About this publication

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The London Fire Brigade

The London Fire Brigade is run by the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority (LFEPA).

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Introduction

In March 2016, the LFEPA Governance, Performance and Audit Committee asked that data be presented alongside the SoA 2015/16 so that a *“full assessment could be made of LSP5”*.

This document sets out the key performance information to support the LFEPA Statement of Assurance (SoA) 2015/16.

Fifth London Safety Plan (LSP5)

The Fifth London Safety Plan (LSP5) was approved by the LFEPA on 12 September 2013, following a Mayoral Direction and on 9 January 2014 the following operational changes were made:

- The closure of 10 fire stations.
- The number of fire engines (pumping appliances) reduced by 14 (net).
- Five appliances were redeployed to different stations.
- The number of fire rescue units (specialist rescue vehicles) reduced from 16 to 14.
- The minimum crewing levels on fire rescue units reduced from five firefighters to four.

Other changes at stations were introduced (before 9 January 2014) including:

- Alternate crewing introduced on the scientific support units at Poplar and Hammersmith.
- Alternate crewing introduced on the two remaining incident response units at Wimbledon and Plaistow
- On-demand mobilising for hose-laying and bulk foam units at the incident support centres.

Impacts on performance in the five years to 2015/16

Performance in 2015/16 is impacted by a range of changes alongside those in LSP5 which includes the temporary removal of EFCC appliances and station/appliances temporary changes as a result of the PFI station rebuilding programme. To provide the

opportunity to assess the impacts of LSP5, this document includes data for five performance years, as follows:

- 2011/12 – the base year for data in LSP5 and showing the position before any LSP5 or EFCC, or PFI changes
- 2012/13 – the last full year based on pre-LSP5 deployments (i.e. 112 stations/169 appliances), and before the temporary EFCC removals, or PFI station closures.
- 2013/14 – the performance year with 27 EFCC appliances temporarily removed (from August 2013), LSP5 changes implemented (from January 2014) and stations/appliances changes arising from the property PFI project (from various dates).
- 2014/15 – the performance year with LSP5 changes fully implemented, but still with 13 EFCC appliances removed and station changes arising from the station PFI project.
- 2015/16 – the SoA year with LSP5 changes fully implemented, 13 EFCC appliances temporarily removed from stations, and station closures arising from the PFI station rebuilding programme.

Routine performance monitoring

Members at the LFEPA Governance, Performance and Audit Committee receive a six monthly performance report which contains details of all the data included in this report. The data published in this document for 2015/16 is consistent with the 2015/16 end of year report (FEP2610) presented to the GPAC in July 2016 and available on the Brigade's web site here.

Progress against LSP5 commitments is reported regularly to the Strategy Committee and the last such report was in July 2016 (report FEP2616). It indicates good progress against 31 ongoing actions of a wide ranging nature and is available here.

Other data published

Data for all incidents attended and for the arrival times of all pumping appliances is published on the London Datastore [here](#). This data covers the period from January 2009, and is updated monthly.

The Brigade's mapping tool on its web site [here](#), provides incident data and pumping appliance attendance time performance by borough and ward and is updated monthly.

Performance overview

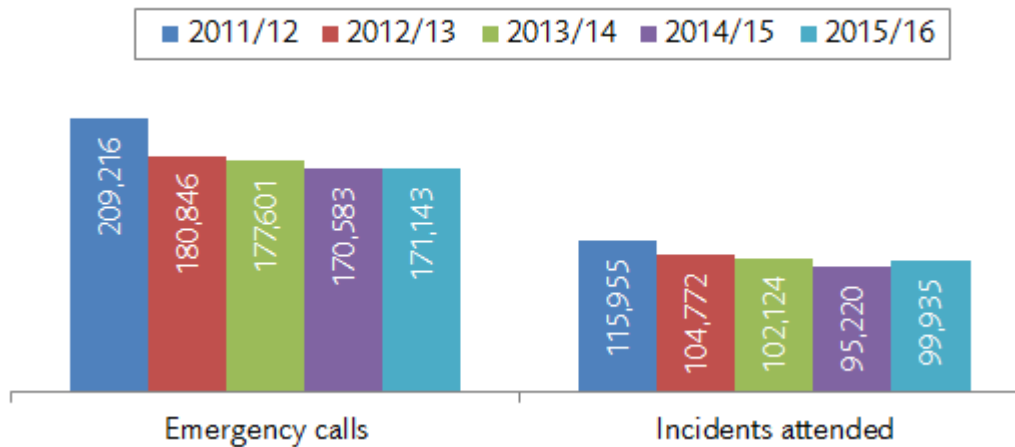
The performance highlights of 2015/16, compared to the previous year (2014/15 and five years earlier in 2011/12, based on the data published in appendix 3, are:

- **Emergency calls** received by the Brigade were higher in 2015/16 compared to the previous year, but only by some 560 (less than one per cent); emergency calls in 2015/16 are down by 18 per cent (38,000 fewer) compared to 2011/12.
- The number of **incidents attended** by the Brigade in London was higher in 2015/16 compared to the previous year by 5 per cent (4,300 more); incidents attended were down by 14 per cent (16,400 fewer) compared to 2011/12.
- **First and second pumping appliance average attendance times** were slightly slower in 2015/16 compared to the previous year (4 seconds for first appliance, two seconds for second appliance), although third appliance was slightly faster (7 seconds). Comparing 2015/16 with 2011/12 all attendance times are slower (13 seconds for first, 24 seconds for second, 27 seconds for third appliance). Despite these slower times, the safety outcomes in London continue to be good, with reductions in many of the key numbers (as set out below).
- **Fire deaths** in 2015/16 are higher than in 2014/15 (36 compared to 30). This higher number was driven by a large increase in deaths in deliberate fires (including suicides) which increased from 3 in 2014/15 to 11 in 2015/16; accidental fire deaths in the home continued a downward trend falling by two to 20 in 2015/16. The long term trend, however, remains downward whether measured using the ten year average or the annual numbers of fire deaths. The ten year average is down from 58 to 46 comparing the 10 years to 2011/12 and the ten years to 2015/16.
- **Fire injuries** in 2015/16 continued to fall compared to 2014/15 (down by 4 per cent or 23 injuries), and over the five year period since 2011/12 (down by 36 per cent, or 208 injuries).
- Whilst all **fires** were slightly higher in 2015/16 (5 per cent, or 1000 more fires), this increase was driven by more secondary fires (up by 1200 fires, or 13 per cent) reflecting the warmer/drier summer months in 2015. The good news is that more **serious (primary) fires** continued to fall (by 2 per cent, or just under 200 fires). Also, significantly, **accidental fires in the home** (dwellings) – which are the main target of community safety activity – also fell in 2015/16 compared to 2014/15 (down by nearly 5 per cent or 263 fires). This is against the backdrop of a steadily rising population in London over the last few years. Over the five year period, all types of fire were significantly lower in 2015/16 than in 2011/12.
- The Brigade delivered on one of its key commitments in LSP5 – to reduce the **fires in care homes and sheltered housing** – which saw 11 fewer fires attended in 2015/16, compared to 2014/15 (down by 21 per cent); fires were down by 84 since 2011/12, or 17 per cent).
- **Community safety work**, as measured by the number of home fire safety visits carried out, remained level in 2015/16 compared to 2014/15. The number of visits increased by over 9,000 over the five year period between 2011/12 and 2015/16 despite fewer appliance crews.
- London performed strongly in 2015/16 when compared to figures for the **all brigades in England** published by the Home Office¹ in August 2016.

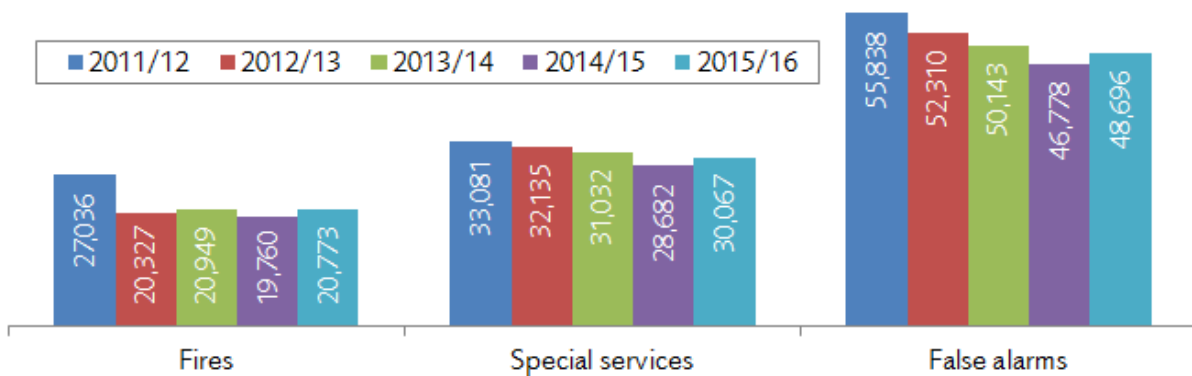

Calls received and incidents attended

1. The numbers of emergency (999) calls received and the incidents attended over the five years to 2015/16 are set out in the charts below.
2. Data for all incidents attended (borough and ward) is available in annex 1C. Emergency call data is not available at ward or borough level as the location of a caller is not captured.



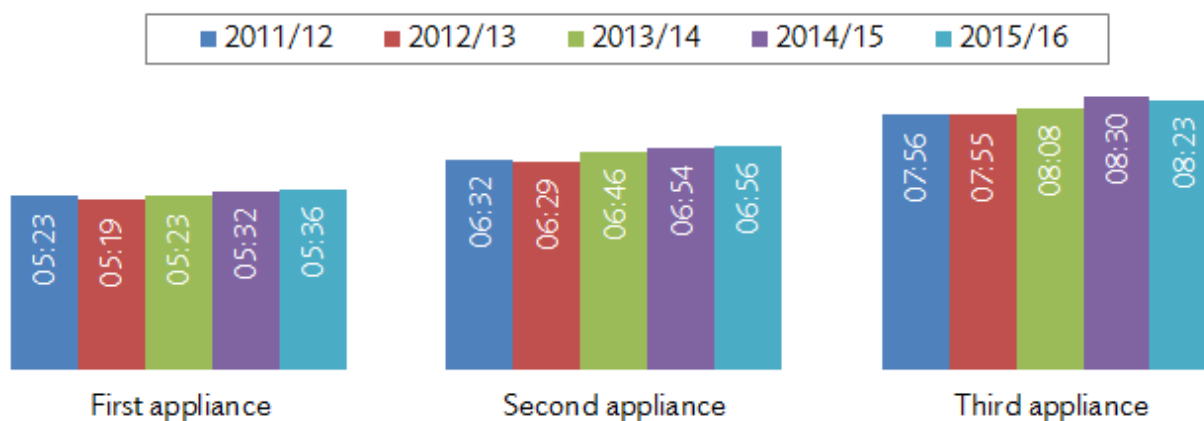
3. London-wide, the number of **incidents attended** by the Brigade rose slightly in 2015/16 but is over 16,000 fewer than in 2011/12. Most boroughs saw a small rise incidents in 2015/16 compared to 2014/15.
4. Fires, special services and false alarms all showed an increase London-wide in 2015/16 compared to 2014/15, although numbers are still lower than five years earlier.



Attendance time impacts

First, second and third pumping appliances

5. The London-wide performance for first, second and third pumping appliances is summarised in the chart below. London-wide and borough attendance times for five years are set out in annex 1A (borough) and Annex 2A (ward).

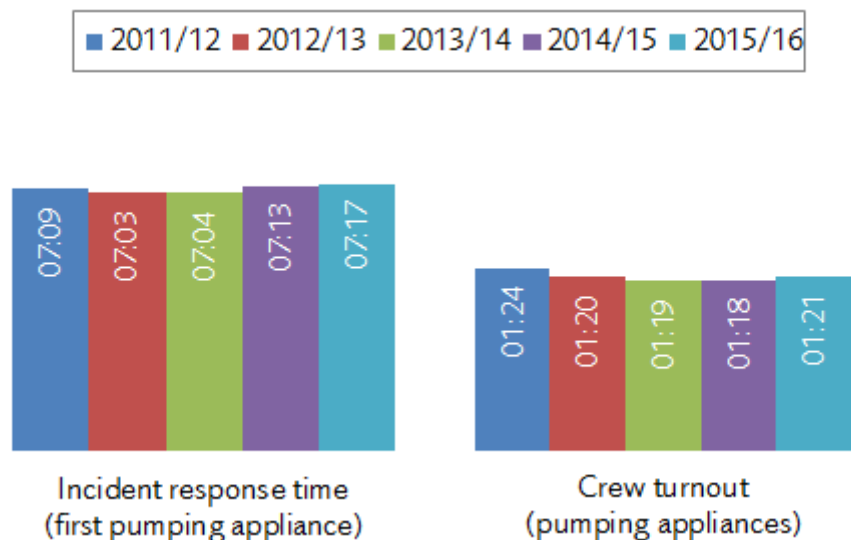


6. Average performance for **first appliance** in 2015/16 (at 05:36) is some 4 seconds slower than in 2014/15. In LSP5, modelling suggested that six boroughs were likely to perform outside the first appliance target following the station/appliance changes. In 2015/16, there were 10 boroughs that performed outside the target. In some boroughs, this reflects the direct impact of the closure of Dagenham fire station for rebuilding which pushed Barking and Dagenham, Redbridge and Havering all outside the first appliance target during the year.
7. London-wide, **second appliance** average response time (at 06:56) was 2 seconds slower than in 2015/16 than in 2014/15. This reflects the absence of 13 EFCC appliances during the year. In LSP5, modelling suggested that one borough (Kingston) was likely to perform outside the second appliance average response time target following implementation of the station closures/pump removals. In 2015/16, two boroughs were outside target (Hillingdon, Havering).
8. London-wide, average **third appliance** response times (at 08:23) in 2015/16 was 7 seconds faster than in 2014/15. As Members will know, there is no agreed target for third appliance performance, but performance is well within the benchmark average of 10 minutes used during LSP5 consultation; two boroughs (Hillingdon and Kingston) in 2015/15 fell outside this benchmark.

Overall pumping appliance 'incident' response time

9. In line with previous reporting for Statement of Assurance purposes, details of the **overall time taken between answering the 999 call answer and arrival of the first pumping appliance at incident scene** are published for borough and ward in annexes 1A and 2A. The London-wide performance is shown in the chart below.
10. As the incident response time covers call handling, the equivalent performance target (for a first appliance) would be 7m40s (1:40 call handling plus 6 minute attendance).
11. Whilst the travel time to the incident scene may be impacted by the LSP5 changes to stations and appliances, no other aspect of the process (i.e. call answer, call handling and crew turnout) would be impacted as a direct result

of LSP5. The new mobilising system went live during 2015/16 (November 2015) and this is expected to improve call handling performance, and the travel to the incident as a result of the introduction of geographic mobilising.

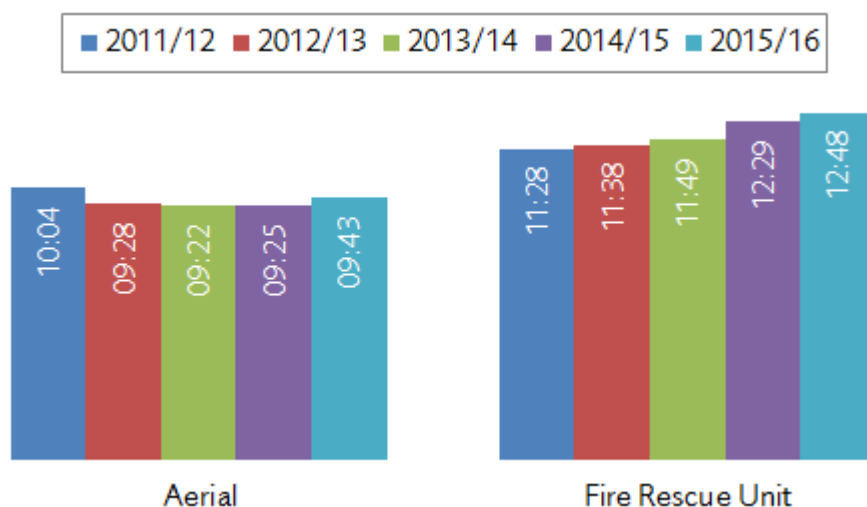


Crew turn-out for pumping appliances

12. Data on pumping appliance **crew turnout** performance is shown in the chart above, and is available by borough in annex 1A. The crew turn-out time is included within overall attendance times (which are measured from the time of mobilisation to arrival at the incident address). Crew turnout performance, whilst slightly slower in 2015/16 compared to 2014/15, continues to show an improvement when compared to 2011/12. It would not be expected that crew turnout performance would be impacted by the changes to stations and pumping appliances implemented in LSP5.

Special appliances

13. Data for special appliance average response times – for Fire Rescue Units (FRUs) and aerial appliances – is shown in the chart below for five years up to 2015/16. Data for borough and ward performance is shown in annex 1B and annex 2A respectively.



14. London-wide, average **aerial appliance** response times were 08:31 in 2015/16. This is slightly slower than in 2014/15 (08:24), but faster than in 2011/12. Members will know that there are no published attendance standards for aerial appliances and that there were no changes made to the number or deployment of aerial

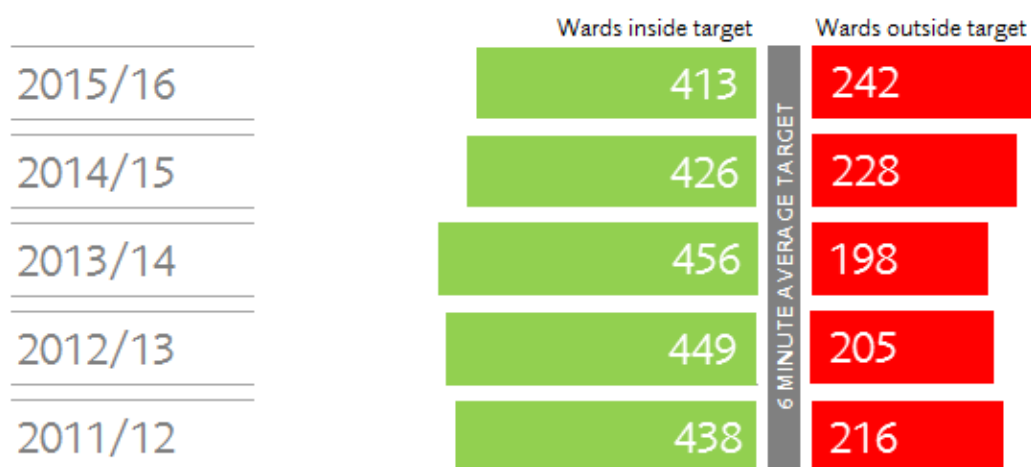
appliances in LSP5. The relatively small numbers of mobilisations of aerial appliances, and the major road infrastructure works in London, are likely to impact on 2015/16 performance.

15. London-wide, average **fire rescue unit** response times were 10:01 in 2015/16, and this is slightly slower than in 2014/15 (09:51). Members will know that there are no published attendance standards for fire rescue units. In LSP5 FRUs were removed from Hornchurch in Havering, and Millwall in Tower Hamlets.

Ward pumping appliance attendance times

16. Ward data for pumping appliance attendance times is in annex 2A.

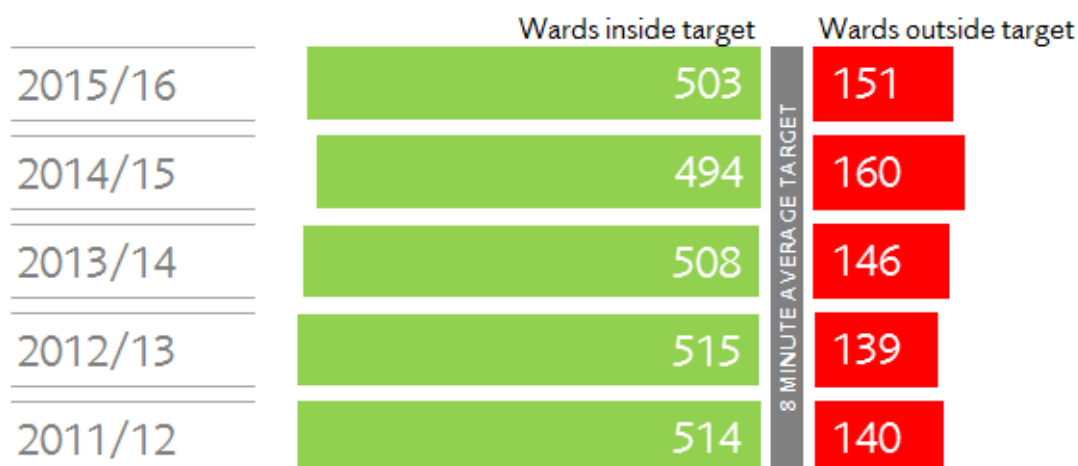
17. 64 per cent of wards in 2015/16 had a **first appliance** within the average six minute target. Comparing performance in 2015/16 with a year before the LSP5 changes and EFCC removals; i.e. 2011/12, there were 20 more wards outside target in the most recent year.



18. Of the 242 wards outside the first appliance average six minute target in 2015/16, 102 wards were within 30 seconds of the target, with 29 further wards within 10 seconds of the target. The chart below shows wards outside the target within four time bands together with the cumulative number of wards at each time band.

19. Performance for **second appliance** comparing 2015/16 against 2011/12 shows eight more wards outside the target in the most recent year.

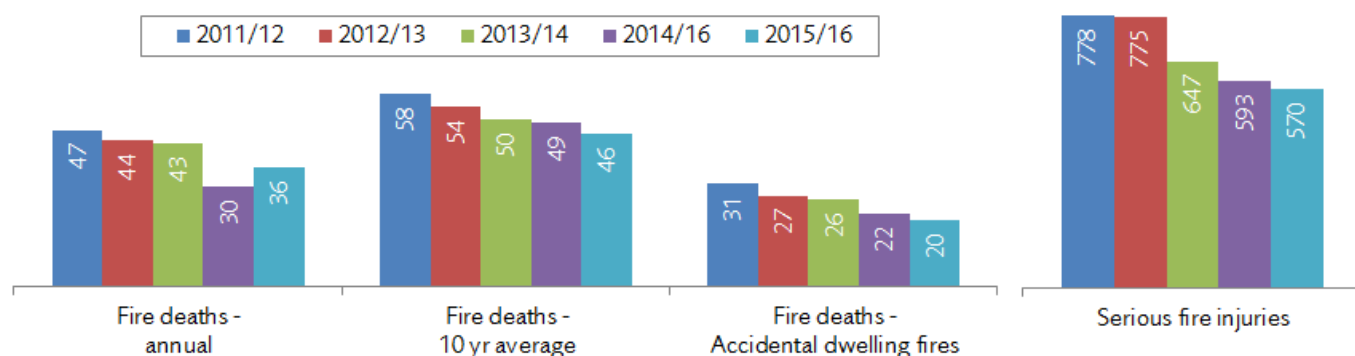


20. Of the 151 wards outside the second appliance average eight minute target in 2015/16, 62 wards were within 30 seconds of the target, with 29 further wards within 10 seconds of the target. The chart below shows wards outside the target within four time bands together with the cumulative number of wards at each time band.

Fire casualties (fatal and non-fatal)

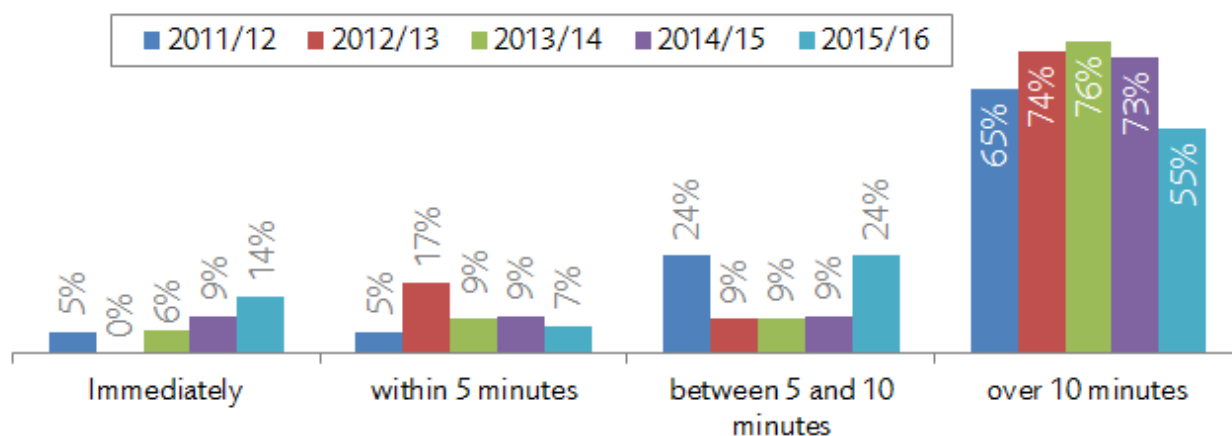
21. Data about fire casualties (by borough and ward) is available in annexes 1D and 2B respectively.
22. The chart below shows the numbers of fire casualties (fatal and non-fatal) for the five year period up to 2015/16. Whilst there was a small upturn in the number of all fire deaths in 2015/16, this was almost entirely due to a rise in deaths resulting from deliberate fires (which includes suicides). The 10 year average for all fire deaths, the numbers of fire deaths in accidental fire in the home (dwellings) and serious fire injuries, have continued a downward trend over the five year period, and confirm that the LSP5 changes have not impacted on these critical measures of safety from fire in London.

23. Borough and ward data for **fire deaths** is set out in Annex 1D (borough) and 2B (ward). The number of fire deaths is generally low and so there are always limitations on the statistical conclusions that reliably can be drawn, particularly at borough and ward level.
24. There is always an interest in whether changes to pumping appliance response times increases the prevalence of deaths. One factor that is key to whether the Brigade arrives in good time and someone is rescued in a timely way is the delay in discovering the fire and calling the fire brigade. The chart below looks at the estimated delay between ignition of the fire and calling the brigade, based on the work of crews and fire investigators. This data is available for 29 (of 36) fatal fire casualties in 2015/16. In over half of cases there was a delay of 10 minutes or more in calling the Brigade.

Estimated delay between fire ignition and call to the Brigade for fire fatalities in London

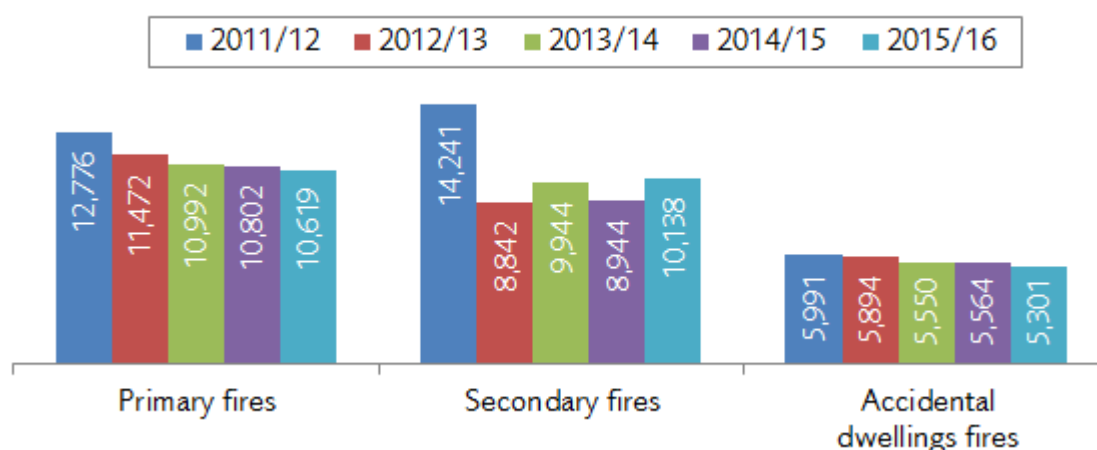

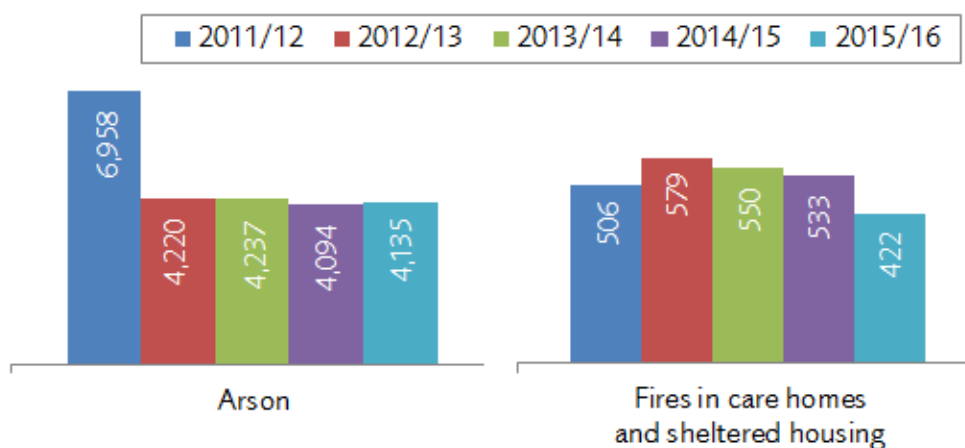
25. The number of **serious fire injuries** have fallen by 36 per cent, or 208 injuries since 2011/12 and 4 per cent or 23 injuries compared to 2014/15. The actual number of fire injuries annually at borough and ward level are such that there are limitations to the reliability of statistical conclusions. As with fire deaths, the LSP5 reductions do not appear to have had an adverse impact on the volume of serious fire injuries.

Fire incidents

26. Detailed borough and ward data is in annexes 1C and 2B, together with data for all fires, primary (more serious) fires, dwellings fires, and fire size.
27. London-wide, the number of **primary fires**, and **accidental dwelling fires** continue to fall and that pattern is maintained in the period since the implementation of LSP5 in January 2014. The number of **secondary fires** fluctuates as open land and grass fires are a significant proportion of these fires and are higher in years which have more warmer/drier summer periods (like 2015/16).



28. Data for all deliberate fires (arson) and for fires in care homes and sheltered housing, and accidental fires in the home is set out in the chart below.
29. In the period since LSP5 was implemented, **arson** incidents have remained relatively flat and are lower than five years ago. In LSP5 we said that we were concerned by the number of older people who are still harmed or killed by fire in places where they should be safe, and we introduced a new headline target focusing on reducing the **fires in care homes and sheltered housing**. Over the life of LSP5, the numbers of these fires has reduced.

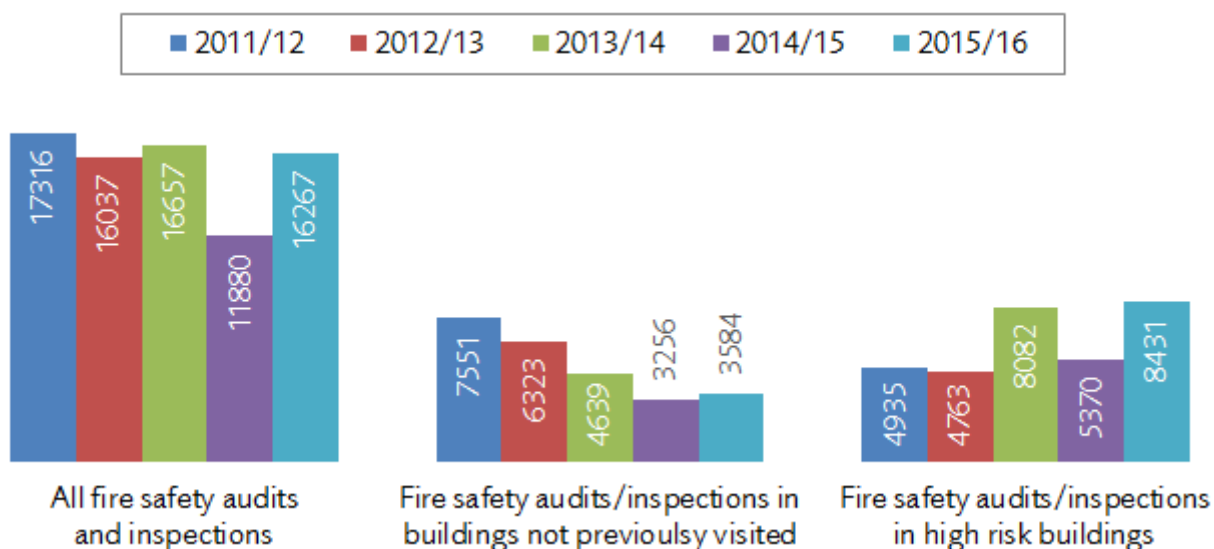


Note: incident types not to same scale.

Fire safety

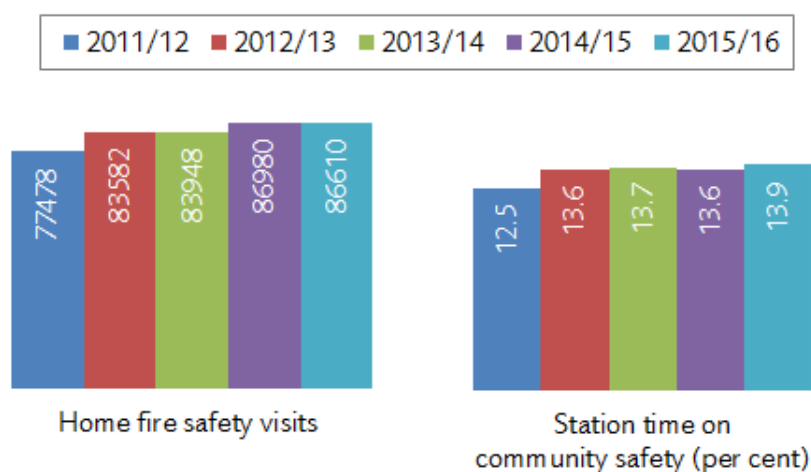
Regulatory fire safety

30. Data on **all fire safety inspections/audits**, those in **premises not previously visited** and for **inspection/audits to high-risk premises** and this data is provided at borough level only (annex 1E). London-wide performance for the past five years, including 2015/16, is set out in the chart below.
31. There is no relationship between the stations and pumping appliance reductions in LSP5 and the volume of regulatory fire safety work undertaken, as this is currently carried out by specialist non-station based staff. As the Committee will know, the numbers of inspections has fluctuated over the last few years with a decline shown in 2014/15. The Committee monitor the numbers of inspection closely and there is evidence, after Q1 2015/16 that the numbers are beginning to rise in line with targets.



Community safety

32. Data for the proportion of **time spent on community safety by station based staff** is published at borough level only in annex 1E. The London-wide data for the last five years is in the chart below.
33. A decade ago, this figure was recorded as 7.4 per cent annually, since which time it has steadily risen and is now recorded at just under 14 per cent. The indicator is expressed as a proportion of available time by the crews of pumping appliances. Borough data has been provided, as requested, but officers would put a health warning on how it can be interpreted because it is a measure of the proportion of time spent on community safety (so smaller time for a smaller workforce might not show a reduction).
34. Data for the numbers of **home fire safety visits** (HFSVs) carried out (mainly by station staff) is available by borough in annex 1E. The London-wide data for the last five years is in the chart below.
35. In 2011/12, the Brigade carried out 77,478 visits and in the last performance year (2015/16) nearly 87,000 visits were undertaken. This is similar to the performance for 2014/15 despite the reduction in the number of crew as a result of the LSP5 closure of fire stations, and removal of appliances.

Comparison with performance for the FRS in England

36. A key comparator for London performance in terms of safety outcomes, is overall performance of all Brigades in England in 2014/15. Comparative data for other metropolitan brigades is published every six months as part of routine performance monitoring. Most recently, the Governance, Performance and Audit Committee (GPAC) considered 2015/16 end of year comparative data for London and other Metropolitan brigades in July 2016 (LFEPA report FEP2610). Since producing the GPAC report, the Home Office published its Fire Statistics Monitor for 2015/16² on 17 August 2015.

37. These are the headlines from the data for England published in the Fire Statistics Monitor together with comparison data for London (and movements compared to earlier years):

- There were **303 fire-related fatalities** in England during 2015/16. This was 39 more than in 2014/15 and the highest figure since 2011/12. Fire-related fatalities have been on a broadly long-term downward trend, with the 2015/16 figure being 83 fewer than a decade ago.
 - In 2015/16 in London there were 36 fire deaths, this is 6 more than 2014/15 but is 16 per cent lower than 2013/14 (43), 18 per cent lower than 2012/13 (44) and 23 per cent lower than 2011/12 where there were 47 fire deaths. The increase in London was the result of fatalities in deliberate fires.
- Fire and rescue services (FRSs) attended around **528,700 incidents** in England during 2015/16, 7 per cent higher than the previous year. This increase was predominantly driven by a large increase in non-fire incidents.
 - LFB attended 99,538 incidents in London in 2015/16 which represents an increase on the previous year and also just under 20 per cent of the England total. Compared to 2005/06 when LFB attended 155,669 incidents, this is an overall reduction of 36 per cent over 10 years.
- Fire and rescue services (FRSs) attended around **162,000 fires** in England during 2015/16. This is 5 per cent more than the 155,000 attended in 2014/15 but 52 per cent fewer than in 2005/06.
 - LFB attended 20,775 fires in London in 2015/16, and this is about 1,000 more than in 2014/15 (5 per cent increase), although all the increase in London is attributable to secondary fires. Since 2005/06, when there were almost 40,000 fires, the 2015/16 figure is a reduction of 47 per cent over ten years
- **Primary fires** (more serious fires that harm people or cause damage to property) have also been on a long-term downward trend but increased slightly, for the first time in 14 years, by 3 per cent from around 71,100 in 2014/15 to 73,400 in 2015/16. The increase in primary fires was largely driven by an 11 per cent increase in deliberate primary fires.
 - London did not reflect the national trend with an increase in primary fires and 2015/16 saw the lowest number of primary fires in London since records began. LFB attended just 10,620 Primary Fires in 2015/16 (or under 30 per day). In 2005/06 this was 45 fires per day, 15 per day more than current levels. The overall reduction over ten years since 2005/06 is 33 per cent.
- Although the number of **accidental dwelling fires** [nationally] was virtually unchanged in 2015/16 compared to 2014/15, there were 24 more fire-related fatalities in accidental dwelling fires in 2015/16 (191) than the previous year (167).
 - LFB attended 5,341 accidental dwelling fires in London in 2015/16 which was 268 fewer than in 2014/15, a reduction of 5 per cent and 726 fewer than 2011/12, a reduction of 12 per cent. There

was two fewer fire related fatality in accidental dwelling fires in London in 2015/16 (21) compared to the previous year.

- FRSs attended roughly **214,100 fire false alarms** in England during 2015/16. This was a small decrease of 1 per cent compared with 2014/15, continuing the long-term decreasing trend of false alarms. However, the number of malicious false alarms increased for the first time in 14 years (up by 2 per cent on 2014/15) to around 6,900 in 2015/16.
 - All false alarms in London increased in 2015/16, largely driven by a 4 per cent increase in AFAs since 2014/15, but remain at low levels relative to 2005/06; they've reduced by 35 per cent since then. In London, malicious false alarms were at their lowest level with 1,353 incidents in 2015/16. This is a drop of 68 per cent since 2005/06 (4,175 incidents).
- There was a **22 per cent increase in the number of non-fire (also known as Special Service) incidents** attended by FRSs [in England] from 125,200 in 2014/15 to 152,500 in 2015/16. As a result, 29 per cent of incidents attended by FRSs in 2015/16 were non-fire, the highest proportion since non-fire incidents were first recorded in 1999/00.
 - In London 30 per cent of all incidents were Special Services in 2015/16 compared with 26 per cent in 2005/06. Of the Special Service categories, RTCs contributed most to the increase, as they rose by 11 per cent since 2014/15, and have reached the highest level since 2007/08 (4,476).
- The increase in non-fire incidents was driven to a large extent by increases in **co-responder medical incidents** (where the FRS has a formal agreement in place with the ambulance service to respond to medical incidents), which increased by 83 per cent from 14,200 in 2014/15 to 25,900 in 2015/16.
 - The co-responding trial in London started late in the 2015/16 year, and just in four boroughs, so only contributed to 218 incidents in the data for that year.

Notes on data

Second and third appliance average attendance performance

Data for average **third appliance response times** is provided by ward (in annex 2A). There is no target attendance time for third appliance. In this ward data there are some cases where the third appliance response is shown with a faster time than the second appliance response. This is a function of maths. Take an example of six incidents in one ward. For each incident, the times are consistent with first faster than second and second faster than third. But when they are averaged, you get a third appliance average response time faster than second appliance, as follows:

Methodological difficulties working at ward level

Ward level data is provided at the request of LFEPA Members to assist with an assessment of the impact of LSP5. During LSP5 consultation and in the two reports which dealt with the SoA 2013/14 (FEP2363 and [FEP2385](#)) and the SoA 2014/15 (FEP2514), officers explained the difficulties in interpreting ward level data. To summarise:

- **high level of variability in ward demand/ward response performance year-on-year.** There are some wards in London where the Brigade did not attend any incidents (particularly in the City of London). In those wards where the Brigade did attend an incident, in 2015/16, 99 per cent of wards had fewer than one incident a day (609 wards). In 2015/16, 57 per cent of incidents (56,700) were resolved by one appliance; 33 per cent of incidents (33,100) received two appliances, with just 10 per cent (9,500) receiving three or more appliances. The small number of incidents means that ward response times, particularly where a second or third appliance are mobilised are subject to considerable variability year-on-year. Some of the data shown for an individual ward will reflect what happened on a single occasion. In other wards it will reflect the average of what happened across a range up to 100 incidents.
- **changes to wards in three boroughs:** Wards in three boroughs changed in 2014 impacting on 60 wards in Hackney, Kensington and Chelsea and Tower Hamlets. Data for this report is consistently on the basis of new wards even for periods before the change.
- **temporary changes due to station rebuild programmes:** A number of boroughs and many wards in 2015/16 were directly impacted by temporary closure and removal of pumping appliances changes which were in place due to the station rebuild (property PFI) programme. Those wards where stations were closed for all or

part of the year, had a temporary impact on attendance times in 2015/16. During 2015/16, six stations were closed at various points during the year³.

- **temporary removal of EFCC appliances:** 252 wards in 2015/16 were impacted by the temporary removal of fire appliances to support emergency fire cover (EFCC) arrangements. As outlined in reports on the SoA 2013/14, the extent of this impact is variable. Clearly the wards that the removed appliances normally sit in are most affected, with a ripple effect beyond that ward, to others, of a variable nature. The thirteen EFCC appliances remained temporarily removed from stations for the whole of 2015/16: Chelsea, Ealing, Erith, Forest Hill, Holloway, Old Kent Road, Plaistow, Poplar, Romford, Shoreditch, Stratford, Wandsworth and Willesden.

Corrections

This document includes some minor corrections to some data for years earlier than 2015/16 and published to support earlier versions of the Statement of Assurance. These are minor corrections and do not materially impact on any conclusions to be drawn from the data.
