About this publication

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The London Fire Brigade

The London Fire Brigade is run by the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority (LFEPA).

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Introduction

This document sets out the key performance information to support the LFEPA Statement of Assurance (SoA) 2016/17. The intention is to be able to assess the impact of the changes made to fire stations, and fire engines as part of the Fifth London Safety Plan (LSP5). The LSP5 changes also need to be considered with the permanent removal of 13 further fire engines in June 2016; these fire engines had been temporarily removed from station in August 2013 to provide a contingency resource – the Emergency Fire Crew Capability (EFCC) – in the event of strike action.

Fifth London Safety Plan (LSP5)

The Fifth London Safety Plan (LSP5) was approved by the LFEPA on 12 September 2013, following a Mayoral Direction and on 9 January 2014 the following operational changes were made:

- The closure of 10 fire stations.
- The number of fire engines (pumping appliances) reduced by 14 (net).
- Five appliances were redeployed to different stations.
- The number of fire rescue units (specialist rescue vehicles) reduced from 16 to 14.
- The minimum crewing levels on fire rescue units reduced from five firefighters to four.

Other changes at stations were introduced (before 9 January 2014) including:

- Alternate crewing introduced on the scientific support units at Poplar and Hammersmith.
- Alternate crewing introduced on the two remaining incident response units at Wimbledon and Plaistow
- On-demand mobilising for hose-laying and bulk foam units at the incident support centres.

Impacts on performance in the five years to 2016/17

Performance in 2016/17 is impacted by a range of changes alongside those in LSP5 which includes the

temporary removal of EFCC appliances and station/appliances temporary changes as a result of the PFI station rebuilding programme. To provide the opportunity to assess the impacts of LSP5, this document includes data for five performance years (April to March), as follows:

- **2012/13** – the last full year based on pre-LSP5 deployments (i.e. 112 stations with 169 fire engines), and before the temporary EFCC removals, or a number of station closures for rebuilding (i.e. station PFI project).
- **2013/14** – the performance year with 27 EFCC appliances temporarily removed (from August 2013), LSP5 changes implemented (from January 2014) and stations/appliances changes arising from the property PFI project (from various dates).
- **2014/15** – the performance year with LSP5 changes fully implemented, but still with 13 EFCC appliances removed and station changes arising from the station PFI project.
- **2015/16** – the performance year with LSP5 changes fully implemented, 13 EFCC appliances temporarily removed from stations, and temporary station closures arising from the PFI station rebuilding programme.
- **2016/17** – the SoA year with LSP5 changes fully implemented, 13 EFCC appliances temporarily removed from stations from April 2016 and permanently removed from June 2016, and a few temporary station closures arising from the PFI station rebuilding programme in April, May and June 2016.

Other data published

Data for all incidents attended and for the arrival times of all fire engines is published on the London Datastore [here](#). This data covers the period from January 2009, and is updated monthly.

The Brigade's mapping tool, on its web site [here](#), provides incident data and first and second fire engine attendance time performance by borough and ward. This is updated monthly.

Performance overview

The LFEPA Governance, Performance and Audit Committee (GPAC) receive a six monthly performance report which has details of performance indicators (including much of the data in this report), with commentary. The data published in this document for 2016/17 is consistent with the end of year report (FEP2741) presented to the GPAC in July 2017 and available on the Brigade's web site [here](#).

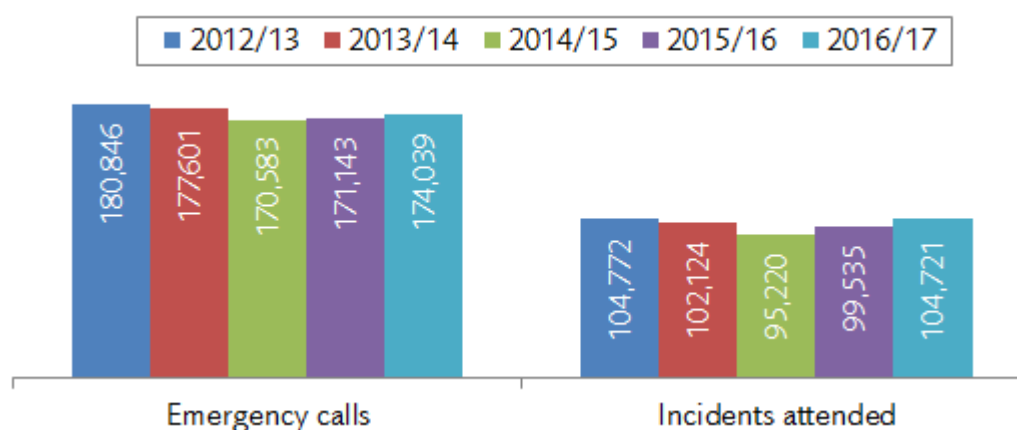
The main performance highlights of 2016/17, compared to the previous year (2015/16) and five years earlier in (2012/13), and based on the data published in annexes, are set out below.

- **Emergency calls** received by the Brigade (174,039) were higher in 2016/17 compared to the previous year (171,143), by nearly 3,000 (about 2 per cent higher). They were lower by over 6,800 calls compared to 2012/13 (180,846).
- The number of **incidents attended** by the Brigade in London (104,721) was also higher in 2016/17 compared to the previous year by 5 per cent (5,200 more); incidents were lower than five years earlier (by nearly 4 per cent).
- The **speed of attendance to incidents** by both first and second fire engines continues to remain well within the performance targets (6 minutes and 8 minutes, on average, respectively). On average, a first appliance arrived at an incident in 5m22s and a second appliance in 6m44s. This performance is an improvement on the year before (10 and seven seconds faster respectively). Despite the LSP5 changes in 2014 and the permanent removal EFCC fire engines in 2016, performance in 2016/17 is nine seconds for first and 22 seconds for second slower compared to 2012/13.
- The total number of **fire deaths** in 2016/17 was some eight higher at 44, compared to 2015/16, and the same (44) as in 2012/13. Based on the 10 year rolling average fire deaths were at 46, compared to 54 five years ago. The longer term trend remained one of improvement across the five years.
- **Deaths in accidental fires in the home** (the main focus of the Brigade's community safety work) also increased in 2016/17 and at 39 for the year were 18 higher than the year before, and eight higher than in 2012/13.
- The number of **serious injuries at primary fires**¹ in 2016/17 (542) shows an improvement over 2015/16 of some 5 per cent, and are nearly 27 per cent lower than in 2012/13.
- The overall number of **fires** in 2016/17 was lower than 2015/16 by over 500, at 20,259. The number in 2016/17 is similar to the level of fires five years earlier (in 2012/13); total fires fluctuate because of summer related secondary (mainly grass) fires.
- The number of **primary (more serious) fires** was similar in 2016/17 to the year before, and about eight per cent (or nearly 900 fires lower).
- The number of **accidental fires in the home** (accidental dwelling fires) fell again in 2016/17 – by three per cent compared to 2015/16, and 15 per cent compared to 2012/13.
- The number of **fires in care homes and sheltered housing** fell to 321 in 2016/17; down from 422 in 2015/16 (32 per cent). And 62 per cent lower than 2012/13.
- **Time spent on community safety (CS) activity by fire station staff** is at 14.5 per cent in 2016/17. This represents a continual improvement since 2012/13 (13.6 per cent) and compared to 2015/16 (13.9 per cent).
- The number of **home fire safety visits** completed during 2016/17 was down (two per cent) compared to 2015/16 at 84,890, although this is a higher number than five years ago in 2012/13 by some two per cent (83,582).

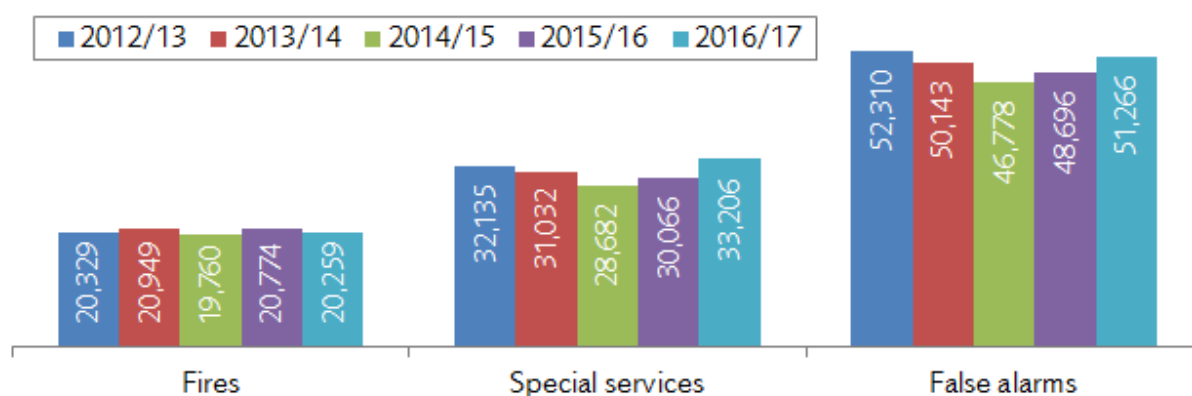
¹ Primary fires are those that meet one of the following criteria – a) occurs in a (non-derelict) building, vehicle or outdoor structure, b) involve a fatality, casualty or rescue or c) attended by five or more pumping appliances.

Calls received and incidents attended

- The numbers of emergency (999) calls received and the incidents attended over the five years to 2016/17 are set out in the charts below.
- Data for all incidents attended (borough and ward) is available in annex 1C. Emergency call data is not available at ward or borough level as the location of a caller is not captured.



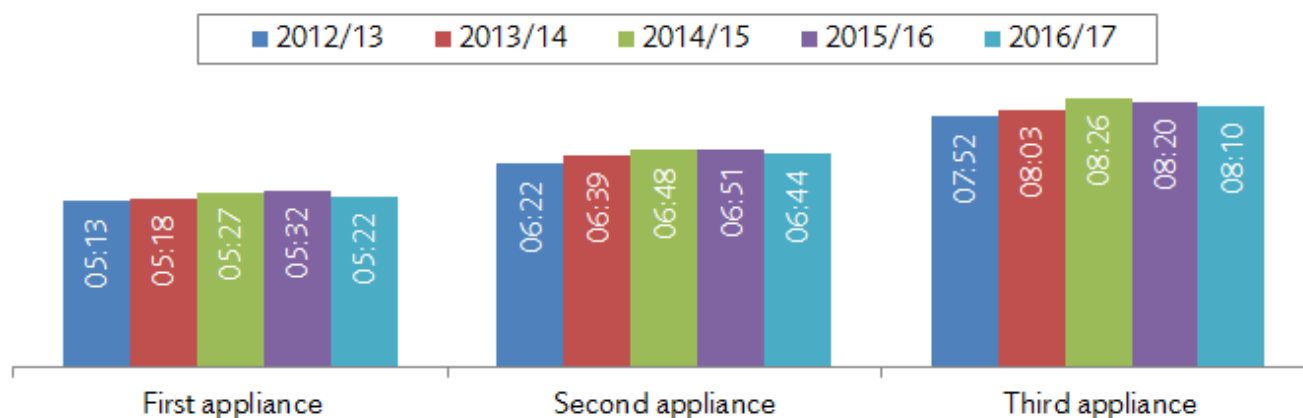
- London-wide, the number of **incidents attended** by the Brigade rose slightly in 2016/17 but is very similar to the number in 2012/13. Most boroughs saw a small rise incidents in 2016/17 compared to 2015/16.
- Fires were down in 2016/17 compared to 2015/16, and at a similar level to than five years earlier (2012/13). Special services and false alarms both show an increase London-wide in 2016/17 compared to 2015/16, although numbers are lower than five years earlier. A key driver for special services is the attendance by the Brigade at some 1,599 medical incidents where the Brigade co-responded with the London Ambulance Service as part of a trial (which started in February 2016) in four London boroughs.



Attendance time impacts²

First, second and third pumping appliances

- The London-wide performance for first, second and third pumping appliances (fire engines) is summarised in the chart below. London-wide and borough attendance times for five years are set out in annex 1A (borough) and Annex 2A (ward).



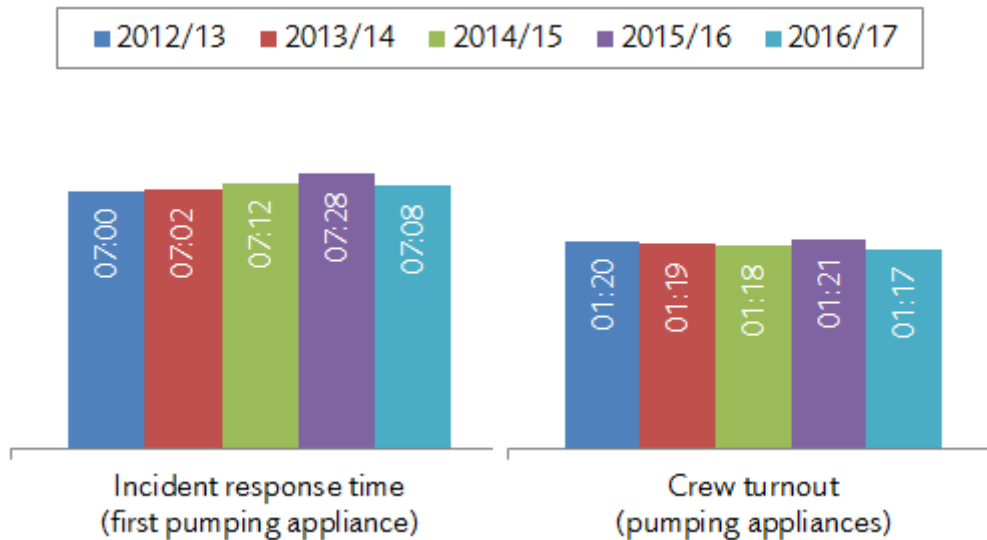
- Average performance for **first appliance** in 2016/17, at 05:22, is some 10 seconds faster than in 2015/16. The temporary closure of some fire stations in 2015/16 and 2014/15 resulted in slower first and second appliance times in those years. Performance in 2016/17 was slower by nine second (on average) than five years earlier in 2012/13 (05:13). This difference is consistent – and slightly better – than the modelled impact of the LSP5 changes and the removal of the EFCC appliances (+17 seconds). Only Hillingdon borough fell outside the six minutes average target for first appliance (at 06:24).
- London-wide, **second appliance** average response time in 2016/17, at 06:44, was seven seconds faster than in 2015/16. This reflects the re-opening of station closed for rebuilding works in previous years. Second appliance performance is 22 seconds slower than in 2012/13 by 22 seconds. The changes in LSP5 and the removal of EFCC appliances would impact more on second appliance performance given the overall removal of 17 second fire engines (compared to 10 first fire engines). This difference is consistent – and slightly better – than the modelled impact of the LSP5 changes and the removal of the EFCC appliances (+28 seconds). In 2016/17, two boroughs were outside second appliance average attendance target of eight minutes (Hillingdon at 08:07 and Havering at 08:09).
- London-wide, average **third appliance** response times (at 08:10) in 2016/17 was 10 seconds faster than in 2015/16, but 18 seconds slower than in 2012/13. There is no target for third appliance performance, but performance is well within the benchmark average of 10 minutes used during LSP5 consultation. No borough in 2016/17 fell outside this benchmark (although two were at the benchmark – Bromley and Hillingdon).

Overall pumping appliance 'incident' response time

- Details of the **overall time taken between answering the 999 call answer and arrival of the first pumping appliance at incident scene** (the 'overall incident response time') are published for borough and ward in annexes 1A and 2A. The London-wide performance is shown in the chart below.

² See the 'Notes on data,' on page 19. There has been an adjustment to the way in which attendance times are calculated which was covered in the agreed London Safety Plan 2017. The aim has been to count more mobilisations to achieve a more accurate performance. That change will have an impact on the data in this section which will be different from previously data supporting the Statement of Assurance in previous years.

- As the incident response time covers call handling, the equivalent performance target (for a first appliance) would be an average 7m40s (1:40 call handling plus 6 minute attendance).
- Whilst the travel time to the incident scene may be impacted by the LSP5 and EFCC changes to stations and appliances, no other aspect of the process (i.e. call answer, call handling and crew turnout) would be impacted as a direct result of these changes. A new mobilising system went live during 2015/16 (November 2015) and this has improved call handling performance (e.g. postcode and premises mobilising), and the travel time to the incident as a result of the introduction of geographic mobilising. The overall incident response time (07:08) was 20 seconds faster in 2016/17 than in 2015/16, and only eight seconds slower than in 2012/13 (07:00).



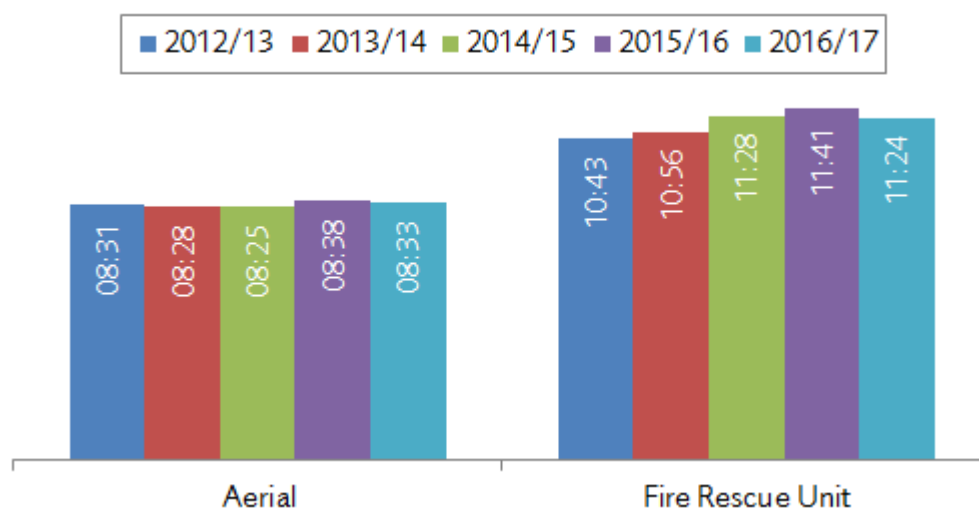
Note: crew turnout time not to same scale.

Crew turn-out for pumping appliances

- Data on pumping appliance **crew turnout** performance is shown in the chart above, and is available by borough in annex 1A. The crew turn-out time is included within the overall incident response times (which are measured from the time of mobilisation to arrival at the incident address). Apart from in 2015/16, there has been a slowly improving crew turn-out performance over the five years to 2016/17. It would not be expected that crew turnout performance would be impacted by the changes to stations and pumping appliances implemented in LSP5 or the removal of EFCC appliances.

Special appliances

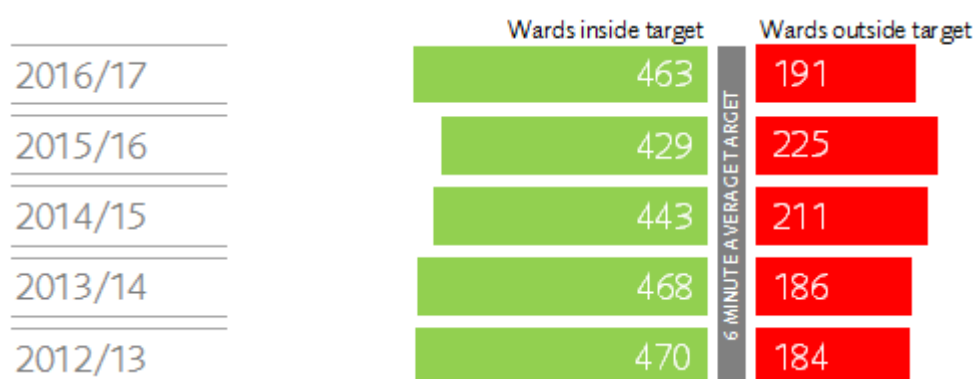
- Data for special appliance average response times – for Fire Rescue Units (FRUs) and aerial appliances – is shown in the chart below for five years up to 2016/17. Data for borough and ward performance is shown in annex 1B and annex 2A respectively.



- London-wide, average **aerial appliance** response times were 08:33 in 2016/17. This is slightly faster (five seconds) than in 2015/16 (08:38), but slower than in 2012/13. There are no attendance standard for aerial appliances and that there were no changes made to the number or deployment of aerial appliances in LSP5 or over the five years for which data is displayed. Performance is relatively consistent over the five years.
- London-wide, average **fire rescue unit** response times were 11:24 in 2016/17, and this is slightly faster (-17 seconds) than in 2015/16 (11:41). There are no attendance standard for fire rescue units. In LSP5 FRUs were removed from Hornchurch in Havering, and Millwall in Tower Hamlets, which would account for the change in performance between 2012/13 and 2016/17 (+41 seconds).

Ward pumping appliance attendance times

- Ward data for first and second pumping appliance attendance times is in annex 2A.
- 71 per cent of wards in 2016/17 had a **first appliance** within the average six minute target. Comparing performance in 2016/17 with a year before the LSP5 changes and EFCC removals; i.e. 2012/13, there were seven more wards in outside target in the most recent year.



- Of the 191 wards outside the first appliance average six minute target in 2016/17, 87 wards were within 30 seconds of the target. The chart below shows wards outside the target within four time bands to show how far they were away from the target, together with the cumulative number of wards at each time band.

- Performance for **second appliance** comparing 2016/17 against 2012/13 shows fewer wards outside the target in the most recent year, than in any other year.

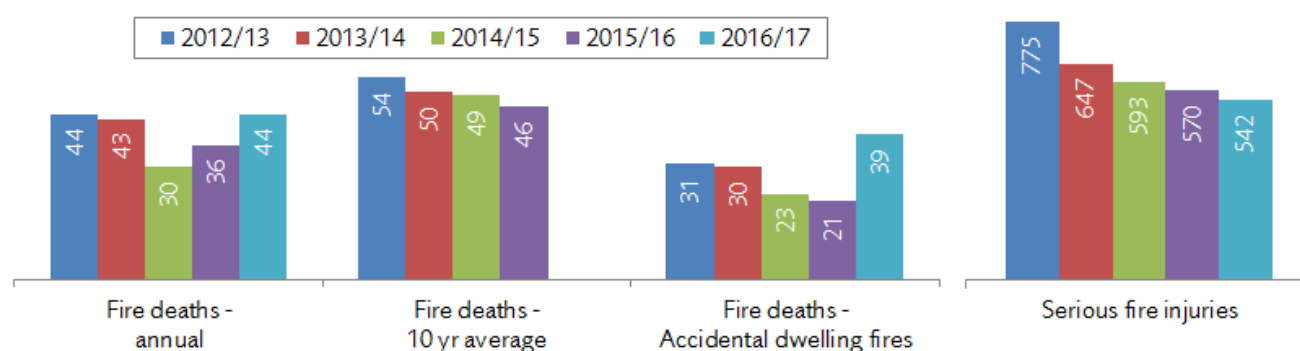

- Of the 117 wards outside the second appliance average eight minute target in 2016/17, 50 wards were within 30 seconds of the target. The chart below shows wards outside the target within four time bands, to show how far they were away from the target, together with the cumulative number of wards at each time band.

Fire casualties (fatal and non-fatal)

- Data about fire casualties (by borough and ward) is available in annexes 1D and 2B respectively.
- The chart below shows the numbers of fire casualties (fatal and non-fatal) for the five year period up to 2016/17. There was a small upturn in the number of all fire deaths in 2015/16 and again in 2016/17. The 10 year average for all fire deaths continues to show a downward trend over the five year period despite the upward fluctuations in recent years. The upward movement in deaths from accident fires in the home (accidental dwelling fires) reflects the upward trend for all fires deaths in 2016/17, although the number of serious fire injuries continues to fall.

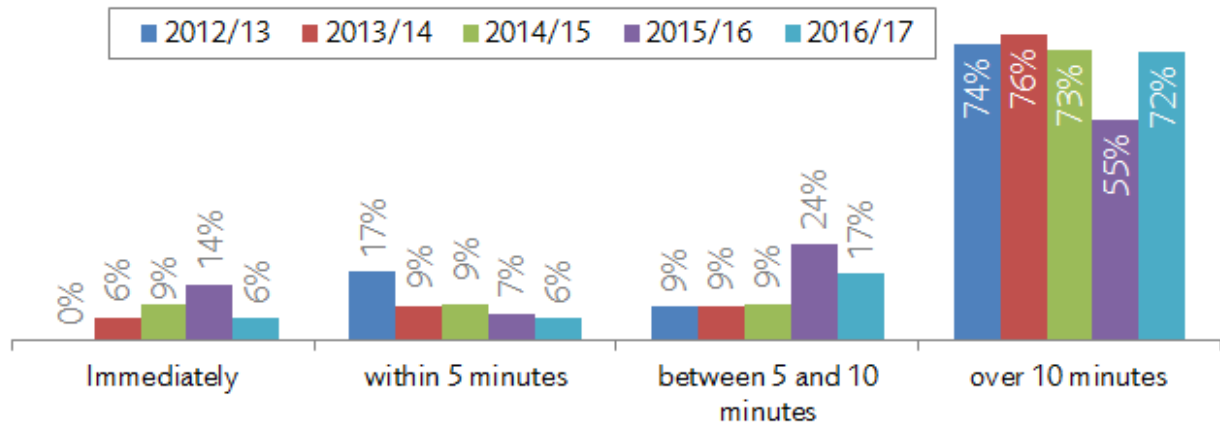


Note: serious fire injuries not to same scale.

- Borough and ward data for **fire deaths** is set out in Annex 1D (borough) and 2B (ward). The number of fire deaths at borough and ward level is generally very small, so there are always limitations on the statistical conclusions that can reliably be drawn from these data .
- The number of **serious fire injuries** have fallen by 30 per cent since 2012/13 and five per cent compared to 2016/17, and 27 per cent since 2012/13. The actual number of fire injuries annually at borough and ward level fluctuate so that there are limitations to the reliability of statistical conclusions that can be drawn.
- There is always an interest in whether changes to pumping appliance response times increases the prevalence of deaths. One factor that is key to whether the Brigade arrives in good time and someone is rescued in a timely way, is the delay in discovering the fire and calling the fire brigade. The chart below shows the estimated delay between ignition of the fire and calling the brigade, based on the work of crews and fire investigators. This data is available for about 80 per cent of fatal fire casualties across the five year period. In 2016/17, in nearly 90 per cent of cases where data is available, there was a delay of 5 minutes or more in calling the Brigade.

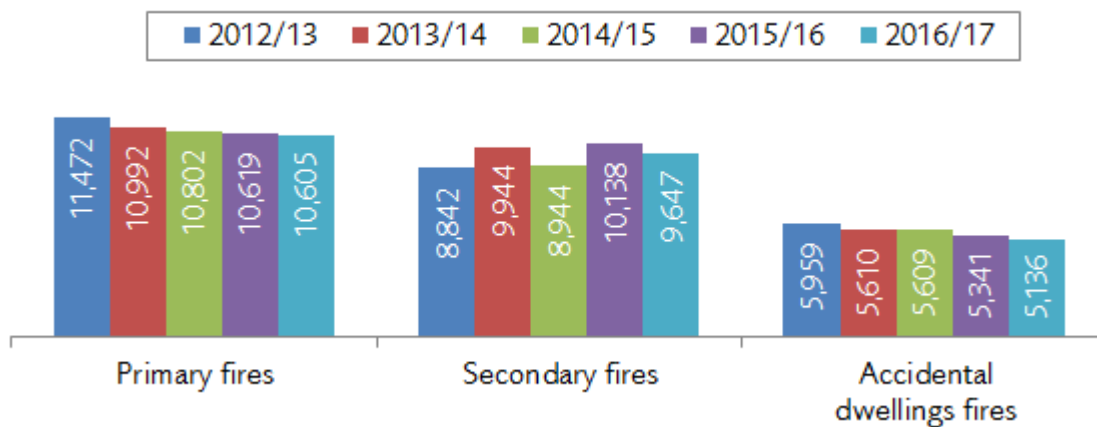
Estimated delay between fire ignition and call to the Brigade for fire fatalities in London

Note: Typically, for the five years displayed, this data is not available for about 20 per cent of fire deaths.

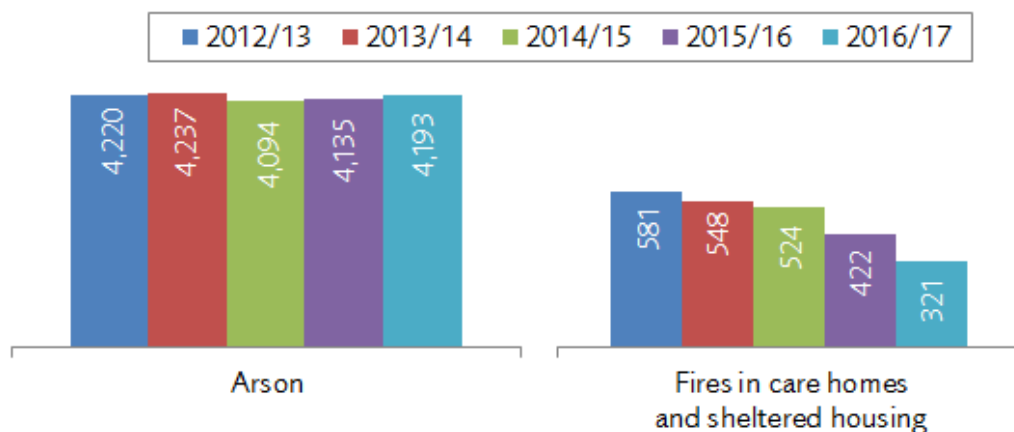


Fire incidents

- Detailed borough and ward data is in annexes 1C and 2B, together with data for all fires, primary (more serious) fires, accidental dwellings fires, and fires in care homes/sheltered housing.
- London-wide, the number of **primary fires**, and **accidental dwelling fires** continue to fall in 2016/17 and that pattern is maintained in the period covering the implementation of LSP5 in January 2014 and removal of EFCC appliances. The number of **secondary fires** fluctuates as open land and grass fires are a significant proportion of these fires and are higher in years which have more warmer/drier summer periods (like 2015/16).



- Data for all deliberate fires (arson) and for fires in care homes/sheltered housing is set out in the chart below. In the period since LSP5 was implemented, **arson** incidents have remained relatively flat and are lower than five years ago. In LSP5, the Authority stated it was concerned by the number of older people who are harmed or killed by fire in places where they should be safe, and we introduced a new headline target focusing on reducing the **fires in care homes and sheltered housing**. Over the life of LSP5, the numbers of these fires in these places has reduced.

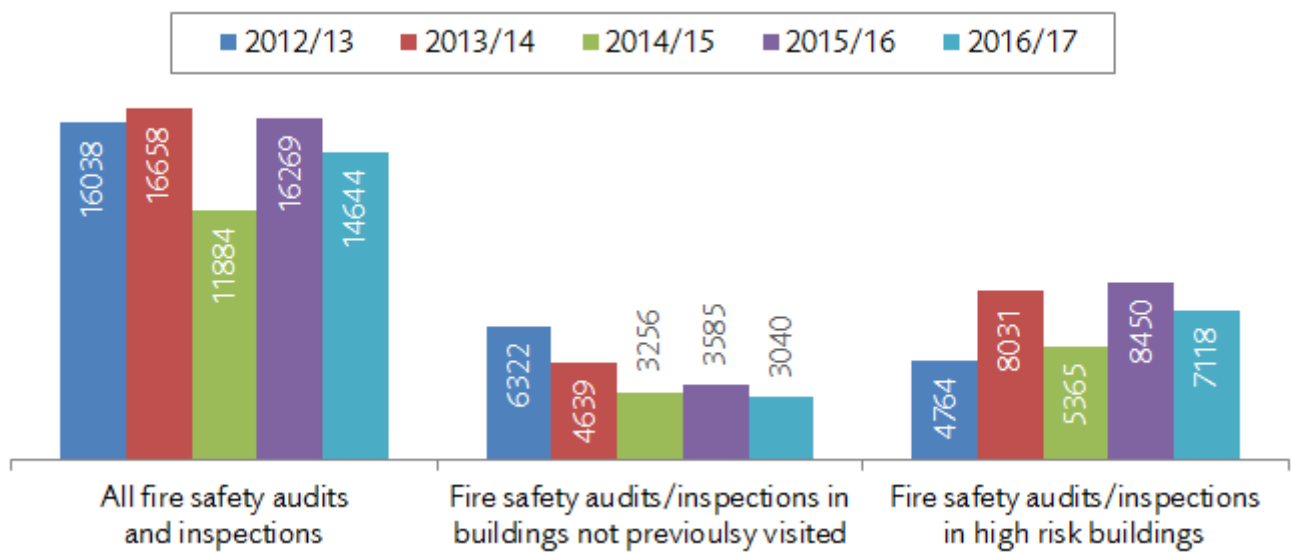

Fire safety

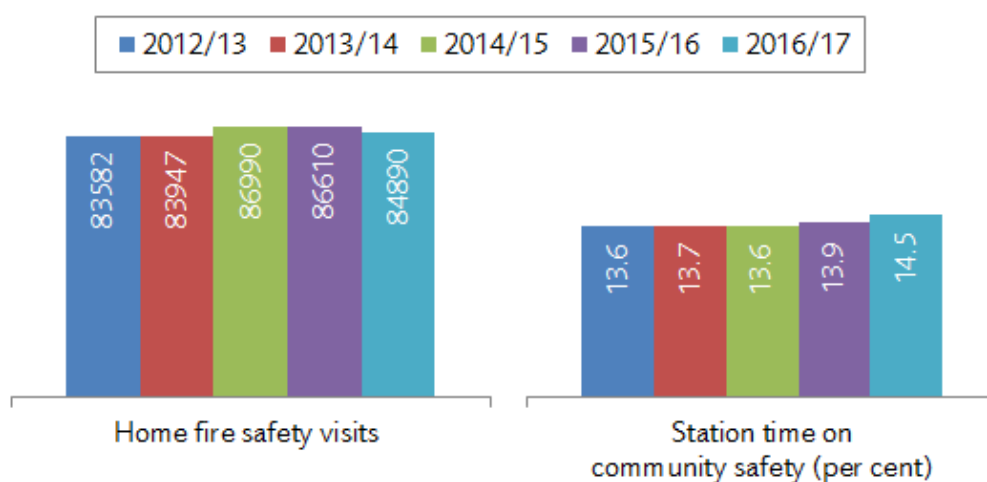
Regulatory fire safety

- Data on **all fire safety inspections/audits**, those in **premises not previously visited** and for **inspection/audits to high-risk premises** and this data is provided at borough level only (annex 1E). London-wide performance for the past five years, including 2016/17, is set out in the chart below.
- There is no relationship between the stations and pumping appliance reductions in LSP5 and the volume of regulatory fire safety work undertaken, as this is currently carried out by specialist non-station based staff. The numbers of fire safety audits/inspections has fluctuated over the last few years with a decline shown in 2014/15, but improved numbers in both 2015/16 and 2016/17.



Community safety

- Data for the proportion of **time spent on community safety by station based staff** is published at borough level only in annex 1E. The London-wide data for the last five years is in the chart below. The indicator is expressed as a proportion of available time by the crews of pumping appliances. Borough data has been provided, as requested, but it should be noted that this is a measure of the proportion of time spent on community safety, so a smaller amount of time by a smaller workforce might not show a reduction.
- A decade ago, the proportion of time spent by crews on community safety work was just over 7 per cent annually, since which time it has steadily risen and is now recorded at over 14 per cent.
- Data for the numbers of **home fire safety visits** (HFSVs) carried out (mainly by station staff) is available by borough in annex 1E. The London-wide data for the last five years is in the chart below.
- In 2012/13, the Brigade carried out 83,582 home fire safety visits and in the last performance year (2016/17) nearly 84,890 visits were undertaken. Despite the reduction in the number of crew as a result of the LSP5 closure of fire stations, and removal of appliances, the volume of home fire safety visits has been largely maintained.

Comparison with performance for the FRS in England

- A key comparator for London performance in terms of safety outcomes, is overall performance of all Brigades in England in 2016/17. Comparative data for other metropolitan brigades is published every six months as part of routine performance monitoring. Most recently, the Governance, Performance and Audit Committee (GPAC) considered 2016/17 end of year comparative data for London and other Metropolitan brigades in July 2017 (LFEPA report FEP2741). Since that report, the Home Office published, on 11 August 2016, the Statistical Bulletin 13/17 *Fire and Rescue Incident Statistics: England, April 2016 to March 2017*³.
- These are the headlines from the data for England published in the Home Office Fire Statistical Bulletin 13/17 together with comparison data for London (and movements compared to earlier years):
 - In 2015/16, **fire-related fatalities** [in England] increased for the first time for several years, but this increase did not continue in 2016/17. There were 261 fire-related fatalities in 2016/17 compared with 303 in 2015/16 (a decrease of 14 per cent). Fatality figures can fluctuate between years because the numbers are relatively small.
 - In 2016/17 in London there were 44 fire deaths, this is eight more than 2015/16, and the same number as five years ago (in 2012/13).
 - There were **558,963 incidents attended** by FRSs [in England] in 2016/17. This was a six per cent increase compared with the previous year (529,504 in 2015/16) but a 35 per cent decrease compared with ten years ago (854,371 in 2006/07). The total number of incidents was on a downward trend for around a decade before it was relatively flat between 2012/13 and 2014/15. Since then there have been two annual increases mainly driven by increases in non-fire incidents attended.
 - LFB attended 104,721 incidents in London in 2016/17 which represents an increase on the previous year of five per cent, and is also just under 19 per cent of the England total.
 - FRSs attended 161,770 **fires** [in England] in 2016/17. This was virtually unchanged compared with the previous year (162,267 in 2015/16), but less than half compared with ten years ago (336,233 in 2006/07). The total number of fires attended by FRSs has been broadly stable since 2012/13.
 - LFB attended 20,259 fires in London in 2016/17, and this is just over 500 fewer than in 2015/16 (three per cent fewer). Since 2005/06, when there were almost 40,000 fires, the 2016/17 figure is a reduction of nearly 50 per cent over ten years
 - Of these 161,770 fires [in England] in 2016/17, 74,803 were primary fires⁴. Primary fires are generally more serious fires that harm people or cause damage to property. This was a two per cent increase compared with the previous year (73,477 in 2015/16), but a 14 per cent decrease compared with five years ago (86,975 in 2011/12) and a 42 per cent decrease compared with ten years ago (129,134 in 2006/07).
 - London did not reflect the national trend with an increase in primary fires and 2016/17 again saw the lowest number of primary fires in London since records began. LFB attended just 10,615 Primary Fires in 2016/17 (or under 30 per day). In 2005/06 this was 45 fires per day. The overall reduction over ten years since 2005/06 is around one third.

- Of the 30,296 primary dwelling fires [in England] attended in 2016/17, 27,201 were accidental dwelling fires. This was a four per cent decrease compared with the previous year (28,359 in 2015/16), a 12 per cent decrease compared with five years ago (30,789 in 2011/12) and a 26 per cent decrease compared with ten years ago (36,660 in 2006/07).
 - Of the 5,495 primary dwelling fires in London in 2016/17 (nearly 200 fewer than in 2014/15, or three per cent), 5,136 were accidental dwelling fire.; this was a nearly four per cent reduction compared to 2015/176.
- FRSs attended 223,614 fire false alarms [in England] in 2016/17. This was a four per cent increase compared with the previous year (214,424 in 2015/16), the first increase in fire false alarms since 2003/04, but a ten per cent decrease compared with five years ago (249,445 in 2011/12) and a 36 per cent decrease compared with ten years ago (352,136 in 2006/07).
 - All false alarms in London increased in 2015/16 to 51,226 (up by five per cent) compared to 2015/16. The largest proportion of false alarms were due to automatic fire alarm activation in non-domestic buildings (21,929 in 2016/17).
- For the first time, in 2016/17 English FRSs attended more **non-fire incidents** [i.e. special services] than fires. Thirty-one per cent of all incidents attended by FRSs in 2016/17 were non-fire incidents compared with 29 per cent that were fires. In 2006/07 these percentages were 39 per cent (fires attended) and 19 per cent (non-fire incidents). The largest incident type continues to be fire false alarms (40 per cent in 2016/17).
 - In London, 32 per cent of all incidents were Special Services in 2016/17. LFB attended more special services from 2004/15 when the proportion was 26 per cent compared to 25 per cent fires. Fire false alarms are also the largest incident type in London (49 per cent in 2016/17).
- FRSs attended 173,579 **non-fire incidents** [special services] in 2016/17 in England. This was a 14 per cent increase compared with the previous year (152,813 in 2015/16). For around a decade, there was a general decline in the number of non-fire incidents. However the last two years have shown two large increases.
 - Special services attended by LFB in London were up by 10 per cent compared to 2015/16.

Notes on data

Corrections

This document includes some minor corrections to some data for years earlier than 2016/17 and published to support earlier versions of the Statement of Assurance. These are minor corrections and do not materially impact on any conclusions to be drawn from the data.

Attendance time calculation

Fire engine response times

The way in which fire engine response times are calculated is described in the document **Fire Facts - Incident Response Times 2015** available on the LFB web site [2016 version to be published by end September 2017]. In line with LSP2017, the calculation has been varied to provide greater accuracy in terms of performance. The method of calculation as described previously, with the recent changes highlighted in red, is set out below.

Attendance times for fire engines are measured from (a) the time an appliance is mobilised to (b) the time the appliance arrives at the incident scene. No special appliances (e.g. aerial appliances, fire rescue units) currently have published attendance times. The standard applies London-wide to any type of emergency incident.

The following criteria are used to calculate published attendance time performance:

- London pumping appliances only; pumping appliances from neighbouring brigades that attend in London are not included.
- Appliances on **any** mobilised attendance, **including running calls, incident upgrades, additional mobilisations**.
- Mobilisations where a time value is present in the data; sometimes 'time arrived' is missing due to a failure (human or technical) to record the time.
- Mobilisations are excluded where:
 - The incident is a 'shut in lift' release not attended as an emergency (i.e. not on 'blue light').
 - The calculated attendance time is greater than 20 minutes (because this generally reflects a failure (human or technical) to record a time of arrival in a timely manner).
 - The mobilisation is to a batch mobilised flooding call.
 - The mobilisation was a relief appliance for an appliance mobilised as part of the initial or upgraded attendance.
 - **The attending crew has added a delay code for: 'arrival time incorrect', 'did not arrive', 'returned by stop', or attendance at 'non-emergency road speed'.**
- Arrival times for all pumping appliances regardless of location of the appliance at time of mobilisation and will include appliances from other station grounds.
- First appliance and second appliance is determined by the order of arrival at the incident, i.e. the first appliance will be the first to arrive not necessarily the first to be mobilised.
- Mobilisations included in the calculation are for:
 - Incidents in London only.

Special appliance response times

The performance calculation for special appliance response times follows the same methodology as that for fire engine response times (as set out above), except that instead of excluding times greater than 20 minutes, the exclusion is set at 40 minutes given the expected longer arrival times for special appliances.

Second and third appliance average attendance performance

Data for average **third appliance response times** is provided by ward (in annex 2A). There is no target attendance time for third appliance. In this ward data there are some cases where the third appliance response is shown with a faster time than the second appliance response. This is a function of maths. Take an example of six incidents in one ward. For each incident, the times are consistent with first faster than second and second faster than third. But when they are averaged, you get a third appliance average response time faster than second appliance, as follows:

Methodological difficulties working at ward level

Ward level data is provided at the request of LFEPA Members to assist with an assessment of the impact of LSP5. During LSP5 consultation and in the reports which dealt with the SoA 2013/14 (FEP2363 and FEP2385), SoA 2014/15 (FEP2514), and SoA 2015/16 (FEP2564), officers explained the difficulties in interpreting ward level data.

To summarise:

- **high level of variability in ward demand/ward response performance year-on-year.** In 197 wards (30 per cent) wards where the Brigade did attend an incident, in 2016/17, over a quarter of ward s(27 per cent) had fewer than two incidents a week (197 wards). In 2016/17, about 58 per cent of all incidents were resolved by one appliance; 32 per cent of incidents received two appliances, with just 10 per cent receiving three or more appliances. The small

number of incidents receiving more than one appliance means that ward response times, particularly where a second or third appliance are mobilised, are subject to considerable variability year-on-year. Some of the data shown for an individual ward will reflect what happened on a single occasion. In other wards it will reflect the average of what happened across a range up to 100 incidents.

- **changes to wards in three boroughs:** Wards in three boroughs changed in 2014 impacting on 60 wards in Hackney, Kensington and Chelsea and Tower Hamlets. Data for this report is consistently on the basis of new wards even for periods before the change. This makes direct comparison with ward data published during LSP5 consultation impossible.
- **temporary changes due to station rebuild programmes:** A number of boroughs and many wards in 2014/15 and 2015/16 were directly impacted by temporary closure and removal of pumping appliances changes which were in place due to the station rebuild (station PFI) programme. Those wards where stations were closed for all or part of the year, had a temporary impact on attendance times in 2015/16 and in 2014/15. During 2015/16, six stations were closed at various points during the year⁵.
