Update on Evening & Night workers in London

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What do we mean by 'Evening & Night'?


- Analysis based on respondents of ONS Labour Force Survey (LFS) whose place of work is in London
- We define Evening & Night (E&N) workers as those who usually work in evenings and/or nights, regardless of daytime work patterns

 Respondents to the LFS are not given guidance as to what constitutes 'evening' and 'night'. So while GLA's Night Time Strategy defines evening hours as 6pm-12am and night hours as 12am-6am, people in this analysis are not necessarily using those particular hours

1.37 million E&N workers in London in 2022, down from 1.6 million in 2017


Evening & Night workers in London

Number of workers (LHS) and share of total (%, RHS)



Almost all E&N workers also work days

- Across all E&N workers:
 - 91% work during daytime
 - 94% work evenings
 - 39% work nights
- Shift work among E&N workers:
 - Nearly two thirds of those who also work during the daytime, never work shifts
 - More than half of those who work nights are shift workers








Health and ICT saw the only increases in E&N workforce size from 2017

Evening & Night workers by industry sector Workers in 2017 and 2022, selected sectors



- Health had the largest share of E&N workers and saw numbers increase
- Most of the decline in Retail and Hospitality from people working during evenings



Almost a third of E&N workers are in Professional occupations

Evening & Night workers by occupation

Workers in 2017 and 2022, selected occupations





- Professional occupations (incl. in Health) saw increase in evening work
- Largest declines in Managerial and Associate Professional occupations
- Elementary administration remained a large E&N occupation

Summary

- 1.37 million E&N workers in London in 2022
- Majority work, at least in part, during the daytime as well
- Recent decline in E&N workers likely linked to shifting work patterns
- Health only industry with large increase in E&N workers over recent years; other sectors saw declines or stagnation
- Almost a third of E&N workers are in Professional occupations
