1. Methodology

- This study was conducted in London via LondonBus, an Internet omnibus survey
- **SAMPLE SIZE** a sample of 1002 Londoners adults aged 16+ were interviewed.
- **INTERVIEWING** Interviewing was conducted by online self-completion from 25/08/2016 30/08/2016 (Week 34).
- **WEIGHTING** The sample has been weighted to represent the adult population of London 16+
- **LOW BASES** Where unweighted base figures are less than 100, data should be treated cautiously, as large margins of error are possible
