### **ONS data release schedule**

As you may be aware, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2003 the Office for National Statistics (ONS) withdrew the timetable for release of census data. ONS is reviewing a potential risk that information about individual workplaces could be disclosed through Census tables on workplace populations. It is also taking ONS longer than planned to produce tables about out migrants due to technical problems affecting SuperCROSS tables.

The ONS statement read *'A revised schedule will be published as soon as possible, but it is not possible to anticipate that products will be released with the content as currently specified or in the order of the previous schedule'*.

Since this message was put on the ONS website there has been no further news regarding a revised timetable for the release any further data.

A further seventeen tables from the National Report covering migration, travel to work and workplace are still unpublished, these are a mixture of standard tables and theme tables. Other tables still to come include Key Statistics tables, Univariate tables, a range of data for parishes, postcodes, origin / destination (special migration statistics and special workplace statistics). For a list of the missing tables see Appendix 1.

We will continue to monitor the situation and keep census contact informed.

### **2001 Census consortium**

One of the major benefit of the census consortium is the joint commissioning of tables across London and Berkshire, gaining comparable information on a wider geography and everyone having access to a wider range of tables. There are also other benefits, including financial, because everyone pays less and the Greater London Authority (GLA) will process the data into SASPAC system files on behalf of the consortiums. Members of the consortium have already paid for commissioned tables. The GLA holds the consortium budget to pay for them. For the list of GLA commissioned tables requested by consortia members so far see Appendix 2. If you wish to add further tables please let us know.

### **Commissioned tables from ONS**

ONS offer a service of producing customised output where requirements are not met by the standard results in reports or local statistics.

Orders for commissioned output may be made at any time. Charges are made to recover staff and material costs for the production and supply of output not otherwise available. This service can produce customised output that cannot be met from the standard classifications, although there are disclosure protection rules which limit the production of output for flexible geographies. Charges would cover any necessary development work, and estimates would be provided in advance of production. These charges will be paid by the GLA, but tables must be requested via the GLA's census team.

Once a table has been commissioned, it is then made freely available to all users on request from Census Customer Services. A list of all available tables is available on the ONS website in an excel format. Some 200 tables are currently listed, and ONS will regularly update this list. So far ONS have produced commissioned tables for the Office for the Deputy Prime Minister (ODPM) and for the Multi Sourced Topic Reports (MSTR), which are currently being produced. To date we have received some 160 commissioned tables from ONS, at various geographic levels. We have looked at all of them and have added comments to the list of tables where similar tables or subsets of standard tables already exist. See appendix 3.

We are concentrating efforts on turning the ward level tables into SASPAC system files. We have processed three tables so far.

- M079 – SCT001 Accommodation type by ethnic group of hrp
- M081a – SCT002 Lives rent free and landlord by number of rooms
- M092 – SCT003 Number of persons/rooms by occupancy rating

The three tables listed above have been converted to SASPAC system files and copies of both the system and framework files are on a CD distributed at the Census Users Group (CUG) meeting of the 11<sup>th</sup> December 2003. Copies are available from the census team.

For these tables for London see Appendix 4

For the framework layouts and cell numbers see Appendix 5

We have overcome some difficulties in processing the files into a saspac compatible format and this should mean that the processing should be quicker from now on.

If having looked at the list of commissioned tables you have any tables you wish us to prioritise please let us know. If you would like any of the files in the meantime could you also let us know.

### **GLA commissioned tables**

All tables produced so far have been commissioned by other census users. For ethnic group tables it was decided that we should commission all wards (and districts) in London, Reading and Slough, plus former county level for Berkshire (a total for the six unitary authorities) and all wards in London and Berkshire for all other tables.

In September the GLA commissioned six tables these were:

- GLA001 - Tenure by persons per room by accommodation type
- GLA002 - Household composition by tenure and occupancy rating
- GLA003 - Dwelling type and accommodation type by tenure (households and dwellings) and ethnic group –all occupied household spaces by ethnic group of hrp.
- GLA004 - Dwelling type and accommodation type by tenure (households and dwellings) and ethnic group –all people in households by ethnic group of hrp
- GLA005 - Country of birth (all categories)
- GLA006 - Ethnic Group (all categories)

We are still awaiting a response from ONS with details of costs, timing, geography etc.

If you can specify a layout such as in Appendix 4 this would be helpful. Failing that we need enough information for the GLA to provide a detailed layout to ONS and the geographical level that we want the tables for.

We will keep census contacts informed on progress of the GLA commissioned tables.

## Footnote:

The occupancy rating provides a measure of under-occupancy and overcrowding. For example a value of -1 implies that there is one room too few and that there is overcrowding in the household. It assumes that every household, including one person households; requires a minimum of two common rooms (excluding bathrooms).
