Green Street West ward in Newham has the lowest median household income with £19,232. This is followed by two other wards in Newham: East Ham North and Green Street East. Also appearing amongst the lowest in London are two wards in Ealing: Southall Broadway and Southall Green (see Table4).

The number of wards in the lowest band used in Maps 4 and 5 increases from 103 when income is unequivalised to 288 once income is equivalised

Southall Green actually had the largest percentage difference between unequivalised and equivalised income (see Table 5). Its household income fell by 24 per cent when comparing the two median measures. Along with Southall Broadway and Lady Margaret ward, Ealing had the three largest differences. Others included the aforementioned wards in Newham, various wards in Harrow and Wembley Central ward and Queensbury ward in Brent. Further down the list (see Appendix table 1) wards in Hounslow like Heston Central and Hounslow West also have large differences between unequivalised and equivalised income figures.

All of these wards have one thing in common – they have a sizeable Asian population. Traditionally, Asian households are larger than average in size. Siblings remain with parents until they get married and many remain with their parents afterwards. There is a tradition of looking after older members of the family within the household.

Table 5 also shows that there are wards where median household income actually increases once equalised. These wards are situated mostly in the City of London, Westminster and Kensington & Chelsea.

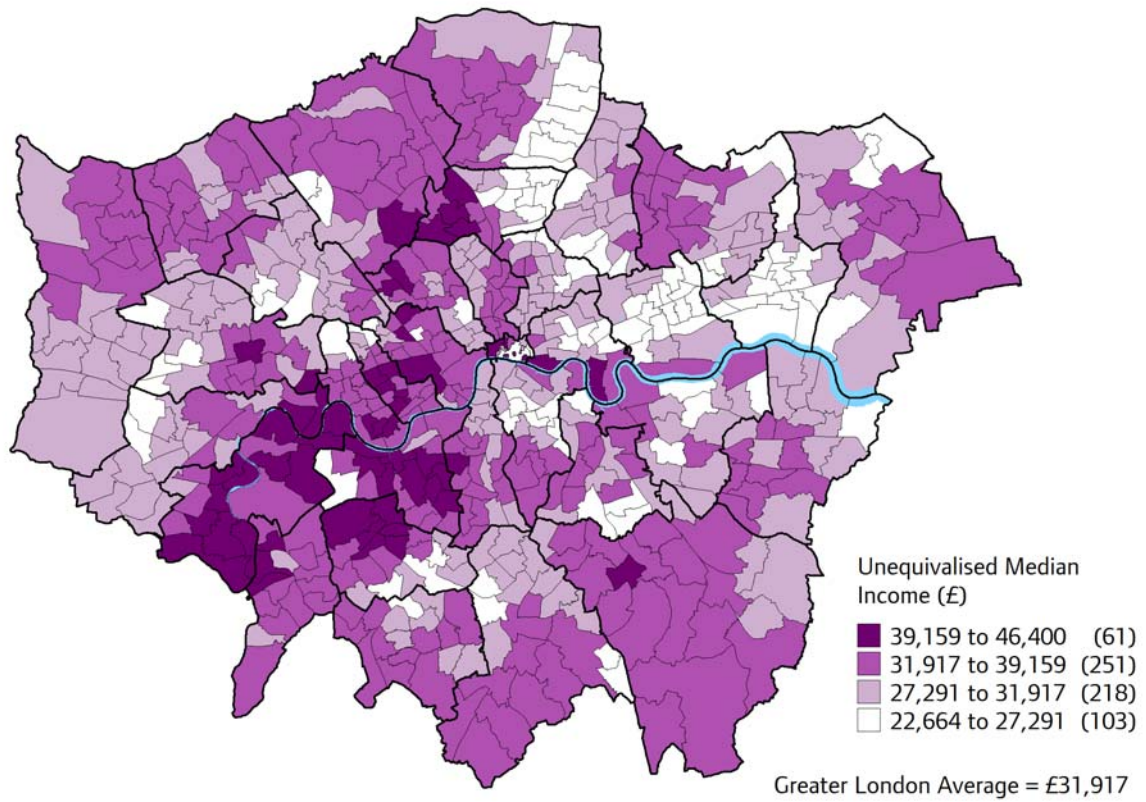

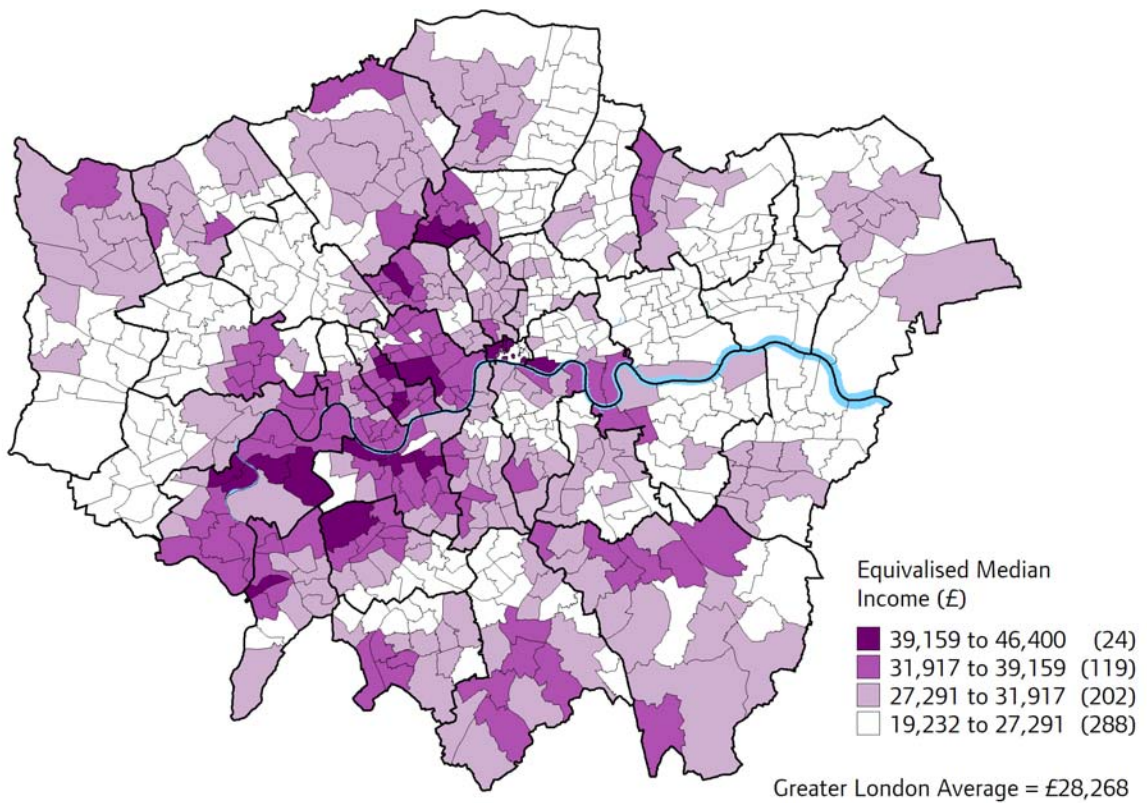
Map 4 Household Median Income by London wards, Unequalised, 2006

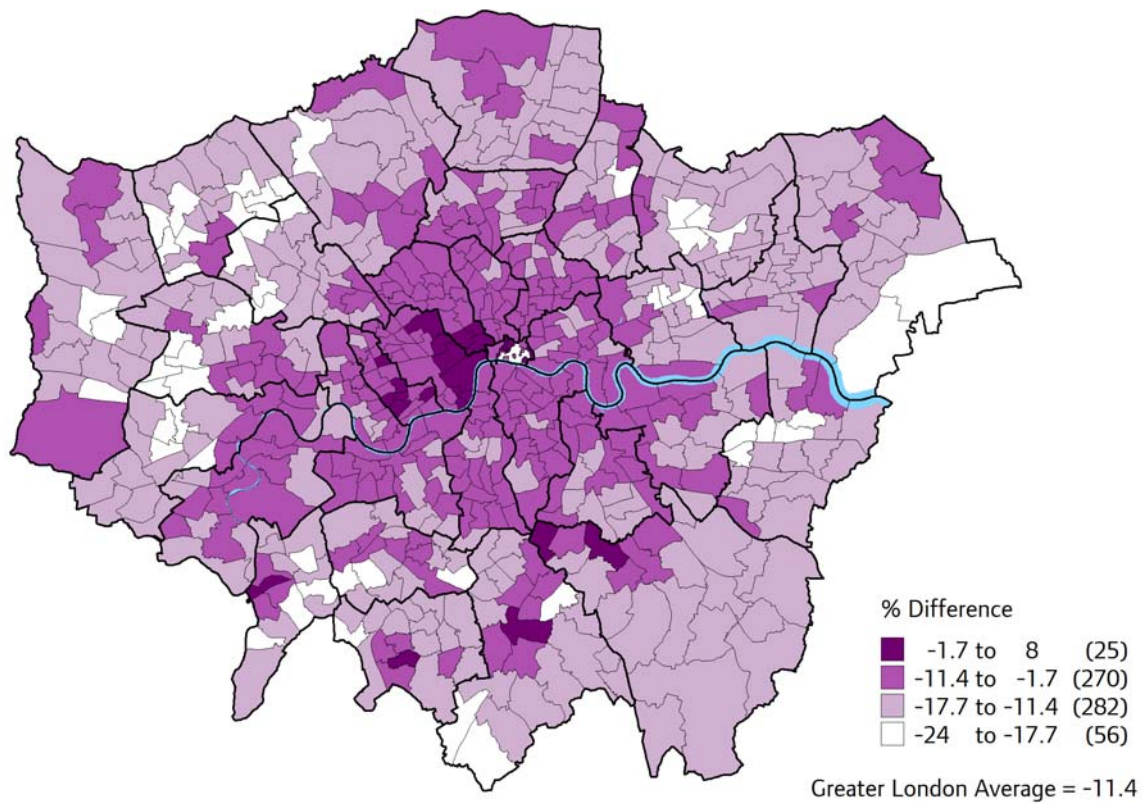
Map 5 Household Median Income by London wards, Equalised, 2006

Appendix 2 shows the distribution of earnings by income band for London wards – comparing unequalised with equalised.

Newham has three wards (Green Street West, Green Street East and East Ham North) that have 37 per cent of households with an annual household income (equalised) below £15,000 – the highest percentage out of all wards. Three quarters of those households have an overall income below £30,000 per year. The lowest percentages for this threshold are all in the City of London.

Overview of methodology

Equivalised PayCheck is derived from the core PayCheck product. The methodology for core PayCheck is described in *DMAG Briefing 2005-29*.

Distributional assumptions

The basic distributional assumption of PayCheck is that $\log(\text{Income}+C)$ is normally distributed among households within each postcode. (More precisely, the actual distribution of household incomes in a postcode can be considered to be a sample from such a distribution) The value of C (constant across all postcodes) is determined as part of the model calibration, as are the values of the mean and standard deviation of the normal distributions. These latter two values differ between different postcodes.

Equivalised PayCheck calculates a mean equivalisation score for a postcode and applies this to the aggregate distribution of incomes to provide an estimate of the distribution of equivalised incomes.

The basics of the model are that, if

$\log(\text{income}+C)$ is distributed $N(\mu_{pc}, \sigma_{pc})$,

and they calculate a mean equivalence score for a postcode of q_{pc} then they take

$\log(\text{equivincome} + C / q_{pc})$ to be distributed $N(\mu_{pc} - \log(q_{pc}), \sigma_{pc})$

Calculation of equivalence scores

The mean equivalised score is based upon:

- a) Estimates of the number of households with 1 adult, with 2 adults, and so on up to 7 adults in the postcode.
- b) An estimate of the number of households containing a married couple.
- c) Estimates of the number of children in the postcode, by age.

(a) and (b) are based upon CACI's Lifestyles UK propensity estimates, and (c) is based upon CACI's population updates and projections.

With these statistics, it is possible to calculate an aggregate equivalisation score for the postcode. The mean is derived by dividing this by the number of households in the postcode, and this mean is then assumed to act on the distribution of incomes as described above.

Within this calculation, an adjustment was made for those few postcodes where there is a high population compared to the number of households. It can be difficult to distinguish between those which have considerable communal population, and those which have large (adult) households, and a general pragmatic approach has been adopted of effectively limiting the size of the mean equivalence score which can be used.
